Darven sits dead last in the Doom Slayer division and at the 1st percentile of the entire field, and the draft log explains exactly why. The reach count here is genuinely alarming: five major reaches across the board, including Patrick Mahomes at pick 3.12 when his QB12 projection suggests he had no business leaving the board that early, and Kyler Murray burned at 6.01 despite projecting as QB19. That is two quarterback slots occupied by players Darven overpaid for by a combined four-plus rounds, capital that could have shored up literally anything else. Kenneth Walker III going at 2.01 for a RB10 projection is the kind of move that makes draft rooms go quiet, and T.J. Hockenson taken 2.2 rounds ahead of his ADP only adds to the carnage. Drake Maye projects as a legitimate QB2 and offers the one genuine bright spot here, but a draft this systematically aggressive in the wrong direction leaves Maye as the lone survivor of a roster that spent its best ammunition on yesterday's prices.

There is no spin available for dheaton47, and the draft record makes no attempt to offer one. Three major reaches across 17 rounds tell the full story: Trevor Lawrence pulled two rounds ahead of his market at pick 2.07, Bucky Irving arrived nearly three rounds early at 4.07, and by the time Ja'Kobi Lane landed at 16.07, the pattern had calcified into a strategy. Those aggressive swings at quarterbacks and running backs consumed draft capital that never found its way to the receiver position, which currently projects WR50 as the top option at the position. The quarterback group is legitimately strong, Herbert and Lawrence both projecting as starters, and Trey McBride at TE2 is the kind of anchor most managers would trade a round to own. But the roster sits 11th in the division and in the 2nd percentile of the tournament field, and last year's 43rd-percentile scoring season suggests this is not a team positioned to paper over its weaknesses. Good intentions built this roster. The board did not cooperate.

There is no polite way to say this: BurtReynolds2002 sits 10th in the Doom Slayer division and in just the 16th percentile of the entire field, and the draft did almost nothing to change that trajectory. Out of 20 picks, the team registered zero steals, and the two major reaches tell the story of a manager chasing upside that almost certainly will not arrive. Bo Nix, a QB15, was pulled four rounds early, burning draft capital on a quarterback who grades out as a low-end starter on a good day. Elic Ayomanor, sitting at WR95, was grabbed nearly four rounds before his market price, which is the kind of late-round gamble that rarely pays off and definitely should not cost you a premium. To be fair, Lamar Jackson is a genuine QB3 anchor, and CeeDee Lamb at WR5 gives the roster a real floor. But when your projected weakest starter is RJ Harvey at RB28, and the draft produced one modest value, there are simply no levers left to pull. This one looks like damage limitation from week one.

NoahNM1 sits ninth in the Doom Slayer division and projects out at just the 34th percentile of the field, and the roster itself does a decent job of explaining why. The draft was built almost entirely on chalk, with three major reaches doing real damage to what could have been a stronger foundation. Taking Jalen Hurts a full round and a half early in Round 2 was the kind of premium commitment that demands a premium return, and at QB9, Hurts is a fine quarterback but not the transformative asset that justifies sacrificing draft capital at that stage. The situation at tight end tells a similar story: Harold Fannin graded out TE6 last year and earned that finish, but he plays in Cleveland, where the quarterback situation featuring Deshaun Watson is genuinely one of the league's worst, and new receiving competition could further dilute his target share. Puka Nacua at WR1 is a legitimate star and Travis Etienne projects as a quality starter, but below that top tier the roster thins out fast, and with no obvious trade chip or sleeper left to flip, NoahNM1 looks like a team that has already played most of its cards.

joberg182 played a disciplined draft, landing Dallas Goedert two full rounds past his ADP and collecting Chuba Hubbard, Rico Dowdle, and Jacory Croskey-Merritt all well after the market expected them to go. The patience was real and the execution was sound. The problem is that being right about value only matters if the players you accumulate actually add up to a contender, and this roster sits at the 50th percentile and eighth in the Doom Slayer division despite the efficiency. Jahmyr Gibbs is a genuine anchor at RB1, and the receiver group, led by Emeka Egbuka and Ladd McConkey, carries enough upside to keep the lineup competitive week to week. But Dak Prescott was taken nearly a full round early at QB7, and the back end of this roster thins out fast, with Quentin Johnston projected as the weakest starter at WR41. joberg182 bought everything at a discount and still ended up with a cart full of items that are fine individually but do not quite add up to a meal.

TheUndroppables.comPeckin finished last season at the 84th percentile in scoring, so there is a baseline here worth respecting before the draft-room second-guessing begins. The reaches are real: Colston Loveland at TE3 cost a half-round of premium, Michael Penix Jr. at QB33 cost nearly four, and Shedeur Sanders came off the board a round and a half early. The board did not offer these players, so the manager went and took them. Here is the uncomfortable part: it mostly worked. Loveland projects as the TE3, a genuinely elite anchor in a positionless format where a top tight end scores exactly like a top receiver. Justin Jefferson at WR6 and Chris Olave at WR11 give this lineup a legitimate top end that most managers would be happy to buy at full price, let alone reach for. The one genuine value, Jayden Daniels falling nearly a full round past his ADP, quietly anchors the QB room.

Whether the conviction behind those reaches was scouting or stubbornness, the roster does not particularly care. It just looks good.

JHough didn't swing for the fences and didn't need to. The 2026 roster was built the same way good teams usually are: round after round of sound decisions that quietly added up to something real. The headliner is Ja'Marr Chase at WR2, a legitimately elite anchor, but what makes this team worth watching is what surrounds him. A.J. Brown at WR8 and Nico Collins at WR9 are both projected starters, and Tetairoa McMillan came in at WR15 after sliding four spots past his ADP, which is the kind of quiet win that separates careful drafters from lucky ones. That group alone would make most managers comfortable. JHough's 2025 campaign backed the process too, finishing in the 90th percentile in scoring with a 69 percent win rate, so this is not a team building on a hunch. The division rank of sixth in Doom Slayer and a 74th percentile tournament standing suggest real ceiling, not guaranteed glory, but a roster this consistently constructed rarely wastes it.

andmart didn't build this roster on one splashy move. They built it pick by pick, and the cumulative result lands them in the 80th percentile of the field. The foundation is genuinely elite: James Cook at RB5 and Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 give this team a pair of projected top-tier contributors that most managers would envy, and Malik Nabers at WR12 alongside Breece Hall at RB14 means the talent doesn't fall off a cliff after the top. What makes the draft grade so clean is the discipline in the middle and late rounds. Bhayshul Tuten at RB25, Tyrone Tracy, and Jonah Coleman all came to andmart at a discount relative to their ADP, quietly padding a roster that was already in good shape. The one spot worth monitoring is Michael Pittman, the projected weakest starter, now running routes for Aaron Rodgers in Pittsburgh on an offense still searching for an identity. But a questionable WR44 is a luxury problem when everything above him on the depth chart looks like this.

SGarza didn't win the draft with one flashy pick. This team was built through a series of small advantages that quietly stacked up. The clearest example is Jonathan Taylor, projected RB4 and taken at 3.02 after his ADP had him going in the second round, a full round of value extracted without any drama. Tyjae Spears slid a round and a half past his ADP as well, giving SGarza late-round depth without paying early-round prices. Up top, Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Caleb Williams at QB6 give this roster a genuine star-tier foundation, and the supporting cast, Jeremiah Love at RB13, Garrett Wilson at WR17, Sam LaPorta at TE8, reads like a manager who refused to let rounds go to waste. The draft chart shows 14 chalk picks and zero major reaches, which sounds boring until you realize it means SGarza never panicked and never overpaid. That kind of discipline lands you at 81st percentile in the field, and in the Doom Slayer division, it puts you squarely in the conversation.

Ironman landed in the top 16 percent of the field not by threading any single needle but by quietly winning exchange after exchange across the draft board. George Pickens at WR10 slid nearly a full round past his ADP before Ironman scooped him up, and Omar Cooper Jr. fell nearly two rounds before landing at WR60, the kind of patient accumulation that compounds into a genuinely dangerous roster. The receiver group anchors everything: Amon-Ra St. Brown (WR4), Drake London (WR7), and Pickens give this team a starting core that most managers would trade their draft boards for, with DeVonta Smith (WR14) and Tucker Kraft (TE5) adding real teeth behind them. Kyle Pitts at TE7 and David Njoku, a steal who tumbled more than three rounds past his ADP, give the team layered depth at tight end. The one soft spot is quarterback, where C.J. Stroud projects as the weakest projected starter on the roster at QB22, but in a positionless format the rest of this lineup has more than enough firepower to carry the weight.

EricNMoody didn't need a lottery ticket to build a contender in the Doom Slayer division, just steady, repeatable edges. The draft tells the story: four values against ADP and zero major reaches, a quiet accumulation of surplus that compounds across a roster. Ashton Jeanty fell nearly a full round past his ADP, Derrick Henry slipped even further, and together they anchor a backfield group that includes Javonte Williams (RB17) and Kyle Monangai (RB33) as projected starters. That is a lot of proven production landing below market rate. Then there's the quarterback situation, which is genuinely enviable: Josh Allen (QB1) is the engine, and Joe Burrow (QB4) is the high-upside insurance policy. Burrow's injury history is real and documented, but when healthy he profiles as arguably the best fantasy quarterback in football, which means EricNMoody is carrying a QB4 as a backup. The 2025 season landed in the 82nd scoring percentile, and with this roster construction, another deep run in 2026 looks less like a prediction and more like a reasonable expectation.

The Funky Bunch sit first in the Doom Slayer division and in the 96th percentile of the field, and the draft sheet explains exactly why. This team was built on discipline and patience, and the board rewarded both. Christian McCaffrey fell nearly a full round past his ADP before this manager pounced at 2.06, and Saquon Barkley followed the same script, sliding 1.3 rounds before getting scooped at 4.06. Neither of those is luck, that is a manager who knew his prices and refused to blink. De'Von Achane at RB6 adds a third elite projected starter in the backfield, and Brock Bowers anchors the whole lineup as the TE1. The one area that invites a raised eyebrow is the quarterback situation, where Brock Purdy arrives carrying a loaded injury report around his weapons, and Daniel Jones sits at QB25 as the backup plan. But in a positionless format this deep at the top, that is a minor footnote on an otherwise immaculate roster. Two major values, four good values, and one division lead. The Funky Bunch did the work.
