Reapers Delight finished 29th percentile in scoring last year and responded by drafting as if the solution was to simply want things harder. The draft board tells the story with brutal clarity: six major reaches against zero steals, which is less a draft strategy than a series of panicked grabs from a manager who saw players they liked and refused to wait. Ashton Jeanty, reached on at pick 1.11, and Omarion Hampton, reached on at 2.02, give this team a legitimate foundation, but the cost of forcing both off the board early rippled through everything that followed. Shedeur Sanders arrived as QB32 three-plus rounds ahead of his market price, Jaxson Dart as QB11 more than a round early, and now this team carries four quarterbacks while the receiver group bottoms out at Michael Pittman as the projected weakest starter. The result is a squad sitting fourth percentile in the field, watching a division it cannot climb out of, built by a manager who confused urgency with instinct and paid for it on nearly every single pick.

ScrubMamaScrub sits 11th in the Fallout Division and in just the 21st percentile of the field, and the roster grades out in a way that makes it hard to argue with either number. The backfield is legitimately strong, with James Cook (RB5), Chase Brown (RB11), and Javonte Williams (RB17) all projected starters, but in a positionless format that kind of depth only matters if the rest of the roster can carry its weight, and here it cannot quite do that. The receiver group is weak, with Tee Higgins (WR19) as the lone high-end option and Jayden Reed (WR48) projected as the weakest starter on the team. The Burrow-Higgins stack offers some upside, but Joe Burrow was the one conspicuous reach of the draft, taken nearly a full round early, so the manager already paid a premium for that ceiling. Trevor Lawrence (QB10) is a useful hedge, having quietly turned in a career year last season, though his fantasy output was tangled enough that trusting him as the anchor feels like a gamble. There is no obvious correction available. This roster is what it is.

The Okie Dokies sit tenth in the Fallout Division and in just the 29th percentile of the field, and the draft board offers little reason for optimism. The most damning detail is at quarterback, where the team reached early for C.J. Stroud, Bryce Young, and Jacoby Brissett in consecutive rounds, paying a premium for a position group that projects QB22, QB26, and QB28 respectively. That is a lot of draft capital chasing middling outcomes, and Bryce Young projects as the weakest starter on the entire roster. Meanwhile, the skill-position core is genuinely decent, Colston Loveland at TE3, Christian McCaffrey at RB3, and George Pickens and Malik Nabers projecting WR10 and WR12 respectively, but the floor under those names is propped up by players like Malachi Fields at WR90 and Keaton Mitchell at RB49. The Okie Dokies had a serviceable 2025, but this roster grades out near the bottom, the quarterback situation bleeds draft equity, and there is no obvious lever left to pull. This one may require a lot of things to go right that probably won't.

Twisted Sanity enters 2026 sitting ninth in the Fallout division and in just the 36th tournament percentile, and the draft chart does not offer much cover for that standing. The team reached on two players in ways that genuinely hurt: Bucky Irving, a projected RB21, was taken 2.4 rounds before his market price, and Deshaun Watson, who grades out as a distant QB34, was pulled in 3.5 rounds early, burning a mid-round pick on a player unlikely to see a lineup. Those two missteps consumed capital that could have deepened a roster already thin on difference-makers. Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 and Drake Maye at QB2 are legitimate anchors, and the manager did find Maye a round late, which counts for something. But Chase and Maye are carrying water for a supporting cast that grades out as average at best, with Brenton Strange, projected TE17, slotting in as the weakest expected starter. When your floor and your ceiling are that close together, hoping for chaos is about the only strategy left on the table.

NacuaCola sits at 37th percentile in the field and eighth in the Fallout Division, and the roster largely explains why. The receiving group is legitimately impressive on paper, with Zay Flowers, Garrett Wilson, Luther Burden, Carnell Tate, and Brian Thomas Jr. all projecting as starters alongside A.J. Brown, who grades out at WR8. That is a real asset. The problem is what surrounds it. Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 is elite, but the rest of the backfield drops off a cliff to Demond Claiborne at RB63. At quarterback, Kyler Murray projects at QB19 and Cam Ward at QB23, which means the position is a drag on scoring almost every week regardless of which one starts. The draft did not help matters: zero steals, zero values, and a pattern of reaching that pulled Garrett Wilson nearly two rounds early and buried capital in late-round receivers like Pat Bryant and Chris Bell well ahead of their price. There is no obvious move that flips this roster, and at this point, NacuaCola may simply be hoping the projections are wrong.

Blamco Mac & CMCheese didn't stumble into correlation, they engineered it. The Dak Prescott and CeeDee Lamb stack is the centerpiece, with Prescott landing at QB7 after slipping nearly a full round past his ADP and Lamb coming in at WR5 after falling from his 1.11 price tag to 2.04, meaning this manager got the best receiver on the board at a discount and immediately paired him with his quarterback. The Baker Mayfield and Emeka Egbuka stack gives the team a second gear, with Egbuka projected WR18 after dropping more than a round past his ADP. Travis Kelce, officially back and chasing a return to the top-12 conversation at TE10, adds another high-upside piece to a starting group that projects well at its peak. The honest caveat is that this roster's ceiling and its floor travel together. If Prescott and Lamb are cooking in the same week Mayfield and Egbuka connect, this team posts a massive number. If those stacks go cold simultaneously, there is not enough firepower elsewhere to paper over it.

UCBravesKing sits at the 51st percentile and sixth in the Fallout Division, which is exactly where a team this finely balanced between good and interesting belongs. The foundation is genuinely strong: Josh Allen is a QB1, Harold Fannin checks in at TE6, and the RB group features Jeremiyah Love (RB13), Breece Hall (RB14), and Josh Jacobs (RB16) across the projected starters, though Jacobs carries real-world uncertainty after an offseason arrest that has yet to produce charges, and his availability could shift the calculus fast. The Allen and Dalton Kincaid stack adds a correlation bonus that could spike a big week when the Bills are rolling. Where the margin gets tight is at receiver, where Nico Collins (WR9) is a legitimate weapon but the next names on the list, Michael Wilson at WR39 and Jauan Jennings at WR63, are depth pieces asked to do starting work. UCBravesKing drafted with discipline, landing four values and zero major reaches, so the roster is built right. Whether it performs right depends on which of those thin edges break in the right direction.

Ghouls & Gridirons didn't win the draft with one flashy pick. They won it by being right, repeatedly, in the middle rounds. The receiver group is where that discipline shows most clearly: Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 anchors the unit, Drake London at WR7 gives them a second projected starter who would headline lesser rosters, and then Chris Olave arrives at WR11 after falling nearly a full round past his ADP, a quiet steal tucked into Round 4. Olave also runs with a stack partner in Tyler Shough, and if Shough can carve out a second-year leap in New Orleans, that connection becomes one of the more interesting value plays on the team. The one blemish on an otherwise disciplined draft sheet is Khalil Shakir, reached 2.3 rounds early and projecting as the weakest expected starter at WR51. That is a real cost. But when your foundation is Smith-Njigba, London, Tyler Warren at TE4, and a backfield anchored by Cam Skattebo at RB20, the margin for the occasional misstep is genuinely there. This is a 67th-percentile team that feels like it could quietly outrun that number.

Justin_Redwards didn't win the draft with one thunderclap pick. This roster was built the way good ones usually are: position after position, the board kept cooperating. Bijan Robinson at RB2 and De'Von Achane at RB6 give this team a ceiling most managers are quietly envious of, and the quarterback stacks only sharpen the edge. Justin Herbert pairs with Ladd McConkey, Jordan Love connects with both Christian Watson and Tucker Kraft, and suddenly the upside on any given week runs through multiple coordinated pipelines. The value column tells the rest of the story: Chris Godwin, projected WR38, slid more than two full rounds past his ADP before Justin_Redwards scooped him up at 11.05, and Quentin Johnston fell a full round to fill out a receiver corps that already had four other projected starters. Chalk dominated this draft, sixteen of those picks, but chalk bought at the right price is just good drafting with less drama. The 2026 Fallout division will not roll over, but this roster arrived ready to argue.

Vault Dweller didn't reshape the board with any single audacious move, but round after round this roster quietly came out ahead, and the cumulative effect is a team that sits at 75th percentile in the field and third in the Fallout division. The foundation is genuinely elite: Brock Bowers at TE1 and Lamar Jackson at QB3 form a stack that gives this team a ceiling most managers would trade for, and George Kittle arriving at TE9 when his ADP suggested he'd be gone more than a round earlier is exactly the kind of incremental edge that separates good drafts from great ones. Kenneth Walker III at RB10 and Derrick Henry at RB12 keep the top of the roster stacked with projected starters. The one moment where discipline slipped, Dylan Sampson taken nearly four rounds ahead of his ADP, doesn't sink a roster this deep at the top. When a team's biggest knock is an aggressive reach near the back of the draft, that's less a red flag and more a footnote on an otherwise clean sheet of work.

The New Vegas Radstags didn't need a lottery ticket to build a winner, just a steady hand and a sharper eye than the rest of the room. The clearest example is Trey McBride, a TE2 projection who slid a few picks past his ADP at 1.12 and landed right in New Vegas's lap. Pair him with Oronde Gadsden (TE16) and Hunter Henry (TE18) and the Radstags are fielding elite production at that position without breaking a sweat. The same pattern shows up at quarterback, where Jayden Daniels fell a full round past his ADP and gives the team a QB5 playing at a discount, stacked neatly with Terry McLaurin (WR24) for maximum upside. Amon-Ra St. Brown projects as WR4 and is the kind of player who quietly makes a lineup hum. The one asterisk on the whole thing is Marvin Harrison Jr., who enters 2026 with unsettled quarterback circumstances in Arizona and some injury history to shake off, but in a positionless format, he is depth insurance at worst. Sitting second in the Fallout division at the 80th percentile, this team earned its spot.

4WhomJBellTolls sits at the top of the Fallout division and in the 97th percentile of the field, and the draft record tells you exactly why: 16 chalk picks, a steal, two values, and barely a reach in sight. This is what quiet competence looks like. Jonathan Taylor landed at RB4 despite slipping nearly a full round past his ADP, and Puka Nacua projects as WR1, giving this roster two anchors that most managers would build an entire strategy around. The receiver group runs deep enough that Rashee Rice at WR13 and Jameson Williams at WR21 are essentially supporting cast, and the Jared Goff and Williams stack adds a correlation bonus that could pay dividends in high-scoring weeks. Goff himself is easy to undervalue, a quarterback who has quietly finished as a top-10 asset four straight years in six-point passing leagues, and with the full Detroit skill group intact around him, there is no reason to expect that to change. There was no single flashy gamble here, just a manager who kept winning small edges until they added up to something worth talking about.
