There is no charitable read available for JMees10, and the draft board confirms it. Five major reaches across the roster tell the whole story, and the cruelest ones land at the spots where drafts are supposed to be won. Cam Skattebo at RB20 cost nearly three rounds of premium capital, taken nearly three rounds before the market said he was worth it. Pat Freiermuth, projected TE30, came off the board almost five rounds early, an aggressive commitment to a player who ranks outside the top tier at his position. The anchor, Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4, is real, and Saquon Barkley at RB8 gives this roster a genuine floor, but the supporting cast was assembled at prices that left JMees10 buying wholesale in the late rounds when the shelves were already bare. The result is a team sitting third in the division with a projected finish in the third percentile of the field. That is not a projection shaped by bad luck. That is a draft that made its bed, round by round, and now has to sleep in it.

theJoelWirth came into this draft and somehow constructed a roster that reads like a cautionary tale written in real time. The quarterback situation is legitimately strong, with Lamar Jackson at QB3 and Jalen Hurts at QB9 both projected starters, and the stacks with Mark Andrews and Dallas Goedert add genuine upside. But the draft itself tells the real story: zero steals, zero values, twelve chalk picks, and two major reaches, one of which was MarShawn Lloyd at RB66 taken nearly four rounds before his ADP, and the other was Dontayvion Wicks at WR96, a player ranked outside the top 95 at his position, also grabbed nearly four rounds early. Those are not calculated gambles, those are the picks of a manager who panicked and paid full price for players nobody else was rushing to take. The projected weakest starter is Rico Dowdle at RB32, which is not a ringing endorsement of floor. A 33 percent win rate and a 16th-percentile scoring finish in 2025 set the table, and this draft did nothing to change the menu. Division rank tenth. Tournament percentile tenth. The numbers do not lie.

Rock N Roll Clowns sit 11th in the Johnny Napalm division and deep in the tournament's bottom tenth percentile, and the draft record offers little reason for optimism about how they got there. The team reached four players by a full round or more, including C.J. Stroud at QB22, who was pulled two-plus rounds early despite a concerning trend: after an explosive debut season in 2024, Stroud has spent the last two years backsliding, and even setting aside the concussion that cost him three games in 2025, his active-game production has drifted far from that early promise. Burning a seventh-round pick on a QB22 is a problem on its own, but the team also spent a second-round pick on Justin Herbert, projecting as QB8, which means a significant chunk of early capital went into a position this format doesn't reward with extra lineup slots. Christian McCaffrey at RB3 is a genuine anchor, and the receiving group has usable depth, but when your weakest projected starter is Khalil Shakir at WR51 and the draft log reads like a cautionary tale, there is no obvious lever left to pull.

Last year's Unsolicited Nix Picks went 27-9 and scored in the top 10 percent of the field. This year's version is projected to finish 27th percentile, ninth in the Johnny Napalm division, and the roster tells you why. The receiver group is genuinely excellent, Drake London at WR7, George Pickens at WR10, and Jaylen Waddle at WR23 forming a core that most managers would envy. But the rest of the roster reads like a team that ran out of draft capital before it ran out of rounds, and the draft board confirms it: two major reaches, Romeo Doubs taken more than three rounds early and Cooper Kupp nearly five rounds ahead of his ADP, with not a single steal to show for the aggression. Josh Allen is a legitimate anchor, and the stack with Dalton Kincaid could matter, except Kincaid's knee has been a persistent concern and the Bills' own front office won't commit to his availability. The reputation here is real. The 2026 team is a different conversation entirely.

WilliamMButtlicker finished 2026's draft looking like a team that bet everything on the backfield and forgot the rest of the board existed. The good news is that Bijan Robinson grading out at RB2 and Omarion Hampton at RB9 give this roster a legitimate foundation at the top. The bad news is that nearly everything else reads like a slow leak. Ladd McConkey at WR20 is the only receiver projected to crack the top half of his position, with Jakobi Meyers sitting at WR45 as the weakest projected starter on the whole team. David Njoku at TE29 barely registers. The draft process did not help matters either, with two major reaches, Bucky Irving taken 2.3 rounds early and Tyler Allgeier taken 2.5 rounds early, burning capital that could have addressed the receiver situation. A 3rd-percentile scoring finish in 2025 suggests this is not a team in transition so much as a team standing still, and at 36th percentile in the field heading into 2026, WilliamMButtlicker has very few levers left to pull.

Sean9393 sits at 45th percentile entering 2026, and that number tells the whole story before a single snap is taken. The margins are everything here. Drake Maye projects as QB2, and getting him at 2.06 when his ADP sat at 2.02 is not a dramatic steal, but in a field this competitive, half a round of value compounds over a season. Puka Nacua at WR1 fell nearly half a round past his ADP as well, giving Sean9393 a genuine anchor at the top of the lineup. The concern is that the roster does not have a second gear. Chris Olave at WR11 is a quality piece, but Matthew Golden projects as WR52 and figures to slot into the starting mix, which means Sean9393 is leaning on depth that can only hurt, not help. The AJ Barner reach at nearly three and a half rounds early adds a little anxiety to the tight end picture. Coming off an 8-28 season, this roster has the look of a team that goes exactly as far as Maye and Nacua carry it, and not one step further.

After finishing 2025 in the bottom 18 percent of the field with just 4,007 points, Brownie Bites arrives in 2026 looking like a completely different operation, and the numbers back that up. The foundation is a backfield headlined by Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and James Cook at RB5, two projected starters who give this team an elite ceiling before a single wideout is even considered. Kenneth Walker III at RB10 and Kyren Williams at RB15 add further firepower, and the draft work to land Cook and Williams at favorable prices shows a manager who did their homework. The receiving corps is lighter, but Christian Watson at WR28 pairs cleanly with Jordan Love at QB17 in a stack that could outperform their individual projections on a big Green Bay week. The Dulcich reach at pick 10.10 for a TE25 is the one head-scratcher in an otherwise disciplined draft, but it is a minor blemish on a roster that looks built to bounce back hard. Fifty-ninth percentile feels like a floor, not a ceiling, for this group.

jmeinerding did not stumble into correlation, they built for it. The spine of this roster is two deliberate stacks: Joe Burrow paired with Ja'Marr Chase, and Matthew Stafford paired with Davante Adams. Chase projects as WR2, and Burrow as QB4, so when that Cincinnati offense detonates, jmeinerding collects on both ends. The Stafford stack is the more interesting gamble. At 37, Stafford just won an MVP and set a career high in touchdowns, but the Rams drafted his successor in the first round, making this a last-hurrah partnership between a quarterback playing with something to prove and Adams, who at WR25 still has the tools to benefit from it. The rest of the roster, anchored by Tyler Warren at TE4, gives the lineup genuine upside even on weeks when the stacks run lukewarm. Coming off a 75th-percentile scoring season in 2025, this team lands in the 82nd percentile heading into 2026, and that jump makes sense. The ceiling here is real, but it has an address: Cincinnati and Los Angeles both have to show up.

FreeFries did not build this roster by swinging for the fences and missing. They built it by consistently getting more than they paid for, and the cumulative effect is a team sitting at the 83rd percentile in a loaded field. The centerpiece is Justin Jefferson, a WR6 projection that needs no sales pitch, but the draft around him is where FreeFries quietly separated itself. Nico Collins landed at WR9 after slipping more than a round past his expected price, and Tee Higgins fell nearly a round and a half before FreeFries snapped him up at WR19. Add Trey McBride at TE2, taken late in the first round after drifting past his ADP, and you have a draft that kept finding money on the floor other managers walked past. Travis Hunter slid nearly two rounds before being claimed at WR62. Six players taken later than consensus expected, zero major reaches. That is not luck compounding on luck. That is a manager who did the homework, stayed patient, and never talked themselves into overpaying.

The Cat Dad didn't need a single flashy moment to build one of the better rosters in the Johnny Napalm division. Sitting third in the division and in the 84th percentile of the field, this team got here the old-fashioned way: by repeatedly coming out ahead in the draft. Zay Flowers (WR16) and Jameson Williams (WR21) both fell over a round past their ADPs, turning rounds five and six into genuine surplus value, while Patrick Mahomes (QB12) slipping two full rounds was the kind of accident you happily accept. Brock Bowers (TE1) anchors the roster at the top of his position, and the supporting cast holds up. Bhayshul Tuten (RB25) is the name worth watching: with Travis Etienne gone to New Orleans and Jacksonville's backfield suddenly unsettled, Tuten's athletic profile and draft pedigree give him a real path to a featured role. None of this was built on one dramatic swing. It was built pick by pick, which is usually how the teams that last are built.

joedorsey972 lands at 89th percentile in the field and second in the Johnny Napalm division, and the draft record tells you exactly how it happened: not through a single lightning strike but through a sustained refusal to lose exchanges. The crown jewel is Malik Nabers, a WR3 projection scooped up at pick 6.07 when the board had him penciled in as a mid-third-round selection, a gap of nearly three full rounds between what the market said he was worth and what joedorsey972 actually paid. Pair Nabers with Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and Rashee Rice at WR13, both projected starters, and the receiving corps alone would make most managers nervous. Caleb Williams at QB6 anchors the quarterback room, and De'Von Achane at RB6 gives this team a legitimate top-ten backfield option. Twelve chalk picks kept the foundation solid while the values built around it, and a 2025 record of 21 wins against 15 losses suggests a manager who converts good rosters into actual results. The 2026 version looks like an upgrade.

There are drafts that look clean in hindsight and drafts that look clean in real time, and jbologna14 managed the rarer of the two. Sitting first in the Johnny Napalm division and in the 95th percentile of the entire field, this roster was built the way a good contractor builds a house: no wasted materials, no corners cut. Jonathan Taylor at RB4 and Derrick Henry at RB12 headline a backfield that collected value at nearly every turn, with Travis Etienne and Javonte Williams both sliding past their ADPs by more than a round apiece. Up top, CeeDee Lamb at WR5 and A.J. Brown at WR8 give the lineup a pair of projected starters who cost less than the board said they should. The draft sheet shows ten value picks against zero reaches, which is not luck, that is discipline. Harold Fannin projects as a TE6 starter, and after a 2025 that produced a 97th-percentile scoring season, the evidence strongly suggests jbologna14 knows exactly what they are doing.
