Wide receiver depth is decent, but the reliance on Emeka Egbuka as a starter is

concerning given his lower-end ranking. Despite snagging players like Trevor Lawrence and Hunter Henry at advantageous times, the decision to grab Travis Hunter and DK Metcalf earlier than necessary has left the team scrambling for value elsewhere. As they attempt to climb out of their current standings, IdoloMoctezuma faces a season that demands strategic ingenuity and perhaps a touch of luck if they are to turn their fortunes around.

After soaring high in 2024 with an impressive 86th percentile finish, Netobot now finds itself grappling with the harsh realities of a new season. Ranked 11th in the Cruz Azul division, they're sandwiched uncomfortably between mediocrity and irrelevance. It's hard to imagine their running back lineup striking fear into the hearts of opponents, with D'Andre Swift somehow leading the charge as RB24—a position not unlike winning a bronze medal in a field of two. Meanwhile, no one can argue against their cache of wide receivers; CeeDee Lamb shines brightly as WR3, making those early draft reaches seem almost prescient. That is, until you recall their less-than-stellar reach on Javonte Williams, taken far earlier than even the most optimistic projections. And then there's Cam Ward, QB23, whose presence under center might as well be Netobot's version

of a gentleman's agreement to not score too many points. As the team prepares to tackle the season, they can take solace in their remarkable ability to snag players like Luther Burden and Cedric Tillman after their ADP, a masterclass in drafting value that would only be overshadowed if they hadn't reached for others with the enthusiasm of a kid grabbing cookies before dinner. In a tale of missed opportunities and misplaced optimism, Netobot's journey promises to be an intriguing watch—if only for the schadenfreude.
