The team, despite its youthful average age, seems to lack the veteran influence necessary to navigate the complexities of the competition. Choices that seemed savvy in the draft, like the value grabs of Blake Corum and Rashid Shaheed, are overshadowed by the costly reach for Joe Burrow, leaving fans questioning the tactical foresight of the management.

The division feels like a mountain yet to be climbed, with even minor victories feeling out of reach as they take their place on the field, backs against the wall, hoping for a season that defies expectations.

As Dabbin with Dabo embarks on the 2025 fantasy football season, the outlook appears bleak. With a division ranking of 11 and a dismal 19th percentile standing overall, expectations are low for significant improvement. The team's Achilles' heel remains their weak running back core, headlined by TreVeyon Henderson at RB21, which is unlikely to support the offensive firepower needed to climb the ranks. While their wide receiver lineup is undeniably impressive, boasting top talents like Amon-Ra St. Brown, Drake London, and Tee Higgins, it seems unlikely that they alone can carry the team to success. The tight end position does shine, with Trey McBride ranked TE2 in this TE Premium setup, but these few bright spots are overshadowed by glaring deficiencies elsewhere. The quarterback

situation is particularly dire, with Sam Darnold as the projected starter at QB28, a choice that seems baffling given his earlier-than-expected draft selection. Despite some savvy drafting moves, such as nabbing Caleb Williams later than expected, the team also made several questionable reaches. Overall, unless unexpected breakthroughs occur, Dabbin with Dabo faces another season of mediocrity, struggling to even match last year's disappointing performance.
