There is something genuinely sad about Im-a Luigi, Number One!, and not in an entertaining way. Last year this team scored in the 83rd percentile and posted a 20-16 record, the kind of season that earns a manager real credibility. This year, the tournament has them projected at the 5th percentile, dead last in the Mario Kart 64 division, and the roster tells you why the fall is so steep. Joe Burrow at QB4 is legitimate, and the Burrow-Tee Higgins stack gives this team a genuine anchor, but Higgins was a minor reach at WR19, Henderson was taken a full 1.2 rounds early, and the headliner reach, Jaxson Dart at QB11, cost a fourth-round pick for a quarterback projected well outside the top 10. That is the shape of this roster: real talent at the top squeezed by a draft that leaned on hope over value, producing almost no surplus anywhere. The gap between what this manager accomplished in 2025 and what the numbers say is coming in 2026 is not a slump, it is a reckoning.

EliteJb25 finished last season at the 8th percentile in scoring and currently sits 11th in the Mario Kart 64 division, and the 2026 draft did not do much to change the trajectory. The roster's best asset is a genuinely strong backfield anchored by Christian McCaffrey (RB3) and Kyren Williams (RB15), but the receiver group grades out weak across the board, with Jakobi Meyers (WR45) projecting as the top pass-catcher among the starters. That is a ceiling problem. Where the draft compounded the damage is in the reach column: Kenneth Gainwell (RB34) cost nearly three rounds of surplus value over his ADP, and Rashid Shaheed (WR57) was similarly yanked off the board almost three rounds early, meaning EliteJb25 paid premium prices for players who grade out as low-end contributors at best. With only three values on the entire draft sheet and zero steals, there is no late-round lottery ticket quietly waiting to save this roster. The math is uncomfortable and the lever is already pulled.

Last year mrmeseeks went 26-10 and scored in the 88th percentile, which is the kind of résumé that makes a manager feel bulletproof heading into a new draft. The 2026 roster, sitting at 23rd percentile in tournament projections and tenth in the Mario Kart 64 division, suggests the armor has some gaps. The backfield is genuinely strong at the top, with Jonathan Taylor (RB4), De'Von Achane (RB6), and Kenneth Walker III (RB10) forming a credible foundation, but the depth behind them was built aggressively, including Kyle Monangai (RB33) taken 2.2 rounds early and Kimani Vidal (RB60) taken 3.7 rounds early, which means mrmeseeks paid a premium to stock a tier where the returns get thin fast. Beyond Malik Nabers (WR12), the receiving corps is sparse on projected starters, and Monangai projects as the weakest starter on the roster. The 2025 version of this team earned its reputation. The 2026 version looks like a manager still spending like that version exists.

JJWenner enters 2026 sitting ninth in the Mario Kart 64 division and in just the 24th percentile of the field, and the roster does not offer many reasons for optimism. The receiver group is legitimately strong, anchored by Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and Nico Collins at WR9, but that upside gets quietly swallowed by what surrounds it. The projected backfield is a collection of depth pieces, with Quinshon Judkins as the headliner at RB22, and the tight end situation leans on Dallas Goedert at a modest TE15 alongside T.J. Hockenson at TE23. The drafting did not manufacture much advantage either, producing zero steals and fifteen chalk picks against just one player of genuine value. A 15-21 record last season already telegraphed the problems, and the projected lineup projects the weakest starter as Matthew Golden at WR52, which tells you something about where the floor is. Smith-Njigba and Collins can carry some water, but asking two receivers to rescue a roster this thin elsewhere is a lot to put on anyone's shoulders.

SpaceBrain enters 2026 sitting eighth in the Mario Kart 64 division and at just the 34th percentile of the field, and the roster does not make a compelling case for optimism. The foundation looks solid enough on paper, with Bijan Robinson projected as RB2 and A.J. Brown at WR8 anchoring the lineup, but the supporting cast fades quickly and the draft board offered almost no help. Of 17 picks evaluated, SpaceBrain logged zero steals and two major reaches, including Trevor Lawrence pulled 1.8 rounds before his ADP at QB10 and Justin Fields grabbed a stunning 5.7 rounds early at QB38. Those are the kinds of picks that haunt a roster when the margins are already thin. Then there is Rashee Rice, projected WR13 and theoretically a difference maker, who arrives carrying a knee procedure, reported probation violations, and a short jail stint into a season that asks him to simply stay available. Last year's 50 percent win rate and 47th-percentile scoring look less like a floor and more like a ceiling SpaceBrain may struggle to reach again.

Binnytron went 31-5 last season and finished in the 100th percentile of scoring, which is the kind of résumé that buys real goodwill heading into a new year. The problem is that goodwill does not win games in 2026, and the current roster projects to just the 43rd percentile, good for seventh in the Mario Kart 64 division. The blueprint here is readable: Lamar Jackson anchors everything, and his connection to Zay Flowers gives the team a genuine stack worth building around, with Flowers sitting at WR16 and Trey McBride and Harold Fannin forming a strong tight end group behind him. But last year's version of this team was a machine, and this one looks more like a prototype that still needs testing. The receiver corps beyond Flowers and Jaylen Waddle gets thin in a hurry, the backfield projects as outright weak across the board, and the draft offered no steals and one major reach in Jaydon Blue at RB70. Reputation and projection are pointing in very different directions, and the gap between them is where this season will be decided.

CyndiQ Peachys got it! is a team that lives in the margins, and the margins are exactly where this season gets decided. Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and Drake Maye at QB2 give the roster a legitimate top-end, and Maye in particular looks like a genuine difference-maker after finishing second in MVP voting last year, now with AJ Brown added to a Patriots offense that already made do with less. The trouble is that the gap between those stars and the rest of the lineup is real. Chris Godwin projects as the weakest starter at WR38, and while he arrived as a value pick after sliding past his ADP, value and production are not the same promise. Kyle Pitts at TE7 cost a reach of nearly a round and a half, a calculated bet that either pays off quietly or stings loudly come playoff time. A 52nd percentile projection and a sixth-place division standing say the same thing: this team is one or two breaks away from meaningful, and one or two bad weeks away from irrelevant.

JacobC25 didn't build this roster with one flashy move. They built it by being right more often than wrong, and the numbers back that up. Josh Allen at QB1 anchors the whole operation, and pairing him with Colston Loveland at TE3 gives this team a ceiling that most managers in the Mario Kart 64 division can't match. The back end of the draft is where the gap really shows: Bryce Young at QB26, Michael Pittman at WR44, and Khalil Shakir at WR51 all fell past their ADP and landed in JacobC25's lap while other managers were busy elsewhere. The one blemish worth noting is RJ Harvey, reached 3.5 rounds ahead of his ADP and now projected as the weakest starter on the board. That's a real cost. But one overpay in a draft that otherwise bent value consistently toward this team is a trade most managers would take. A 54th-percentile tournament projection and a fifth-place division ranking feel like a floor here, not a ceiling.

Blue Shell didn't light the draft board on fire, but they didn't need to. This is a roster built on the satisfaction of consistently coming out ahead, and a few moments stand out. CeeDee Lamb fell nearly two-thirds of a round before the manager pounced at pick 2.06, landing a WR5 projection at a meaningful discount. Tony Pollard slipped even further, more than a full round past his ADP, and Blue Shell was waiting. Anchoring the whole thing is Brock Bowers at TE1, a projected top-of-position asset who gives this lineup a ceiling that most managers in this field simply cannot match. The QB group is the one area where the draft summary tells a more complicated story, with reaches on Deshaun Watson and Kirk Cousins eating late capital for below-average projections, but in a positionless format the damage is manageable when the skill position talent runs this deep. Last year's 69th-percentile scoring says Blue Shell knows how to put points on the board. Fourth in the Mario Kart 64 division for now, but this team belongs in the conversation.

FFNateJahnke sits third in the Mario Kart 64 division and at the 94th percentile of the entire field, and the draft ledger explains why: no splashy gambles, just a steady accumulation of wins at the board. Puka Nacua came off at 1.06 when the field had him priced at 1.01, a minor slip that landed a WR1 in Jahnke's lap. Justin Jefferson followed at 2.07 against an ADP of 1.12, meaning Jahnke effectively got a WR6 at a round-plus discount. Luther Burden fell nearly a round and a half before Jahnke scooped him at 6.07, and Mark Andrews arrived at 10.07 after sliding nearly two rounds past his price. Four values, zero steals, and the roster looks like it. The projected starting group features Nacua, Jefferson, George Pickens, Tucker Kraft, Sam LaPorta, and George Kittle, a collection built less through fortune than through a drafter who kept recognizing when the board was offering something for less than it was worth and simply did not look away.

Im the best! didn't build this roster on one flashy swing. They built it by winning small battles, round after round. The clearest proof sits right in the backfield: Omarion Hampton at RB9 fell a full round and a half past his ADP before this team grabbed him at 4.09, and Bucky Irving at RB21 slid more than two rounds before getting scooped at 9.04. Neither pick required genius, just patience and a draft board that was actually correct. Pair those two with Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7, and the foundation here is genuinely hard to argue with. Brian Thomas Jr. at WR31 adds intrigue at a discount, though he arrives with something to prove after a 2025 that raised real questions about his chemistry with Trevor Lawrence. None of this is accidental. A 95th-percentile tournament finish and a second-place division standing reflect a manager who understood value before the rest of the room caught on, and who drafted accordingly.

dstyle02 didn't win the draft with one flashy move. They won it the same way a good poker player wins a session: by consistently getting slightly better than fair value, hand after hand. Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 anchors a starting group that also includes Drake London, taken at 3.03 when the board put him closer to a second-round pick, and Emeka Egbuka projecting out as WR18. Dak Prescott fell nearly two rounds past his WR and landed at 5.03, giving dstyle02 a QB7 projection at a discount that quietly shapes the whole roster. The one variable worth watching is Josh Jacobs, a projected RB16 starter whose offseason situation, an arrest without charges filed as of now, is still unresolved in ways that matter well beyond fantasy. If Jacobs clears that cloud, this team's floor rises considerably. The draft logged five values against zero major reaches, and the 2025 résumé backs the approach: 81 percent wins and a 91st-percentile scoring season. Division-leading teams in the Mario Kart 64 bracket don't usually get here by accident.
