The Charleston Cheekbeaters drafted like someone who had a list of names they liked and a complete indifference to when those names should actually come off the board. Four major reaches across the draft is not bad luck, it is a philosophy, and it is a bad one. Cam Skattebo at RB20 getting yanked 2.3 rounds ahead of his ADP is the headline offense, but Aaron Jones at RB38 as the projected weakest starter and still taken 2.3 rounds early tells you the lesson was never learned. Justin Herbert at QB8 sounds fine until you remember that Josh Allen at QB1 was already on this roster, making Herbert a luxury item drafted like he was a necessity. The result is a team sitting third in the division with a 2025 record of 7-29 that suggests the underlying instincts have not improved with the calendar. There are no steals, one value, and six minor reaches padding out a roster that finishes in the 3rd percentile of the field. The Cheekbeaters did not get unlucky. They drafted their way here.

UCBearcat93 sits 11th in the NBA Jam division and in the 10th percentile of the field, and the draft log explains exactly how they got there. Six major reaches in a single draft is not bad luck, it is a philosophy, and a bad one. Josh Jacobs cost three rounds of draft capital above his ADP to land a projected RB16. RJ Harvey was yanked four full rounds early for a projected RB28. James Conner got taken 4.3 rounds ahead of schedule to become a projected RB56. The cumulative effect is a roster that paid premium prices for mid-range returns at nearly every turn, leaving almost nothing on the board worth celebrating. The one bright spot is Jaxon Smith-Njigba projecting as WR3, and the Burrow-Tee Higgins stack gives the team a pulse, but even Oronde Gadsden, a minor reach at TE16, now has David Njoku looking over his shoulder in Los Angeles. There is no charitable read available here. UCBearcat93 drafted with urgency and without judgment, which is the worst possible combination.

Jamesonrulez did almost everything right at the draft table, and the roster still lands at 10th in the NBA Jam division, which is the kind of outcome that makes a person stare at the ceiling. The process was sound: Mark Andrews fell more than a round past his ADP and lands as a projected TE14 starter, Baker Mayfield slipped two-plus rounds to serve as genuine depth at quarterback behind Lamar Jackson and Jalen Hurts, and nearly the entire board was taken at chalk or better. Fifteen chalk picks, two values, one steal, and the team still projects to the 33rd percentile. The issue is not the method, it is the math. CeeDee Lamb and Chris Olave are legitimate contributors, but the projected starters reflect a roster where doing everything correctly at the margins simply never produced a top-end difference-maker. Jamesonrulez played the Scott Fish Bowl like a patient, disciplined manager, got the prices right, and still ended up with a team that projects to struggle. The cruelest drafts are the ones that punish no particular mistake.

rrummel90 did almost everything right in the draft room and still landed at 9th in the NBA Jam division, which is the kind of outcome that makes you question the entire enterprise. The value discipline was real: Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 slid to pick 1.06, and Sam Darnold fell more than three rounds to 12.07, genuine gifts from a distracted field. But the two picks that define this roster are Quinshon Judkins and Jadarian Price, both grabbed more than two rounds ahead of ADP, both projected starters, and Jadarian Price projected as the weakest starter on the board at RB26. Reaching aggressively for running backs while the rest of the roster filled out on chalk is how you end up with a team that looks busy but projects at just the 36th percentile of the field. Chase and Tyler Warren at TE4 give this team a genuine ceiling, but a roster built on discipline that still surrendered two major reaches has to earn its way back to respectability, and the 2025 results at 33rd percentile in scoring suggest rrummel90 knows exactly how unforgiving that climb is.

whyareunvs didn't stumble into correlation, they built for it. The two live stacks here, Caleb Williams with Luther Burden and Jared Goff with Amon-Ra St. Brown, are the architecture, not the decoration. Williams checks in as QB6 and St. Brown as WR4, so the ceiling on those pairings is genuinely high, and when a stack works in the Scott Fish Bowl it works loudly. The draft strategy was aggressive in places: Breece Hall was taken 1.3 rounds early and Blake Corum came off the board a full 4.2 rounds ahead of ADP, which is the kind of conviction that either looks prescient in November or gets quoted back at you in the group chat. The engine is real. De'Von Achane at RB6 and Travis Etienne at RB18 give this team floor as the stacks develop. But correlation cuts both ways, and whyareunvs sitting 8th in the NBA Jam division at the 41st percentile tells you the field isn't waiting around to find out if Goff and St. Brown decide to have the same good week.

FaceMan81 finished 64th percentile in scoring last year and sits 44th percentile entering 2026, which is about as median as a roster can get without someone handing you a participation ribbon. The ceiling lives at the top: Justin Jefferson at WR6 and Malik Nabers at WR12 give this team a legitimate one-two punch that can carry a week, and Rashee Rice at WR13 arriving two rounds late in the draft is the kind of quiet win that pays dividends across a long season. The floor, though, is where the worry creeps in. Jordan Love and C.J. Stroud are projected QB17 and QB22 respectively, and in a positionless format, that kind of drag at the quarterback position costs points that Jefferson and Nabers have to cover. Tucker Kraft at TE5 is a real asset, but Hunter Henry projected TE18 as a second option offers little cushion if Kraft stumbles. FaceMan81 does not lose weeks badly, but probably does not steal many either, and in a field this competitive, that middle ground is a coin flip dressed up as a strategy.

Smitty1221 finished 89th percentile in scoring last season and returns to the Scott Fish Bowl sitting at 54th percentile projected, which tells you everything about how thin the margins are this year. The engine is real: Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and Saquon Barkley at RB8 give this roster a ceiling that most teams in the NBA Jam division simply cannot match at the top. The problem is what surrounds them. The receiver group peaks at Rome Odunze at WR30, and Chris Godwin projects as the weakest starter at WR38, which means Smitty1221 is asking its best players to carry more than their share every single week. The draft did not help much at the margins either: Bucky Irving was taken 2.2 rounds before his ADP, and Trey Benson was grabbed a staggering 6.5 rounds early, two bets that need to hit for this team to climb from sixth in the division. Jake Ferguson falling to pick 11.01 with an ADP of 8.05 was a genuine find, but one steal does not paper over two major reaches. This team wins if the stars play like stars and the gambles pay off. That is a lot of ifs for a roster sitting right in the middle of the field.

USS Kneecap Collector didn't win the draft with one flashy pick, they won it by consistently getting more than they paid for. Kyle Pitts at TE7 and George Kittle at TE9 both slid past their ADPs by more than a round, and Colston Loveland at TE3 fell nearly a full round before this team pounced, meaning three legitimate starters at tight end were acquired at a collective discount that quietly reshaped the value ledger. Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 anchor a backfield group that doesn't need luck to produce. The reaches are minor enough to forgive, with Jonathon Brooks at RB37 being the one spot where the manager got ahead of the market, but that's a single blemish on a draft that logged four positive-value picks and only one true overpay. The result is a team sitting at 64th percentile in the field, fifth in the NBA Jam division, with a roster built not on a single calculated gamble but on the compounding effect of a dozen small edges going the right way.

Shit Yeah The Achievers didn't build this roster on one splashy gamble. They built it by winning almost every exchange, and the results compound quietly. Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Kenneth Walker III at RB10 give this team an elite floor before it even gets to the skill positions, and Walker was actually a minor reach, meaning the manager wanted him badly enough to move early. On the other end of the ledger, Harold Fannin fell a round and a half past his ADP, and the Achievers were there to collect a TE6 at a discount. Yes, the Browns' quarterback situation is a mess, and the addition of rookie wide receivers means Fannin's target share isn't guaranteed, but his play last year was elite enough to earn that projection on its own merits. Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 and Zay Flowers at WR16 round out a starting group that projects as genuinely competitive. The team landed at the 65th percentile in the field, fourth in the NBA Jam division, and nothing about this roster suggests that ceiling is the limit.

There was no lottery ticket swing here, no moment where rboehmer rolled the dice on a broken-down star and got lucky. This was a draft built pick by pick, and the ledger reads cleanly: four good values, one major steal, and a grand total of three reaches across the entire board. The Matthew Stafford situation alone tells the story, a QB14 projection sliding to pick 9.07 while the rest of the room looked elsewhere. Drake Maye came at a similar discount, landing at 2.06 against an ADP of 2.02, which sounds minor until you remember that Maye projects as QB2. Pair that quarterback depth with Trey McBride at TE2 and Nico Collins at WR9, and rboehmer's projected starters carry real positional value at the top of the lineup. The team finished last season at the 100th percentile in scoring and sits 78th percentile heading into 2026, third in the NBA Jam division. The process was quiet. The results have not been.

sfidler lands in the 89th percentile of the field and second in the NBA Jam division, and the draft tells you exactly why: this roster was built pick by pick without any single moment of desperation or genius, just a steady accumulation of correct decisions. The foundation is genuinely elite, Brock Bowers at TE1 and James Cook at RB5 give sfidler two of the most valuable players on the board, and A.J. Brown arriving as WR8 when the board said he shouldn't still be there at pick 3.09 is the kind of quiet windfall that separates good drafters from lucky ones. Sam LaPorta falling nearly two full rounds past his ADP added TE8 as a legitimate second option. Where sfidler did reach, at Zach Charbonnet and Tony Pollard, the prices were paid in the back half of the draft where the cost of being wrong is minimal. The result is a team with no dramatic story to tell, just a lot of picks that came out ahead, which is exactly the kind of team that wins in May.

FantasyZeus didn't need a miracle pick to land at the top of the NBA Jam division, sitting at the 93rd percentile entering 2026. The foundation is a receiver corps that would make most managers genuinely uncomfortable to face: Puka Nacua at WR1, Drake London at WR7, and George Pickens at WR10 form a projected starting core that is simply hard to match, and all three were acquired at or past their ADP. Nacua, the crown jewel, slipped to WR1 despite an ADP of WR1, which sounds like a wash until you realize that in a field this competitive, landing him at all is the win. The Dak Prescott and Pickens stack adds a structural bonus that rewards the roster on correlated scoring weeks. Prescott himself fell nearly two rounds past his ADP before FantasyZeus grabbed him at QB7, which is the kind of patient, unflashy efficiency that defines this whole draft. Fourteen chalk picks, a handful of genuine values, and zero major reaches. The work was done quietly, and the standings reflect it.
