equipped to compete against more balanced rosters. As the season unfolds, Dirtydan2133 faces an uphill battle to claw back any semblance of competitive standing.

As the 2025 season approaches, the Bunch of Guys Named J.J. find themselves in an intriguing position. Having concluded last year with below-average results, they're looking to climb the ranks and improve upon their 39% win rate. With a current rank of 10 in their division, there's a clear need for improvement if they're to compete more effectively. The team is anchored by a robust quarterback lineup featuring Jayden Daniels, who holds a top-3 positional ranking, alongside J.J. McCarthy and Sam Darnold. This strong QB core could be the key to lifting them out of the lower tiers. Wide receiver Justin Jefferson delivers star power as WR2, supported by Jerry Jeudy, though the

duo has yet to see consistent top-tier performance reflected in their standing. However, concerns loom over their tight end situation. With Mike Gesicki projected as TE22, this position remains a potential weakness that might hinder overall effectiveness. The decision to reach for Aaron Jones and Jerry Jeudy slightly earlier than their average draft positions hints at strategic risks, while the significant leap taken for Pat Freiermuth raises questions about roster management. Despite these challenges, the small stack bonus from pairing Jefferson with McCarthy offers a glimmer of synergy that could spark some much-needed momentum. As they prepare for the new season, the Bunch of Guys Named J.J. will need to capitalize on their strengths and address their vulnerabilities if they hope to excel and push beyond the 32nd percentile mark they've found themselves in.
