Despite a respectable receiver core headlined by Nico Collins, who was a touch optimistic in selection, and solid if unspectacular depth featuring the likes of Mike Evans and Courtland Sutton, the team struggles to coalesce into a cohesive force. Javonte Williams offered a rare moment of value acquisition, but it feels like a solitary bright spot amidst a litany of missed opportunities. With their paltry overall percentile

standing, Drake9532 faces a daunting uphill battle, needing a near-miraculous turnaround to escape the clutches of mediocrity that seem poised to define their season.


