WayniacNation sits dead last in the Contra division and in the top one percent of the field, which in this context means the bottom, and looking at this roster it is difficult to argue with the math. The entire season rests on Joe Burrow, a QB4 talent who is also one of the most medically fragile quarterbacks in the league, a player whose injury history reads less like a medical chart and more like a disaster log. He missed nearly the entire 2026 season with a grade-3 turf toe, and when he finally returned he was brilliant, but "brilliant for four months" does not build a championship roster. The Burrow-Tee Higgins stack is a genuine asset when both are upright, and Higgins at WR19 gives this team a real floor, but James Cook at RB5 is the only other projected starter who grades out as a clear difference-maker. Beyond that pair, the depth falls off fast, the draft produced zero steals against two major reaches, and last year's 28 percent win rate suggests this is not a team on the verge of turning a corner.

Last year MattCisco went 28-8 and finished in the 94th percentile, which is the kind of résumé that earns you a reputation. This year's roster is projecting at just the 6th percentile, ranked 11th in the Contra division, and that gap is almost painful to look at. The TE group is genuinely impressive, with Tyler Warren (TE4), Kyle Pitts (TE7), Isaiah Likely (TE13), and Mark Andrews (TE14) all projecting as starters, but the format is positionless, and stacking the position that already had depth does not fix what ails the top of this roster. Malik Nabers (WR12) is the headliner, taken 1.9 rounds ahead of his ADP as the draft's major reach, and De'Von Achane (RB6) anchors the backfield, but after those two the projected starters drop off quickly and the RB depth behind Achane is Aaron Jones at RB38 and Jordan James at RB67. MattCisco is not a bad manager. He just drafted like last year's version of himself still existed, and the standings are not going to remember that version fondly.

alexewart drafted with genuine discipline, posting 16 chalk selections and reaching early only once in the entire draft, and the reward for that patience is a roster sitting 10th in the Contra division at the 29th percentile. The receiver group is legitimately strong, with Jaxon Smith-Njigba projecting as WR3, Chris Olave at WR11, Ladd McConkey at WR20, and Terry McLaurin at WR24 all penciled into the starting lineup. Colston Loveland at TE3 and Dallas Goedert at TE15 add another layer of projected quality. But the draft delivered those riches in a currency the format barely rewards, and when the top of the board reads D'Andre Swift at RB24 and Rhamondre Stevenson at RB31, the math gets uncomfortable fast. alexewart played the value game correctly, took Jauan Jennings three full rounds after his ADP, never panicked, never chased, and still landed in a place where the projections shrug. Doing everything right and arriving here anyway is not bad luck. It is the draft's most efficient cruelty.

There is no sugarcoating what Commish is staring at heading into 2026. Sitting ninth in the Contra division and at just the 32nd percentile of the field, this roster is in genuine trouble, and the draft did not exactly throw a lifeline. The standout name is Bijan Robinson at RB2, a legitimate anchor, and Kenneth Walker III at RB10 and Breece Hall at RB14 give the top of the lineup real weight. But the problems start almost immediately after that. The receiver group is headlined by Jordyn Tyson at WR34 and Jakobi Meyers at WR45, neither of whom inspires confidence as a projected starter, and Theo Johnson at TE37 is not walking through that door to save anyone. The draft did not help matters either, producing zero steals and two major reaches, including Braelon Allen burned nearly four rounds early. After going 3-33 in 2025 and finishing in the second percentile of scoring, Commish needed a reset. What they got was more of the same.

SundanceKid enters 2026 sitting eighth in the Contra division and in just the 37th percentile of the field, and the draft record offers little hope that the gap gets closed through roster construction: zero steals, eleven chalk picks, and two major reaches in Mac Jones and Elijah Sarratt, players projected at QB39 and WR98 respectively, drafted nearly five rounds ahead of consensus in each case. The floor here is Justin Jefferson, a genuine WR6 projection who fell to 2.05 when the field zagged, and Trey McBride as a TE2 gives the roster a real anchor. But Jefferson's value and McBride's production can only carry so much weight when the projected starters also include Tony Pollard at RB30, the weakest link in the lineup by the data's own accounting. Coming off a 2025 campaign that landed in the 16th percentile of scoring, SundanceKid needed a draft that bought back equity, and this one largely did not. The ceiling exists, but the path to it runs through a lot of things going exactly right.

GREGGELS17 is a 54th-percentile team that will live and die by its margins, and right now those margins cut both ways. The backfield is genuinely elite, with Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1, Ashton Jeanty at RB7, and Saquon Barkley at RB8 forming a top of the roster that can punch above its weight on any given week. Tucker Kraft at TE5 and Sam LaPorta at TE8 add a second tier of real reliability. The problem is that receiver production is thin at the top, with Carnell Tate projected WR29 and Quentin Johnston at WR41 carrying the load there. The quarterback situation is the sharpest edge of the margin question: Jordan Love was taken 2.3 rounds ahead of his ADP, a significant commitment to a QB17 projection that has to hit to justify the cost. Love and Kraft do connect as a stack, which softens the gamble slightly, but in a field where most managers drafted efficiently, betting a fifth-round pick on a middling QB projection is exactly the kind of thin ice that separates 7th in the division from something better.

undkasey didn't swing for the fences and miss, didn't load up on upside plays that implode by Week 6. This roster was built through a draft that kept coming out ahead on value, and the results speak for themselves. Taking Brock Bowers at 1.01 was a minor reach by ADP, but landing the TE1 half a round early is a trade most managers would make every time. From there, the value accumulated quietly: Marvin Harrison Jr. at WR33 slipped a full round past his ADP, and pairing Patrick Mahomes with Rashee Rice gives undkasey a stack that makes ceiling weeks genuinely dangerous. The receiver group is the backbone here, with A.J. Brown (WR8), Nico Collins (WR9), and Rice (WR13) all projected as starters, supported by Harrison and Alec Pierce. No single pick looks like a lottery ticket that happened to cash. The 2025 campaign finished at 61st percentile, and this draft suggests 2026 lands in at least the same neighborhood, probably better.

NimblewNumbers didn't build this roster with one thunderclap moment. They built it the way a good contractor builds a house: methodically, with almost nothing wasted. Josh Allen at QB1 anchors the entire enterprise, and the tight end group, headlined by Harold Fannin at TE6 and George Kittle at TE9, both taken roughly a round and a half after their ADPs suggested they would go, gives this team a ceiling that most managers in the Contra division are simply not working with. The draft as a whole leaned heavily on patience over aggression, with values outnumbering reaches across the board. The one genuine blemish, a 6.7-round early investment in Darnell Washington at TE38, stands out precisely because there are so few like it. Coming off a 2025 campaign that finished in the 98th percentile in scoring, NimblewNumbers has the profile of a team that does not need to get lucky because it already did the work in the draft room. Fourth in the division right now, but the floor here is high and the ceiling is legitimately title-range.

The board will tell you usmcotalaf11 reached three times in a major way, including pulling Mason Taylor (TE35) four rounds early and grabbing Christian Kirk (WR100) nearly five rounds before his number was called. The roster will tell you it mostly didn't matter. Christian McCaffrey (RB3) fell nearly half a round into their lap at 2.03, Omarion Hampton (RB9) came a full round late, and Javonte Williams (RB17) slid a round and a third past his expected window. That kind of value at the top end covers a lot of sins at the bottom. The result is a team sitting at the 72nd percentile with a starting backfield that would make most managers in the Contra division quietly envious. The WR group is genuinely thin, but in a positionless format the McCaffrey and Hampton combination does real work regardless of how the lineup fills in around them. Brenton Strange (TE17) draws some uncertainty given Jacksonville's recent investment in a blocking-first tight end, but Strange figures to remain the primary receiving

option there, which keeps the floor reasonable. This team reached its way to a good roster. Whether that reads as conviction or coin flips, the 2026 projections lean toward forgiving the process.

Romeokid sits third in the Contra Division and in the 91st percentile of the entire field, and the draft sheet explains exactly why. The foundation is a Dak Prescott and CeeDee Lamb stack, with Prescott projecting as QB7 and Lamb as WR5, both acquired at or better than fair value, Lamb sliding all the way to pick 2.04 despite an ADP of 1.11. That kind of discipline compounds. Travis Kelce came off the board at 9.09 when his ADP sat at 7.05, a two-round gift at TE10. Makai Lemon followed the same pattern, falling more than two rounds to land at WR40. Thirteen chalk picks and zero major reaches mean the manager never panicked, never overpaid, and never mortgaged a later round to chase a name. The one minor reach, Cooper Kupp, is a forgivable flier late in the draft. When your projected weakest starter is DK Metcalf at WR36, you have built something that is very hard to tear apart.

WalkFF sits second in the Contra division and at the 92nd percentile of the field, and the draft log tells you exactly why: no major reaches, five values, and a steady hand throughout. The foundation is Lamar Jackson, a QB3 who slid to pick 2.07 while the board looked the other way, paired with Jayden Daniels at QB5, giving this team a ceiling most managers would trade their whole draft for. Puka Nacua lands as WR1 and was somehow still on the board at pick 1.06. The quieter win is Jaylen Waddle, a projected WR23 who spent last season grinding through one of the league's more dysfunctional passing offenses and now steps into Denver, where Bo Nix led the league in pass attempts and the receiving room suddenly has real talent around it. That is the story of this roster: not one splashy moment, but pick after pick where WalkFF came out ahead. That kind of drafting compounds, and by November it tends to show.

Last year was a disaster for nicsulsky, a bottom-8-percent scoring season that left little to feel good about heading into 2026. The rebound, though, looks very real. The foundation starts with Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 and Jonathan Taylor at RB4, two genuinely elite projected performers who anchor a roster that now sits first in the Contra division and in the 95th percentile of the field. What makes this especially satisfying to look at is how nicsulsky built it: Taylor was secured at 2.09 despite an ADP of 2.01, and Jalen Hurts fell nearly a full round to 4.09, both adding top-end value without forcing a thing. George Pickens projects as WR10, Emeka Egbuka as WR18, and a Mayfield-Egbuka stack gives the roster a legitimate ceiling-raising component. Yes, Colby Parkinson sits at TE31 and Jalen Tolbert was the one real reach of the draft, but when your floor is Chase and Taylor, the margins at the edges barely matter. This is a roster built for a very different kind of season.
