There is no elegant way to spin a 13th-percentile projection and a last-place division ranking, so let's not try. OmNomNomStBrown built this roster around a genuinely exciting core, Joe Burrow at QB4 paired with Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 in a Goff-St. Brown stack that at least gives the team a coherent identity, but the draft process that got them here is hard to defend. Three major reaches dot the board, headlined by Jadarian Price pulled 3.6 rounds ahead of his ADP and Mac Jones taken more than five rounds early, and when reaches miss at that magnitude they tend to define a season in the worst way. The ceiling players are real, Derrick Henry at RB12 and Breece Hall at RB14 give the lineup genuine firepower, but a team sitting this deep in the field with no obvious undervalued asset left to flip is a team that has already played most of its cards. The math is not cruel, exactly, it is just indifferent, and indifferent math does not reverse course on its own.

Level 257 sits 11th in the Man division and in the 19th percentile of the field, and the draft record does not suggest a hidden correction is coming. The manager leaned on chalk almost exclusively, and the two moments of genuine aggression cut against the team: Bhayshul Tuten was taken 2.7 rounds early at RB25, and Rico Dowdle was grabbed 3.2 rounds ahead of schedule at RB32, a pair of reaches that consumed capital without landing difference-making talent. Meanwhile, the one real bargain of the draft, Jaxson Dart falling to QB11 two full rounds past his ADP, is a nice consolation prize in a format that rewards top-end firepower. Drake Maye gives the team a legitimate QB2 anchor, and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 is a genuine asset, but below those two the roster grades average across the board, with Rhamondre Stevenson projected as the weakest starting option. Coming off a 33

percent win rate in 2025, this team needed a bold, reconstructive draft and instead got a careful one. Careful does not fix 11th place.

DecafDreamer sits 10th in the Man division and in just the 19th percentile of the field, and the draft record offers little reason to dream of a turnaround. The team grabbed four values, including Jayden Daniels at QB5 and CeeDee Lamb at WR5, so the top of the roster is genuinely good. The problem is everything underneath it. Jonathan Taylor at RB4 cost a reach of nearly a full round, Travis Kelce at TE10 cost another 1.7 rounds early, and those debts compounded until the back end of the draft was spent papering over cracks with Jalen Nailor at WR61 and a Trey Benson pick so early it qualifies as the roster's one major reach despite Benson projecting as RB64. The projected weakest starter is Michael Pittman at WR44, which is not catastrophic on its own, but it tells you how thin the margin for error is. Lamb and Daniels can carry a team to the middle of the pack on a good week. They cannot carry it out of the bottom fifth of the tournament.

There is no pretty way to say this: ssn670 is staring at a rough 2026. Sitting ninth in the Man division and projecting in just the 21st percentile of the field, the roster's ceiling is almost entirely dependent on a wide receiver group that is genuinely strong, anchored by A.J. Brown at WR8, Nico Collins at WR9, and DeVonta Smith at WR14, all projected starters. The problem is that Brown, Collins, and Jameson Williams were all reached on in the draft, meaning ssn670 paid premium prices to build that strength while the rest of the roster quietly sagged. The backfield projects as a collective grind with no starter ranking better than RB36, and the most actionable lever, the Jalen Hurts and Smith stack, is already baked in. Hurts landing at QB9 as a genuine steal is a bright spot, but one well-timed value does not offset four major reaches scattered across a draft that reads like a manager who fell in love with receivers and hoped everything else would sort itself out. It did not.

Bengalsgirl1726 enters 2026 as the kind of team that looks better on paper than it projects in practice, and even on paper it ranks eighth in the Man Division and sits at just the 28th tournament percentile. The foundation is real: Ja'Marr Chase (WR2) is a genuine top-tier asset, and George Pickens (WR10) gives this roster a legitimate one-two punch at the position. But the receiving depth only goes so far when the players throwing them the ball are Jordan Love (QB17), Malik Willis (QB24), and Bryce Young (QB26), a quarterback room that projects as one of the weakest in the field. Love came at modest value, sure, but there is no avoiding the ceiling that a QB17 puts on a lineup. Compounding the problem is a draft board that logged two major reaches and zero steals, including Darnell Washington (TE38) taken more than five rounds early. This roster had one gear to shift into and bengalsgirl1726 appears to have already shifted it.

paytheprice enters 2026 sitting seventh in the Man division and projected at just the 37th percentile of the field, and the draft board does not offer much cover for that standing. The backfield looks like the team's foundation, with Saquon Barkley, Jeremiyah Love, Travis Etienne, and D'Andre Swift all projected as starters, but the price paid to build it matters. Love cost a 3.01 pick against an ADP of 4.05, Etienne was taken 1.5 rounds early, and Swift came off the board more than a round before the market did. That is a lot of draft capital spent ahead of schedule, and the receiver group is where it shows. Tetairoa McMillan grades out at WR15 and Brian Thomas Jr. at WR31, which is serviceable, but the group bottoms out at Khalil Shakir as the projected third starter at WR51. A 2025 finish in the 68th percentile of scoring suggests the engine can run, but this roster as constructed looks like a team that mortgaged flexibility for a backfield and is now hoping the ceiling holds.

A Slight Oops sits at 44th percentile and sixth in the division, which is exactly as unremarkable as it sounds, and yet the margins here are genuinely interesting. Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 is a legitimate difference-maker at the top, and the Caleb Williams and Rome Odunze stack gives this roster a ceiling that most middle-of-the-pack teams cannot touch. The problem is that the floor drops off faster than it should. Tony Pollard projects as the weakest projected starter at RB30, which is a fine player until you need him to carry weight on a bad week for Gibbs. The draft tells a similar story of small miscalculations compounding: Daniel Jones taken two full rounds before his ADP at QB25 is the kind of reach that costs you a round of real value, and Tory Horton pulled three-plus rounds early in the late rounds is a bet on upside that rarely pays at that cost. Nothing here is catastrophic, nothing is elite, and in a field this competitive, that is precisely where seasons slip away.

alphamalejmj didn't make headlines on draft day, but the results hold up under scrutiny. The backbone of this roster is a backfield anchored by Bijan Robinson at RB2 and De'Von Achane at RB6, a pair that gives this team a ceiling most managers would envy before they even get to the receiver group. Then sprinkle in the draft efficiency: Rashee Rice fell a full round past his ADP and landed at WR13, Brock Purdy slipped a round and a half and gives the team a QB13 option, and Jalen McMillan tumbled nearly three rounds to become a late-round dart with real upside. That is four players acquired at a discount without a single dramatic swing. The one blemish is Sam LaPorta, reached nearly three rounds early at TE8, though LaPorta's projected rank suggests the price, while steep, bought something real. A 58th-percentile tournament projection and fifth in the division is not a flashy landing spot, but this is a roster that drafted well and enters 2026 with legitimate room to outperform those numbers.

cbag didn't swing for the fences in the Scott Fish Bowl so much as they just kept making contact, and the cumulative effect is a roster that sits at the 64th percentile with a legitimate ceiling. The centerpiece is a receiving corps that reads like a coordinator's fever dream: Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3, Justin Jefferson at WR6, and Malik Nabers at WR12 are all projected starters, and cbag got Jefferson a half-round past his ADP, which counts as real money in a field this competitive. Tee Higgins, Terry McLaurin, and Mike Evans round out a projected starting group that gives this team a floor most managers would envy. Chris Godwin at WR38 came in nearly a round and a half late, adding quiet depth behind that already formidable group. The draft was not flawless, Cooper Kupp arrived four rounds ahead of market, and the position groups outside the receivers project thin, but this is a positionless format and the top of this roster is genuinely hard to beat. Fourth in the Man division for now, but the talent is there to climb.

Mossman07 lands at third in the division and the 75th percentile of the field, and the draft tells you exactly why: not one dramatic swing, just a series of quiet advantages that compounded round by round. The foundation is the tight end group, where Brock Bowers (TE1), Colston Loveland (TE3), and Tyler Warren (TE4) give this roster three of the top four players at the position, all projected starters. That kind of top-end concentration at any position wins weeks. Matthew Stafford (QB14) arrived a full round past his ADP, and his stack with Davante Adams (WR25) adds a correlation bonus that can turn a good week into a great one. Isaiah Likely (TE13) is worth watching too, reuniting with John Harbaugh in New York where the tight end role is wide open. The two major reaches on Tyreek Hill (WR77) and Keenan Allen (WR99) are real, but they are late-round gambles on a roster already built to compete, not load-bearing walls. This team did not need a heist. It just drafted well, consistently, and that is usually enough.

Bengalbugg lands at 92nd percentile in the field and second in the Man Division, and the draft chart explains exactly why: this roster was built on the back of consistent, quiet value accumulation. Puka Nacua at WR1 fell to the sixth pick of the first round when his ADP sat at first overall, a gift that any contender would take and most managers didn't see coming. Lamar Jackson at QB3 slid past his ADP as well, and pairing him with Justin Herbert at QB8 gives Bengalbugg elite upside under center without burning premium capital to get there. Marvin Harrison Jr. at WR33 arriving a round and a half late adds another projected starter who came cheaper than he should have. The two major reaches on Stefon Diggs and Calvin Ridley are real, and both managers and analysts will debate whether that late-draft aggression was necessary. But six values against two major reaches is a favorable ledger by any measure, and when the top of this roster is this well-stocked, Bengalbugg has every right to expect a long October.

wildcatrandy sits first in the Man Division and at the 98th percentile of the entire field, and the draft sheet tells you exactly why. The foundation is immaculate: Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and Trey McBride at TE2 give this roster two top-tier anchors before the conversation even gets interesting. Then comes the discipline. While other managers were still bidding up quarterbacks, wildcatrandy let the board come to him, landing Dak Prescott at QB7 a full two and a half rounds past his ADP and Patrick Mahomes at QB12 more than two rounds late. That is not luck, that is patience executed correctly. Kenneth Walker III at RB10 and Chase Brown at RB11 deepen a backfield that would be the envy of most rosters on its own, and the draft closed with seven values or better against just four minor reaches and zero major ones. The weakest projected starter is Jakobi Meyers at WR45, which is the kind of floor that wins leagues. Clean build, elite ceiling, very little to argue with.
