Compounding their woes, questionable draft decisions have haunted the PetFries, as they reached for players like Justin Herbert and Breece Hall far ahead of their average draft positions, sacrificing valuable opportunities to strengthen their

lineup. Trey Benson's dubious status as a starter only exacerbates the fragile state of affairs. Even as Justin Fields, a shrewd acquisition, seeks to revitalize their fortunes in tandem with Wilson, the path ahead seems fraught with uncertainty and dwindling optimism. The once vibrant dreams of repeat glory now seem like distant echoes, replaced by a season poised on the precipice of despair.
