There is no charitable read available for LifeLessons, a team sitting at the bottom of the Cloud Strife division and projecting in the 12th percentile of the field, and the draft sheet explains exactly why. Four major reaches across 20 rounds is a special kind of self-sabotage: Alvin Kamara at RB50 was taken more than four rounds before his ADP, Theo Johnson at TE37 cost four rounds of premium capital to land a backup tight end, and RJ Harvey at RB28 was drafted two and a half rounds early as if LifeLessons had insider information the rest of the field did not. The result is a roster that spent early resources on late-round outcomes. CeeDee Lamb at WR5 and Trey McBride at TE2 are genuinely excellent anchors, and Kenneth Walker III at RB10 gives the team a real foundation, but reaching four times in a single draft is how you turn a promising core into a cautionary tale. LifeLessons learned several lessons in this draft. Unfortunately, none of them were the right ones.

Bahamut Zero enters 2026 sitting 11th in the Cloud Strife division and down in the 16th percentile of the field, and the draft board does not offer much reason for optimism. The real damage shows up in the reach column: three major reaches in a single draft is genuinely difficult to survive, and two of them landed at quarterback. Cam Ward at QB23 cost an 8th-round pick against an ADP that said wait until the 10th, and Kirk Cousins at QB35 was yanked off the board nearly five rounds ahead of schedule in the 14th. Those are not calculated gambles on upside, they are rounds that cannot be reclaimed, and they left the manager leaning on Ward as the projected starter at a position where the ceiling is already modest. James Cook at RB5 and Derrick Henry at RB12 give this roster a legitimate backfield foundation, but when the draft capital spent chasing quarterbacks who grade out this low is factored in, the math gets grim fast. There is no obvious lever left to pull here.

There is no gentle way to say this: KnightsoftheRound Leather is sitting at the bottom of the Cloud Strife division, projected in just the 20th percentile of the field, and the draft did not provide the kind of ammunition needed to climb out. The most glaring issue is the quarterback room, where the manager reached 1.4 rounds early for Brock Purdy (QB13) and then compounded the problem by taking Kyler Murray (QB19) a full 2.2 rounds before his ADP. Two major reaches at one position, and the payoff is a QB13 and a QB19, neither of which grades as elite. Christian McCaffrey (RB3) and A.J. Brown (WR8) give this roster a legitimate foundation, and Rashee Rice (WR13) and Marvin Harrison Jr. (WR33) provide real depth behind them. But when the projected floor starter is Chigoziem Okonkwo at TE19, and early capital was burned chasing quarterbacks who landed in the middle of the pack anyway, KnightsoftheRound Leather looks like a team that spent its best picks solving the wrong problem.

AirDemon sits ninth in the Cloud Strife division and projects at just the 30th percentile of the field, and the roster itself explains why there is not much room for optimism. The RB group is legitimately deep, with Jonathan Taylor (RB4), Josh Jacobs (RB16), and David Montgomery (RB23) all projecting as starters, but depth is only valuable if the players at the top of the lineup are elite, and that is where this roster loses the argument. Justin Jefferson (WR6) and Malik Nabers (WR12) are genuine difference-makers, but beyond them the receiving corps falls off sharply to Courtland Sutton (WR37) and Hunter Henry (TE18), neither of whom moves the needle at tournament level. The draft offered little corrective medicine: ten chalk picks, four minor reaches, and a James Conner (RB56) taken nearly four full rounds ahead of his ADP. This roster is not one injury away from trouble; it is already in trouble, and there is no obvious lever left to pull to change that projection.

Red 13 Personnel won 75 percent of their matches last year and scored in the 87th percentile, so the reputation is real. The projection, sitting at 33rd percentile and eighth in the Cloud Strife division, suggests that reputation is doing a lot of heavy lifting right now. The receiver group is the one area that still looks the part, with Puka Nacua at WR1, Garrett Wilson at WR17, and Ladd McConkey at WR20 all projecting as starters, and a Herbert-McConkey stack adding a small structural bonus. But the draft process raises questions. Justin Herbert was taken a full round ahead of his ADP, Rhamondre Stevenson was reached on by two rounds and lands at RB31, and the board shows zero steals and only one value across fifteen chalk selections. That is not the draft of a team trying to climb, it is the draft of a team coasting on a brand. Last year's version of this roster earned that 87th percentile finish. This version will have to prove it is something more than a fond memory.

The7Htrain boards the Cloud Strife division at 37th percentile and quickly discovers the brakes are out. The draft is the core problem: six major reaches against zero steals is the kind of draft chart that makes evaluators wince, and the damage shows up in the projected lineup. Patrick Mahomes grades out as QB12, a reach of more than two rounds from his ADP, and Tua Tagovailoa cost a similar premium to land at QB31, which means two picks that could have built starter-caliber depth elsewhere were spent on a QB room that delivers one good option and one mediocre one. Down the roster, Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and Joe Burrow at QB4 are legitimately excellent, and Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 keeps the floor from completely collapsing, but the projected starter pool bottoms out at Jayden Higgins at WR54, and there is no obvious upgrade path hiding in the late rounds. The7Htrain is not without talent. It is, however, without margin, and in a field this competitive, those are nearly the same thing.

Cait Sith Njigba sits at the 51st percentile and sixth in the Cloud Strife division, which is another way of saying this roster will be decided by inches. The foundation is genuinely impressive: Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3, George Pickens at WR10, Chris Olave at WR11, and DeVonta Smith at WR14 give this team a projected starting core that can hang with anyone in the field. Trevor Lawrence projects as a QB10 with Matthew Stafford as a capable alternative, so the position is covered without being spectacular. The concern is at the margins, which is precisely where this season gets decided. The weakest projected starter is Michael Pittman at WR44, a minor reach who now has to earn his spot every week. The draft itself was almost entirely chalk, with 16 of 20 picks landing right at consensus value, meaning there are no hidden gems propping up the back end. When your ceiling is clear and your floor depends on Pittman, the season becomes exactly as simple as that sounds.

Emekald Weapon didn't need a heist to build this roster, just a draft that kept winning small. The headliner is Ja'Marr Chase at WR2, a projected starter who gives the team a genuine top-shelf anchor, and he's surrounded by a starting group that includes Colston Loveland (TE3), Tucker Kraft (TE5), and George Kittle (TE9), a tier of tight end depth that would make most managers quietly furious. Travis Kelce rounds that group out at TE10, and the Kelce situation is worth noting: after real uncertainty about whether he'd return in 2026, he's back and chasing a spot in the top-12 conversation, which makes him exactly the kind of value pick that moves a roster from fine to formidable. Kelce came off the board at 9.02 against an ADP of 7.05, a round and a half of free equity. The Daniel Jones reach at pick 7.02 is the one blemish on an otherwise clean sheet, but when your floor looks like this roster's floor, one swing-and-miss at quarterback doesn't move the needle much. Sitting 58th percentile in the field right now, Emekald Weapon has the pieces to climb.

fantasycloud did not win the draft with one flashy moment. They won it pick by pick, and the ledger shows it: 15 chalk selections grounded the roster in reliable value, while the two players who fell past their ADP quietly elevated the ceiling. Alec Pierce landing at WR32 a full round later than expected is exactly the kind of patience that separates disciplined drafters from lucky ones, and Brenton Strange slipping to the TE17 slot at pick 11.01 after an ADP of 9.11 means the backend of this starting lineup costs less than it should. Layered on top of that foundation are Josh Allen at QB1 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7, a one-two punch that gives fantasycloud an elite floor before the rest of the lineup is even considered. The result is a team sitting in the 68th percentile of the field and fourth in the Cloud Strife division, not because of a single swing that happened to connect, but because almost nothing in this draft went wrong.

Shin-ra St. Browns did not stumble into a 75th-percentile roster. They built it, pick by pick, with the kind of draft discipline that makes the rest of the Cloud Strife division uncomfortable. Nineteen picks went chalk or better, zero went as reaches, and the values were not incidental. Tyler Warren fell more than a round past his ADP and landed as the TE4. Oronde Gadsden slipped nearly three rounds and gives this team a projected TE16 as a secondary option at a position where most managers are scraping. That is not luck, that is a manager who knew the price of everything and waited. Meanwhile, the projected starters read like a highlights reel: Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4, Drake London at WR7, Jalen Hurts at QB9, Sam LaPorta at TE8, all in the lineup. The weakest projected starter is Chris Godwin at WR38, which tells you everything about the floor of this roster. Third in the division is the current standing, but this team is built to move.

Avalanche of Sector 7 didn't swing for the fences on any single pick, and that's precisely what makes this roster dangerous. The foundation is a backfield anchored by Bijan Robinson (RB2) and De'Von Achane (RB6), both projected starters, with Achane arriving a full round after his ADP suggested he would. Then the draft just kept compounding. Javonte Williams fell more than two rounds past his ADP and landed as RB17, a projected starter who cost the price of a late-middle pick. Quinshon Judkins and Jameson Williams both slipped past their expected windows as well, and Jameson pairs neatly with Jared Goff in a stack that gives the lineup a built-in upside mechanism on the weeks it clicks. Three values and a major steal woven across the draft, eleven picks taken at or near consensus, and the team still landed four projected starters in a field where consistent execution is rare. Sitting second in the Cloud Strife Division and at the 86th percentile of the field, this is what a disciplined draft looks like when it comes together.

Omnislash did not stumble into a 94th-percentile finish. This is a roster built with patience and precision, and the draft board tells the story plainly: seven players acquired at or better than market value, zero major reaches, and a pair of steals that would make any seasoned SFB manager nod in quiet approval. Bucky Irving landing at RB21 two-plus rounds after his ADP is the kind of inefficiency most managers only dream about finding, and Harold Fannin at TE6 slipping more than a round past his number gives this team a genuine dual-threat at the position alongside Brock Bowers at TE1. That is not depth for depth's sake, that is a manager identifying value and taking it without hesitation. The top of the lineup is the real argument, though: Lamar Jackson as a QB3 starter, Saquon Barkley at RB8, Breece Hall at RB14, and Bowers anchoring the tight end position as the top-ranked player there. Omnislash leads the Cloud Strife Division for a reason. Clean drafts produce clean records.
