There is no version of this draft that flatters woody55255, and the numbers do not ask you to look for one. The headline disaster is Caleb Williams, taken at 1.09 despite an ADP of 3.06, a reach of nearly two rounds that consumed the most valuable real estate on the board for a QB6. That pick alone would define most bad drafts, but woody55255 kept going: Bucky Irving pulled almost three rounds before his ADP, Tyreek Hill grabbed nearly three and a half rounds early at what projects to WR77. Four major reaches across the draft is the kind of pattern that does not happen by accident, it happens when a manager is chasing names rather than reading a board. The receiver group as a whole sits at the bottom of the roster, with Hill, Jakobi Meyers at WR45, and Deebo Samuel at WR70 carrying the load. A 22nd-percentile scoring finish in 2025 suggested these problems were not new. The 2026 projection, sitting at the bottom of the Clash of Clans division, suggests they have not been solved.

There is no polite way to say this: Monkeyshines is staring at an 11th-place division ranking and a 9th-percentile tournament projection, and the draft did not do much to improve the outlook. Four major reaches punctuate a board that already graded out thin, and the most damaging of them came early. TreVeyon Henderson, reached three full rounds before his ADP, carries an RB19 projection that simply does not justify the draft capital spent to secure him. That is a problem that compounds at the top, where Matthew Stafford, for all his 2025 heroics, arrives in 2026 with the Rams already grooming his replacement and a ceiling that probably lands him closer to the QB14 floor than any upside number. Trey McBride as a projected TE2 is a genuine anchor, and Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 gives this roster something real to build around. But two players do not win a season at this level, and with the draft producing four major reaches and zero steals, Monkeyshines arrives without obvious reinforcements waiting in reserve.

There is no charitable read available for wissportsfan, a team sitting at the bottom of the Clash of Clans division and projected at just the 25th percentile of the field. The draft tells the story clearly: zero steals, zero values, and three major reaches in the final rounds that confirm a manager who panicked when the board went sideways. Reaching 3.5 rounds early on Chris Bell (WR87) and 3.2 rounds early on Emmett Johnson (RB54) are not aggressive moves, they are the picks of someone grasping at names they recognized. The top of the roster does offer Amon-Ra St. Brown (WR4) and Justin Jefferson (WR6), two genuinely elite starters, but Jefferson arrives with real uncertainty after a miserable 2025 alongside J.J. McCarthy in Minnesota, and whether Kyler Murray's arrival actually restores him to form is still an open question. Below that elite pair, the supporting cast crumbles fast, with Kyle Monangai projected as the weakest starter at RB33. This is a roster that needed everything to break right and drafted like nothing would.

jwhumble finished 2026 with an 11-25 record and ranked in the 29th percentile of scoring, and the 2026 outlook offers almost no reason to expect a different story. The roster grades out ninth in the Clash of Clans division and sits at the 30th percentile tournament-wide, a number that feels generous on close inspection. Josh Allen is a genuine anchor at QB1, and James Cook at RB5 gives this team a real floor, but the draft did nothing to push the ceiling upward: twelve chalk picks, zero steals, and a pattern of minor reaches that bought depth without buying quality. Braelon Allen, grabbed 2.2 rounds early, projects as RB58. Jack Bech, also taken 2.2 rounds ahead of his ADP, sits at WR94. The projected fifth starter is Jalen Coker at WR55, which is the kind of name you pencil in hoping something breaks right and then erase in October when nothing does. Allen and Cook are real, everything downstream of them is a prayer, and the draft supplied more of the latter than the former.

k0pectate drafted with discipline. Nearly every pick landed at or after ADP, the team collected Davante Adams at WR25 a full round late, Jerry Jeudy fell three rounds past his number, and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 anchors a starting group that looks genuinely useful on paper. And yet the roster sits eighth in the Clash of Clans division and in the 37th percentile of the field, which is the particular punishment the draft lottery hands out when you do everything right and the projections shrug anyway. The starting receiver group tops out at Adams, who is WR25, and Jordyn Tyson at WR34, and the tight end situation is an afterthought anchored by Dalton Schultz at TE22. Drake Maye arriving with AJ Brown for the first time gives the QB2 slot real upside, but upside requires everything else to hum. Right now this roster reads like a budget that balanced perfectly and still came up short, a ledger with no arithmetic errors and a negative balance all the same.

RyGuy5 is a team that will win exactly as many games as it deserves, which sounds like a compliment until you realize it isn't. The ceiling here is real: Nico Collins at WR9, George Pickens at WR10, and Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 form a core that can put up numbers on any given week, and a 61 percent win rate last season suggests this manager knows how to deploy talent. But the margins decide everything, and the margins point to Malik Willis. A QB24 projection is the kind of quiet anchor that drags a lineup down not in one catastrophic week but across a long season, in all the four-point losses and near-misses that separate a playoff team from a 48th-percentile finish. The draft offered no steals and no values, sixteen chalk picks and four minor reaches, which means RyGuy5 built exactly what the board offered and nothing more. Seventh in the Clash of Clans division feels about right: not a pushover, not a threat, just a very well-dressed team standing precisely in the middle of the room.

arudnicki enters 2026 sitting at the exact latitude where championships go to hibernate. The 53rd percentile is not irony, it is architecture. The ceiling here is real: Lamar Jackson at QB3 and Christian McCaffrey at RB3 give this roster two of the most dangerous players in the field, and a 2025 season that finished at the 75th percentile in scoring proves arudnicki knows how to extract points from talent. But the margins decide everything, and the margins are thin. The six projected starters beyond Jackson and McCaffrey range from Rashee Rice at WR13 down to Chuba Hubbard at RB29, and it is Hubbard who keeps showing up as the soft floor of this lineup. The draft was disciplined, 16 chalk picks and no major reaches, which reads as competence but not aggression. Sixth in the Clash of Clans division feels like the honest projection for a team built to beat the people below it and lose close games to the people above it, one unfortunate week at a time.

PeytonSparks finished 24-12 last year and enters 2026 sitting fifth in the Clash of Clans division, which is the part of this story that feels temporary. The roster they built suggests it should be. The draft board will tell you this team reached, and it is not wrong: Chris Rodriguez came off the board nearly three full rounds before his ADP, and Malik Nabers cost an extra round of capital to secure at WR12. What the board cannot tell you is whether those bets land, and right now the evidence leans toward yes. Nabers is a projected starter and a legitimate top-12 receiver, and pairing him with Puka Nacua (WR1) and Jaylen Waddle (WR23) gives PeytonSparks a tier of pass-catchers that most teams would not reach by accident. Then add Tyler Warren (TE4), Tucker Kraft (TE5), and Kyle Pitts (TE7) as projected starters, and the positional depth starts to look less like luck and more like someone who knew exactly what they were doing. The 64th percentile projection may catch up to them. The roster construction suggests it might be wrong first.

MrrsGiraldi didn't splash on one marquee move and coast. This roster was built pick by pick, and the cumulative effect is a team that projects to sit at 66th percentile in the field with a genuine case to climb. The receiver group alone could carry a bad week, with Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and Drake London at WR7 both slotting in as projected starters alongside DeVonta Smith at WR14. That is not luck, that is sequencing. Dak Prescott fell nearly a full round past his ADP, and he brings a stack with Jake Ferguson that adds a ceiling layer on top of an already stable foundation. Zach Charbonnet was another quiet win, sliding more than two rounds past his number before MrrsGiraldi made the call. The draft was almost entirely chalk, which gets a bad reputation it does not deserve when the chalk is this good. Fourth in the Clash of Clans division is the current projection, but the margin between here and first is thinner than that number implies.

shadesfan lands third in the Clash of Clans division and in the top 10 percent of the field, and the draft record explains why: one major value, four good values, and only one major reach across the entire board. The centerpiece is CeeDee Lamb, a WR5 projection who fell nearly a full round past his ADP to pick 2.07, the kind of slip that wins drafts before the third round is over. From there, shadesfan kept compounding the advantage, landing Chris Olave at WR11 and Tee Higgins at WR19 in a projected starting group that runs deep without ever requiring a miracle. Brock Bowers at TE1 is simply unfair, the sort of positional advantage that quietly tilts close weeks. The Jordan Love and Christian Watson stack adds a ceiling component, and while Jaydon Blue was taken six rounds ahead of his ADP, one reach on a 20-plus round board is barely a footnote. The weakest projected starter is Jordan Addison at WR43. That is the floor. shadesfan did not chase one big swing; the roster was built pick by pick, and it shows.

Japper didn't swing for the fences and miss, didn't mortgage depth for a single superstar, just drafted a roster that quietly came out ahead at every turn. Five values against zero steals tells the real story here: this team wasn't built on lightning, it was built on discipline. Patrick Mahomes at QB12 slipping to pick 6.11 is the kind of thing that happens when a manager stays patient and lets the board come to them, and Japper collected that patience dividend again with Sam LaPorta at TE8 and Dallas Goedert at TE15, both falling well past their ADPs into waiting hands. Layer in Bijan Robinson at RB2 and De'Von Achane at RB6 as projected starters, plus a receiving corps headlined by A.J. Brown at WR8 and Zay Flowers at WR16, and you have a team built on the unsexy premise that consistent execution beats heroism. A 94th-percentile scoring season in 2025 and a current tournament ranking of 93rd percentile suggest Japper isn't lucky, just good.

NickMimi did not win the Clash of Clans division by accident. Sitting at 94th percentile in the tournament field and first in the division, this roster got there the quiet way, through a draft that kept finding the right side of the ledger. Jonathan Taylor fell nearly a full round past his ADP and landed at RB4. David Montgomery slipped more than a round and gives NickMimi a projected starter at RB23. Neither pick required a bold move, just patience and positioning. Up top, Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 and Jayden Daniels at QB5 give this team the kind of ceiling anchors that make a good roster dangerous, and Travis Kelce and Isaiah Likely project as legitimate starters at TE10 and TE13 respectively. The 2025 campaign already validated this approach, with a 72nd percentile scoring finish and a winning record. The 2026 version is more talented and was assembled with the same disciplined eye. No heists, no regrets, just a draft that consistently came out ahead.
