There is not much to soften the blow here: the Warwickshire Falcons grade out at the 6th percentile of the field and sit 12th in the Combat Division, and the roster does not hide why. The QB situation is a quiet disaster, with Jaxson Dart (QB11) and Baker Mayfield (QB18) projecting as the starters, both taken before their ADPs, neither capable of carrying a lineup on volume alone. The draft did not generate the surplus value that might bail out a thin build, logging just one steal against six reaches, including a major one on Greg Dulcich (TE25), a tight end taken three full rounds ahead of his ADP who projects as the team's weakest starter. James Cook (RB5) and Drake London (WR7) are genuine assets, but two premium players cannot redistribute themselves across ten starting spots. This roster is a building project dressed up as a contender, and the Scott Fish Bowl is not a league that waits around while you figure that out.

BerniesBums drafted like someone who had a plan and then immediately abandoned it, and the board confirms every suspicion. The carnage starts at the top: Omarion Hampton at RB9 is a fine player, but taking him 0.8 rounds ahead of his ADP in a positionless format means BerniesBums paid a premium for a player the market hadn't even reached for yet. It gets worse. Mac Jones, projected QB39, was yanked off the board nearly five rounds before anyone else wanted him, a move so aggressively wrong it almost loops back around to being impressive. The draft chart shows zero steals, eleven chalk picks, and three major reaches, which is less a draft strategy and more a controlled demolition. Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 is a genuine asset and keeps this from being a total write-off, but one elite piece cannot paper over a roster built on overpayments and wishful thinking. BerniesBums sits 11th in the Combat division, and right now nothing in the draft suggests that ranking is unfair.

Zeus sits 10th in the Combat division and in just the 21st percentile of the field, and the draft offers almost no reason for optimism. The roster produced zero steals and just one value across 20 picks, a telling sign that the margins were never there to begin with. The pillars are real: Brock Bowers projects as TE1, Ashton Jeanty grades out at RB7, and Zay Flowers and Emeka Egbuka give the team a pair of viable starting receivers at WR16 and WR18. But the depth behind that core is where the season quietly unravels. Jayden Higgins, the weakest projected starter, checks in at WR54, reached 1.8 rounds early, and is being asked to hold down a starting spot. Jacoby Brissett, a QB28 taken two full rounds before his market price, is the kind of dart that needs to hit for this roster to have any cushion at all. It almost certainly will not. Zeus has the bones of a team that finished its draft and hoped for the best, and hope is not a strategy.

Deadmoney enters the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl sitting ninth in the Combat Division and at the 26th tournament percentile, and the draft record does not suggest a hidden turnaround is coming. Five major reaches dot the board, including Kenneth Walker III pulled nearly a round and a half before his ADP and RJ Harvey scooped up almost two and a half rounds early despite landing in exactly the kind of Denver committee backfield that eats fantasy value alive, with JK Dobbins back and Jonah Coleman added in the fourth round to further muddy the waters. The receiver group grades weak, with Jordan Addison the lone bright spot after sliding to pick 12.01 despite a WR43 projection. Jayden Daniels and Trey McBride give the team a legitimate QB5 and TE2 anchor, and both were acquired at genuine value, but two strong anchors cannot carry a roster this thin at the margins. Deadmoney is not a team looking for the right bounce. It is a team hoping enough rosters above it simply collapse first.

RobGzz is sitting at the 31st percentile and ranking eighth in the Combat division, and the roster tells you exactly why. The top of the lineup is genuinely good: CeeDee Lamb at WR5, Jonathan Taylor at RB4, and Justin Herbert at QB8 give this team a core that most managers would envy. The problem is what happens after that. Tony Pollard projects as the weakest starter at RB30, which is a long way down from Taylor, and the drop-off matters because depth only helps if the players in it are worth starting. Meanwhile, the draft board offers little comfort. RobGzz posted zero steals on the season, and the one move that stands out for the wrong reasons is Geno Smith, a QB30 taken more than two rounds early at pick 12.02. In a positionless format where roster quality compounds across every slot, reaching for a fringe quarterback that high is the kind of decision that quietly poisons a team, and RobGzz may be drinking from that well all season.

jmcgee93 played the value game about as well as a drafter can without it actually mattering, which is its own kind of tragedy. Joe Burrow at QB4 slid two picks past his ADP and landed in the second round, Courtland Sutton fell two full rounds before being claimed, and Aaron Rodgers came two rounds late at a cost of nearly nothing. Twelve chalk picks and a handful of steals should produce a roster that hums, and yet the team sits 41st percentile and seventh in the Combat Division, projecting like a well-organized filing cabinet nobody needs to open. The issue is not the process, it is the ceiling. Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and Malik Nabers at WR12 headline a group that is solid across most of the depth chart but never quite erupts into something frightening, and the projected weakest starter, Makai Lemon at WR40, is a real sentence that real people must contend with. jmcgee93 bought everything at a discount and still cannot quite afford what they need.

Luvtocook sits at 47th percentile heading into 2026, which is another way of saying the margins decide everything. The foundation is legitimately good: Christian McCaffrey at RB3, De'Von Achane at RB6, and Chase Brown at RB11 give this roster a ceiling that most Combat division opponents would trade for, and Tee Higgins at WR19 and Mike Evans at WR27 round out a starting core that can compete on any given week. Evans is the interesting case here, arriving in San Francisco after injuries limited him to eight games last season and snapped an 11-year consecutive 1,000-yard streak, so projecting him as WR27 requires some faith that a change of scenery restores him. That faith is baked in. Where the margins tighten is at the back of the roster, where the draft skewed chalk across 16 picks and produced little upside insurance. Kaytron Allen was taken nearly three rounds early. When

McCaffrey and Achane are humming, none of that matters. When they are not, Luvtocook has very little room for error.

Keep on truckin sits fifth in the Combat Division and around the 55th percentile of the field, numbers that undersell what is quietly a well-constructed roster. The foundation is Bijan Robinson, a projected RB2, and the kind of player who makes a team competitive before you even scroll past the first round. Kyren Williams at RB15 and David Montgomery at RB23 keep that momentum going, meaning the team is not leaning on its depth to bail out its top end, its top end is just good. The receiver group follows the same pattern, with Chris Olave at WR11 and Ladd McConkey at WR20 both projecting as starters and neither requiring any creative optimism to justify. The most intriguing subplot is the Tyler Shough and Olave stack. Shough projects as a QB20, which is modest, but the talent around him in New Orleans is real, Olave is a genuine WR1 when healthy, and a second year of polish could push that pairing into a weekly weapon. Keep on truckin did not win the draft with fireworks. It won by being right, repeatedly.

kjesbo didn't build this roster with one flashy move, they built it by quietly coming out ahead over and over again. The headliner is Josh Allen, a QB1 who slid nearly a full round past his ADP before kjesbo scooped him at 2.03, and pairing him with a Justin Jefferson and Kyler Murray stack only adds to the upside of an already sound foundation. From there, the draft reads like a steady accumulation of small wins: Dallas Goedert at TE15 fell a full round before being claimed, and Malik Willis provided late-round depth at a cost well below market. Even the one major reach, J.J. McCarthy taken nearly three rounds early, looks more like conviction than panic when the rest of the board is this clean. The projected starters across the board are legitimate, Jefferson at WR6, Tyler Warren at TE4, and Rashee Rice at WR13 anchor a group that should compete every week. Sitting 69th percentile in the field and fourth in Combat, this team didn't need a lottery ticket to get here. It just needed a good draft.

Dan089 didn't swing for the fences and miss, didn't get lucky on a single dart throw, just consistently came out ahead of the board and built something that belongs in the Combat division conversation. The foundation is legitimately elite: Lamar Jackson at QB3 and Saquon Barkley at RB8 anchor the roster, and both were acquired after the field overvalued them slightly, making them values rather than splurges. Derrick Henry at RB12, taken more than a round after his ADP, extends that pattern, giving Dan089 genuine top-end firepower secured without overpaying. The one player worth watching closely is Jalen Hurts, projected QB9 and a projected starter, who brings five consecutive top-10 fantasy finishes to the table but now faces an Eagles offense without AJ Brown, whose trade to New England puts Hurts' passing game under a microscope it has rarely faced. Whether Hurts holds his value or slides will matter. But a roster sitting at the 86th percentile and third in the division didn't get there by accident, it got there because Dan089 drafted with a discipline the scoreboard has already noticed.

markymarkSC is sitting at 92nd percentile in the field and second in the Combat Division, and the draft sheet explains exactly why. The receiver group is the engine here: Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 and A.J. Brown at WR8 give this roster a top-end that most managers would trade half their bench to acquire, and Nico Collins at WR9 keeps the quality from dropping off the moment depth gets tested. What makes this draft genuinely impressive, though, is the discipline behind it. Dak Prescott landed at QB7 more than a full round after his ADP suggested he should have gone, and Harold Fannin and George Kittle each slid roughly a round and a half past their expected price, giving markymarkSC a Purdy-Kittle stack that came at a discount. Fourteen chalk picks and zero major reaches is not a flashy draft, it is a correct one, the kind where a manager trusted the board instead of forcing agendas. The ceiling is real, the process was clean, and the Combat Division is going to feel it.

CamFrost did not win the draft with one splashy move. They won it by consistently being on the right side of the transaction, and the tight end group is where that philosophy shows up most clearly. Tucker Kraft landed at TE5 after falling a full two rounds past his ADP, Travis Kelce came off the board at TE10 nearly two rounds late, and Kyle Pitts slid almost a round and a half before CamFrost scooped him at TE7. Three projected starters, all acquired at a discount, none of them the result of luck so much as patience and positioning. Colston Loveland at TE3 rounds out a group that would be the envy of almost any roster in the field. Meanwhile, Puka Nacua checks in as WR1 and George Pickens as WR10, giving this team a top of the lineup that does not need the late rounds to go perfectly. They did not swing for the fences and miss. They just kept getting more than they paid for, which is why CamFrost sits first in the Combat division and in the 99th percentile of the entire tournament.
