the draft. With these questionable choices, ThatMetalJew is staring down the barrel of a long and difficult season filled with tough matchups and disappointment.

As they gear up for another challenging season, In-A-Gadda-Da-Vida must leverage their young roster's potential to climb out of the depths and make headway against more seasoned opposition.

Thomas Jr., offers some stack synergy, yet the team must overcome these draft missteps to contend. With a schedule filled with challenges and a roster that demands more than just flashes of brilliance, dsokol05's path to success will require deft management and perhaps a bit of luck.
