There is no polite way to say this: mmidlikowski is in trouble. Last season ended at the 11th percentile in scoring with a 6-30 record, and the 2026 roster, sitting dead last in the Cloud Strife division and at the 19th percentile of the field, does not inspire much confidence that the trajectory is changing. The draft was cautious to a fault, producing zero steals and leaning almost entirely on chalk picks, with the one notable exception being Travis Etienne falling to RB18 value at a mild discount. The upside anchors are real, Lamar Jackson at QB3 and Saquon Barkley at RB8 are legitimate studs, and the Joe Burrow and Tee Higgins stack adds a cute wrinkle. But the depth falls off quickly, and two major reaches, Chimere Dike taken nearly four rounds before his ADP and Jake Tonges grabbed nearly three rounds early, suggest the manager was scrambling to paper over weaknesses in the late rounds rather than finding actual value. When your projected weakest starter is Hunter Henry at TE18, your floor and your ceiling are closer together than you would like.

There is no sugarcoating what the numbers say about XIII: an 11th-place division ranking and a 32nd-percentile tournament standing paint a bleak picture before a single snap is played. The receiver group is genuinely elite, with Puka Nacua projecting as WR1, Malik Nabers at WR12, and Emeka Egbuka at WR18 giving this roster a top-heavy shine that flatters the overall grade, but the quarterback situation undercuts almost all of it. Jared Goff comes in as a QB16 after the manager burned a fourth-round pick to get him, a reach of nearly a round and a half that looks worse the longer you stare at it. Baker Mayfield profiles as a QB18, and his situation in Tampa has only murkier since Mike Evans walked in free agency, leaving genuine doubt about whether he can claw back toward his 2024 form. Two quarterbacks who project outside the top fifteen, both acquired with draft capital that could have gone elsewhere, and a 2025 campaign that finished in the 18th percentile in scoring. XIII is not one move away from contention. It is several.

Gold Chocobo did almost everything right by the draft sheet. Seventeen chalk picks, one legitimate steal in Woody Marks falling nearly three rounds past his ADP, and a roster that came together without much financial bleeding. And yet here the team sits at 36th percentile, tenth in the Cloud Strife division, because being efficient with your picks only matters if the picks themselves are good enough. The foundation is genuinely impressive: Chase Brown at RB11, Kyren Williams at RB15, Josh Jacobs at RB16, and Cam Skattebo at RB20 represent a remarkable concentration of projected value, and CeeDee Lamb at WR5 paired with Justin Jefferson at WR6 gives the manager two of the best receivers in the field. But in a positionless format where you start your ten best players, the ceiling of this roster is determined by what sits outside the elite tier, and the answer is not much. Tony Pollard at RB30 is the weakest projected starter. The quarterback room is a wasteland. Drafting well and building a mediocre team is the cruelest kind of irony the game produces.

UnicornBolt enters 2026 sitting ninth in the Cloud Strife division and in just the 38th percentile of the field, and the roster does not offer much reason for optimism. The foundation looks decent on paper: Jahmyr Gibbs projects as RB1, and Nico Collins, DeVonta Smith, Garrett Wilson, and Rome Odunze give the team legitimate receiver depth. But beneath that surface layer the drop-off is steep. Wan'Dale Robinson, the projected weakest starter at WR47, is the kind of player you are hoping does not see the field in a meaningful week, not the kind you are counting on. The draft did little to change the trajectory. Twelve chalk picks and two major reaches, including Tory Horton at WR93 taken more than three rounds early, suggest a manager who ran out of conviction and started guessing in the later rounds. There is one legitimate steal in RJ Harvey at RB28, but a single late-round find is a life raft, not a rescue. The ceiling here is just not high enough to dream on.

JTivs9 lands in the Cloud Strife division sitting 8th and at just the 38th percentile of the field, and the roster construction offers little reason for optimism. The receiver group is legitimately elite, anchored by Ja'Marr Chase (WR2), A.J. Brown (WR8), and George Pickens (WR10), and that trio alone could carry a team deep in any given week. The problem is that beyond those receivers, the cupboard gets thin in a hurry, and the draft decisions that were supposed to fill in the gaps made things worse. Daniel Jones, projected QB25, was taken at pick 7.01 against an ADP of 11.05, a reach of over four rounds that burned premium draft capital on a quarterback who grades out as a borderline starter at best. Chuba Hubbard, the projected weakest starter on the roster at RB29, was the one player who came as a genuine late-round value. One steal does not offset two major reaches. Chase and Brown can win individual weeks, but JTivs9 has essentially no lever left to pull when they don't.

DFSKyle did almost everything right in the draft room and still walked out holding a roster that lands 7th in the Cloud Strife division and in the 42nd tournament percentile, which is the kind of outcome that makes you question whether the game is fair. The discipline was real: 18 chalk picks, two genuine values, zero reaches anywhere on the board. Blake Corum fell 1.4 rounds past his ADP and DFSKyle was there to take him. Sam Darnold dropped a full round and landed in this lineup at QB21. Patient, correct, unrewarded. The problem is not the process, it is the ceiling. Jonathan Taylor anchors the group at RB4, and Trey McBride projects as TE2, but the receiving corps thins out fast after Tetairoa McMillan, and Matthew Golden projects as the WR52 and still draws a starting role. When your draft discipline produces nothing better than Golden as a projected weekly contributor, the math was simply never going to work, no matter how clean the card looked going in.

ChadS-MN is the kind of team that makes bracket-watchers glance twice and then move on, which is exactly the margin by which this season gets decided. The core is quietly compelling: Brock Bowers at TE1 and Kyle Pitts at TE7 give the lineup a ceiling that most managers in this field cannot match at that position, and Drake Maye landing as a QB2 means the quarterback spot is not where points get left on the table. The problem is that the floor keeps dipping at the edges. Jordan Addison projects as the weakest projected starter at WR43, and the decision to take Jaxson Dart in round three against an ADP of round five reads less like bold conviction and more like dead capital that could have shored up the margins instead. Last year's 56 percent win rate and a 55th-percentile scoring finish is the template here: good enough to beat who you should beat, not quite enough to steal one from the contenders. Sixth in the Cloud Strife division feels about right, and right is the most uncomfortable place to be.

Orashna finished this draft at the 61st percentile, sitting fifth in the Cloud Strife division, and the paper trail looks a little reckless: three major reaches, zero steals, and a manager who apparently decided that ADP was a suggestion rather than a guide. But here is the thing, the roster is genuinely good anyway. Josh Allen at QB1 anchors everything, and the Herbert-McConkey stack gives Orashna a secondary engine with real upside if Justin Herbert continues trending toward his ceiling. The reaches are the story everyone will tell about this draft, and Cade Otton and David Njoku pulled from rounds earlier than consensus would endorse is hard to defend on paper. But the top of this lineup is legitimate, and in a positionless format the depth at receiver, where Ladd McConkey, Christian Watson, and Brian Thomas Jr. all project as starters, gives Orashna real flexibility. The one place optimism has to pause is Stefon Diggs, the weakest projected starter, who signed with Washington in August after returning from a 2024 ACL injury, which is a late landing spot with upside but not a sure thing. Conviction or fortune, this roster works.

CouchScoutsCoop didn't win the draft with one splashy pick. They won it by never really losing a round. The backbone here is a backfield group that reads like a coordinator's dream: Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 give this roster a floor most managers would build an entire strategy around, and Jeremiyah Love (RB13) and TreVeyon Henderson (RB19) keep the quality from tailing off. At quarterback, Jayden Daniels (QB5) gives the team an elite option whenever it matters most. The receiver group is thinner in projection, with Carnell Tate (WR29) leading a group that bottoms out at KC Concepcion (WR50) as the projected weakest starter, but in a positionless format, depth at the top of the roster absorbs that. The 2025 campaign came in at the 57th percentile, a respectable but not dominant baseline. This roster is constructed to do better. Landing at 63rd percentile in the tournament and fourth in the Cloud Strife division reflects a team that drafted with discipline, not desperation, and that tends to age well as a season unfolds.

Camlawfff drafted like someone who did their homework and then actually followed through on it, which puts them ahead of roughly a third of this field before a single game is played. The tight end group alone could carry a lesser roster: Colston Loveland at TE3, Harold Fannin at TE6, and Mark Andrews at TE14 give this team a positional advantage that compounds every single week. Layer on top of that the Patrick Mahomes and Rashee Rice stack, a Christian McCaffrey who projects as RB3, and Chris Olave and Rashee Rice running as WR11 and WR13 respectively, and the top of this roster is genuinely difficult to pick apart. Where Camlawfff really earns its draft grade, though, is in the details: Javonte Williams fell a full round past his ADP to land at pick 7.07, and Jaylen Warren slid more than two rounds to become the steal of the draft at 12.06. Fifteen chalk picks, three good values, one steal, and zero major reaches. That is not luck, that is discipline. Third in the Cloud Strife division at the 67th percentile, and the arrow is pointing up.

Bam Knights of the Round didn't swing for the fences and whiff, they just kept making the right call, round after round. The headliners are legitimate: Jaxon Smith-Njigba projects as WR3, De'Von Achane sits at RB6, and Derrick Henry checks in at RB12, giving this roster a top-end core that most managers would sign for immediately. What separates a good draft from a great one, though, is whether the back half holds up, and this one does. J.K. Dobbins fell more than two rounds past his ADP and lands as a projected RB36 starter, exactly the kind of quiet win that props up a lineup when injuries come calling. Travis Kelce spent the offseason flirting with retirement before officially returning, and at TE10 he gives this team a safety net at a position where depth evaporates fast. No wasted picks, no panicked reaches, just a steady accumulation of value that earned Bam Knights a spot at 67th percentile in the field and second in the Cloud Strife division. Steady wins the draft, and this team was very, very steady.

poppykimish didn't win the draft with one big swing. They won it by being right more often than wrong, and the evidence is threaded throughout the roster. Omarion Hampton lands as RB9 despite slipping a full round past his ADP, and Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and Drake London at WR7 give this team a receiver corps that would make most managers quietly reconsider their own choices. The values kept coming: David Montgomery fell nearly two rounds before poppykimish scooped him at RB23, and Aaron Jones dropped two and a half rounds to land at RB38. None of these picks made highlights. All of them made the roster better. The one blemish worth noting is Mason Taylor, reached for roughly three and a half rounds early, though a TE35 projection means the cost exceeded the return. Still, the division is already theirs, sitting first in Cloud Strife with an 84th percentile projection, and a team built on cumulative advantages tends to hold up. This one looks built to hold up.
