marmstrong119 drafted with the patience and discipline that fantasy advice columns preach and most managers ignore. George Pickens came at WR10 a full round after his ADP. Isaiah Likely landed at TE13 nearly a round late. Aaron Rodgers at QB29 was practically a gift at pick 16.01. Four values, zero major reaches, and the roster still projects at the 16th percentile of the field, which is the kind of outcome that makes you question whether any of this matters at all. The core is genuinely appealing: Jonathan Taylor at RB4 and Drake London at WR7 give the team a real ceiling. But the depth behind them fades fast, and when your projected weakest starter is Michael Wilson at WR39, the margin for injury or disappointment is nearly nonexistent. The 2025 season bottomed out at the 1st percentile in scoring, and while that feels like a floor that almost has to hold, this roster's construction suggests the improvement may be more modest than the draft board implied. marmstrong119 did everything right and still finds himself here.

tylerknaeble did almost everything right in the draft. CeeDee Lamb fell to pick 2.04, Rashee Rice slid nearly two rounds past her average draft position, and Josh Downs arrived at 12.04 when the room expected him gone two rounds earlier. The patience was real, the discipline was real, and the result is a team sitting 11th in the Cyberpunk 2077 division at the 21st percentile of the field, which is the kind of outcome that makes a person question whether drafting well matters at all. The receiving group is genuinely impressive on paper, with Lamb projecting as WR5, Justin Jefferson as WR6, and Rice as WR13, and the Jefferson situation at least offers a reason for optimism: Kyler Murray arriving in Minnesota suggests that Jefferson's WR6 projection is a bet on scheme and quarterback fit, not just reputation. But the depth behind that top layer fades quickly, the quarterback room is a liability at QB15 and QB18, and a 10-26 record from 2025 casts a long shadow over a roster that, by all draft logic, should feel more promising than it does.

There is not much to sugarcoat here for sfairfield, who finished 27th percentile in scoring last season and whose 2026 outlook does not show a clear path to better. The roster leans on Amon-Ra St. Brown (WR4) and James Cook (RB5) as its two genuine anchors, and both are legitimate, but after that the production drops off fast. The Jared Goff and St. Brown stack is a real asset, yet sfairfield burned a 4.02 pick on Goff when his ADP sat at 6.04, and spent a 3.11 on Jaxson Dart when Dart was available more than a round and a half later in most rooms. Those are not just minor inefficiencies, they are the kind of draft capital mismanagement that leaves a team thin where it counts at the back end. The result is a roster that grades out 10th in the Cyberpunk 2077 division and sits in the 24th percentile of the field, the type of standing where you need everything to break right just to feel average. Nothing in this draft suggests sfairfield found the leverage to make that happen.

johnwhorfin played the draft almost perfectly by the numbers, landing four values including Chris Olave at WR11 a full round after his ADP and Travis Kelce at TE10 when the board simply forgot about him. The floor under this roster looks real: Brock Bowers at TE1 and Saquon Barkley at RB8 give you two genuine difference-makers, and Kelce alongside Bowers is the kind of tight end depth that wins weeks on its own. And yet here the team sits, ninth in the Cyberpunk 2077 division and projected 32nd percentile in the field, because doing the right thing at the right price still left the top of the roster one level short of contention. Justin Herbert comes in as QB8 with Mike McDaniel now running his offense, which sounds promising until you remember that Herbert has just 15 career rushing scores and plays for a team that has been perfectly content winning ugly with the running game. Four values, zero steals, and a Daniel Jones reach that cost two rounds. johnwhorfin found fair value everywhere and did not find enough of anything else.

allyreid84 finished 2026's predecessor season at the 15th percentile in scoring and landed in the 33rd percentile entering this year, which is less a trajectory than a slow leak. The draft did not help much: fourteen chalk picks and four minor reaches, with the two best values being Drake Maye falling just a hair past his ADP and Antonio Williams sliding a round and a half in the late rounds. That is not a haul that changes a team's ceiling. The projected starters have some genuine names, Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and Maye projecting as a QB2 give this roster a real top end, but the rest of the lineup is a steady descent into the middle of the position rankings, with Kenyon Sadiq at TE21 anchoring the back end as the weakest projected starter on the sheet. Sitting eighth in the Cyberpunk 2077 division, allyreid84 needs Maye and Smith-Njigba to dramatically outperform their projections, because there is no hidden depth here and no obvious move left to make it matter.

Trancin sits 7th in the Cyberpunk 2077 division and at the 37th percentile of the field, and the draft record does little to suggest a turnaround is coming. The roster's best asset is a genuine one: Bijan Robinson projects as RB2, and Tyler Warren slots in at TE4, giving the team a pair of legitimate difference-makers at the top. The problem is that the support structure underneath them was largely built through hope over reason. Rhamondre Stevenson was taken nearly three full rounds before his RB31 projection warranted, and Elijah Sarratt, a WR98, was grabbed almost five rounds early, burning late capital on a player who projects nowhere near a starting role. Those reaches didn't just miss, they crowded out the kind of late-round value that holds a middle-tier roster together. The receiver group bottoms out with Wan'Dale Robinson as the projected weakest starter at WR47, and there are no obvious waiver targets waiting to fix it. Robinson and Warren can carry a week, but carrying a season is a different ask entirely.

ramuninho enters 2026 as a team that will be decided by inches, not miles. The receiver group is legitimately dangerous, with Ja'Marr Chase (WR2) anchoring a projected starting corps that also includes Zay Flowers (WR16) and Emeka Egbuka (WR18), and the quarterback situation is steadier than most, with Jayden Daniels (QB5) and Dak Prescott (QB7) giving ramuninho flexibility at the position. The problem is that the floor threatens to swallow the ceiling. Jaylen Warren (RB27) is the best backfield option and he's a solid contributor, not a difference-maker, and when you're leaning on Jayden Reed (WR48) as a projected starter, you are playing without margin for error. The draft didn't create any cushion either, featuring fourteen chalk picks and a major reach on Jaydon Blue at nearly six rounds ahead of his ADP. Chase can carry a lineup, but in a tournament where the margin between

winning and losing is a handful of points across a long season, ramuninho's ceiling and floor are uncomfortably close together.

CraftyRooster57 finished last season at 57th percentile and enters 2026 sitting 49th, so the needle has barely moved, which makes the draft all the more interesting to autopsy. The board screamed caution repeatedly and got ignored repeatedly, and yet the roster that came out the other end is genuinely hard to argue with. Trey McBride at TE2 anchors everything, and the receiver group built around Nico Collins (WR9), DeVonta Smith (WR14), Jaylen Waddle (WR23), and Mike Evans (WR27) is the kind of corps that wins weeks outright. The question is how they got here. Collins was the one moment the board actually cooperated, sliding nearly a full round past his ADP. Almost everything else required CraftyRooster57 to jump the line, sometimes aggressively. T.J. Hockenson, Alvin Kamara, and Ashton Jeanty were all taken earlier than consensus said to, and the Justin Fields situation raises an eyebrow at four and a half rounds early. None of those decisions look obviously wrong right now. Whether they look smart in November is the only question this team is really asking.

jrhangsen built something genuinely good in Cyberpunk 2077, and the draft sheet makes it look messier than the roster does. Four major reaches, zero steals, zero values, fifteen chalk picks: on paper, that is the profile of a manager gambling with house money. But the returns are hard to argue with. Christian McCaffrey at RB3, Kenneth Walker III at RB10, and TreVeyon Henderson at RB19 form a top-end group that most teams in this field would trade for without blinking, and Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 and Ladd McConkey at WR20 give jrhangsen legitimate punch at receiver too. Lamar Jackson at QB3 is the kind of anchor that makes a positionless format feel unfair to opponents. The major reaches, Bryce Young, Michael Penix Jr., Sean Tucker, and Elic Ayomanor, are depth gambles on upside, not the core of why this team works. Sitting 52nd percentile in the field after a middling 2025,

jrhangsen looks like a team that finally drafted to its ceiling. Whether the board called it lucky, conviction got the last word.

SeaWatIDidThere finished 2026 ranked third in the Cyberpunk 2077 division and landed at the 53rd percentile of the field, which looks modest until you see how the roster actually came together. The draft sheet reads like a confession: three major reaches, zero steals, and yet the starting group features Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1, Malik Nabers at WR12, Garrett Wilson at WR17, and a tight end room headlined by Colston Loveland at TE3 and Tucker Kraft at TE5. Those last two names are the tell. Loveland fell into range, Kraft was a genuine value pick, and together they form a stack with Jordan Love that gives this team a built-in floor on weeks when the rest of the roster goes sideways. Love himself is the reach that will define the season, taken two full rounds ahead of his QB17 projection. If he outperforms that number, the whole exercise looks like conviction. If he settles into it, the team still has enough talent elsewhere to stay competitive. The difference between shrewd and stubborn is usually the scoreboard.

PseudoFootball didn't win the draft with one audacious swing. They won it by consistently getting slightly more than they paid for, round after round, until the advantages compounded into something real. De'Von Achane at RB6 slipped to pick 2.11 when his ADP sat at 2.07, a minor gap that still counts as coming out ahead. Harold Fannin fell nearly two rounds past his ADP and landed as a projected TE6 starter, the kind of quiet heist that makes a draft look smart in October. The foundation underneath all of it is genuinely elite: Josh Allen at QB1 and Jalen Hurts at QB9 give this team a ceiling most managers in the Cyberpunk 2077 division cannot match, and Achane, Jeremiyah Love, and Breece Hall project as three of the top 14 running backs in the field. There are no steals on the board and four values, which is less a complaint than a description of a manager who drafted with discipline, stayed composed, and finished second in the division with an 86th-percentile roster to show for it.

BBBurger enters 2026 sitting at the top of the Cyberpunk 2077 division and in the 100th percentile of the entire field, and the draft record tells you exactly why: nine value picks, ten chalk selections, and zero steals needed because the board just kept delivering. The TE group alone is the story of a manager who stayed patient and got paid, landing Kyle Pitts (TE7), Sam LaPorta (TE8), and George Kittle (TE9) at an average of nearly two full rounds past their ADPs. That kind of collective slide at one position does not happen by accident; it happens when a manager knows what he wants and trusts the process. Up top, Joe Burrow (QB4) is the engine, and the Burrow-Tee Higgins (WR19) stack gives this team a direct pipeline to one of the highest-upside quarterback-receiver pairings in fantasy. Yes, Burrow's injury history is real and well-documented, but when he plays, he plays like a QB4 at his floor, and Puka Nacua (WR1) and A.J. Brown (WR8) ensure the production floor stays high regardless.
