T.J. Hockenson earlier than necessary. A bold early grab of Josh Jacobs has left many scratching their heads, considering the diminishing returns it offered. As they prepare to tackle the season, 18n1CallMeGreat must rely on their robust running backs to steer them out of this tumultuous phase, hoping that any small gains from their stack with T.J. Hockenson and J.J. McCarthy can light a path toward a more successful campaign.

As they brace for the season ahead, arjchandar seems poised to face yet another year of battling against the quicksand of the lower ranks, plagued by the specter of what might have been.
