Komments finished last season at the 34th percentile and apparently decided the cure was a draft in which zero picks qualified as steals or values, six qualified as major reaches, and the whole thing reads like someone bid their own price up in a war against nobody. The most damning exhibit is Kaelon Black, a WR65 taken eight full rounds ahead of his ADP, a pick that would be hard to justify even if Black were projected as a starter, which he is not. Meanwhile, the roster's top projected starters tell their own story: Ladd McConkey at WR20 and Luther Burden at WR22 are fine, but Burden was a three-round reach to get there, and the projected starter floor bottoms out at Stefon Diggs at WR56. KC Concepcion lands in Cleveland, where the quarterback situation ranges from uninspiring to actively grim, making his WR50 projection feel generous rather than safe. There is no sleeper angle here that rescues the draft grade, no buried value that reframes the losses. This is the 1st percentile of the tournament, and komments built it that way pick by pick.

The Tush Pushers drafted with genuine discipline. Fifteen chalk picks, only two minor reaches and one major, and a stolen Jalen Hurts at 6.04 when his ADP sat at 3.12. That is a draft that should produce a functional roster. It has not. Sitting 11th in the John Madden Football division and in just the 14th percentile of the field, this team is the cautionary tale you tell about the limits of process-based drafting. The receiver group is the culprit. Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 leads a projected starting corps that bottoms out at Jayden Reed at WR48, and the players between them, Courtland Sutton at WR37, Quentin Johnston at WR41, offer competence without upside. Meanwhile, the Hurts steal carries its own asterisk: AJ Brown is gone to New England, and a quarterback whose fantasy value has always leaned on rushing touchdowns now faces a passing offense under a microscope it may not survive. The value was found. The ceiling just was not there to find.

There is no kind way to say this: brucewayne0305 is a 15th-percentile team sitting 10th in the John Madden Football division, and the draft did not generate the kind of surplus value that makes those numbers look temporary. Of 18 picks, zero graded out as steals, two qualified as major reaches, and the best value on the board was Fernando Mendoza at QB27, which is the fantasy equivalent of finding a dollar in a coat pocket when you needed rent money. The receiver group is the real anchor dragging this ship down, with Emeka Egbuka as the projected WR1 on the roster at WR18 and Wan'Dale Robinson, a minor reach, slotted behind him. Josh Allen and De'Von Achane give brucewayne0305 a genuine top-end core worth building around, and Derrick Henry at RB12 adds real depth, but when Egbuka is your best receiver and Blake Corum grades out as your weakest projected starter, the ceiling has a low ceiling. A year after going 44 percent in wins, there is no obvious fix here.

ScottBill did everything right and arrived somewhere wrong anyway. The draft was disciplined, 10 chalk picks and only minor reaches, and the values were genuine: Jordan Love fell nearly two rounds, Baker Mayfield fell more than one, and Oronde Gadsden slid past his ADP only to land in a situation complicated by the late free-agent addition of David Njoku, which is exactly the kind of quiet roster footnote that erodes projected production without ever showing up as a headline. The receiver group is legitimate, with Puka Nacua at WR1 and both Nico Collins and George Pickens projected as starters, and yet the team sits ninth in the John Madden Football division and in the 20th percentile of the field. That is the cruelest thing a draft can do to a manager: reward the process and withhold the result. ScottBill bought value, avoided catastrophe, and built a roster that projects to go nowhere, which after a 2025 season that finished below .500 is starting to feel less like bad luck and more like a pattern.

footballdiehard arrives in the John Madden Football division sitting eighth and projecting in just the 22nd percentile of the field, and the draft log does not offer much comfort. The receiver group is the one genuine bright spot, with CeeDee Lamb (WR5), A.J. Brown (WR8), and DeVonta Smith (WR14) forming a legitimate top tier, but Brown cost a second-round pick nearly a full round ahead of his market price, which is the kind of aggressive move that has to pay off when the rest of the roster is this thin on upside. It mostly hasn't: Trevor Lawrence lands at QB10 and Tucker Kraft at TE5, respectable numbers on paper, but three major reaches elsewhere in the draft, including Mike Washington Jr. at RB59 and Geno Smith at QB30, burned late-round capital that never materialized into value. Coming off a 47-percent win rate in 2025, footballdiehard needed a draft that bought margin, and instead this one mortgaged future flexibility for depth that grades out near the bottom of the division.

centxcommish sits at 60th percentile heading into 2026, which sounds like a compliment until you realize it means roughly half the field is ahead of them and the other half isn't exactly trembling. The receiver group is genuinely strong, with Amon-Ra St. Brown (WR4), Chris Olave (WR11), Garrett Wilson (WR17), and D.J. Moore (WR26) all projected as starters, and that kind of depth at the top end can carry a roster through the rough patches. The problem is that everything else requires things to go right. Caleb Williams (QB6) was the draft's clearest steal, falling two full rounds past his ADP, and if he plays like a QB6 this team has a real ceiling. But Jonathan Taylor (RB4) has to stay healthy, Travis Kelce (TE10) has to remain relevant, and a 47 percent win rate last season doesn't leave much margin for error. This roster doesn't lose rounds, it loses coin flips, and in the Scott Fish Bowl, coin flips add up fast.

StephenHoopes didn't win the draft with one thunderbolt pick. They won it by consistently landing players past their expected spots, round after round, until the whole thing added up. Dak Prescott, projected QB7, slid nearly two full rounds before Hoopes grabbed him at 5.03. C.J. Stroud fell a similar distance to become a viable QB option at pick 11.03. Meanwhile, the positional talent at the top is genuine: Jahmyr Gibbs projects as RB1, Colston Loveland comes in at TE3, and George Kittle sits at TE9, giving this roster a legitimate floor that most managers would envy. The 2025 season already hinted at what this roster construction can produce, a 27-9 record and a finish in the 85th percentile for scoring. There are no signature moments to point to here, no single pick that makes the highlight reel, but that's almost the point. StephenHoopes drafted a team that earns its ranking the quiet way, and at 67th percentile entering 2026, it looks like the work is already done.

NinjaChickens21 didn't build this roster with one flashy move. They built it pick by pick, coming out ahead often enough that the cumulative advantage is hard to ignore. Landing Christian McCaffrey at RB3 in the second round when his ADP sat in the first round is the kind of quiet win that compounds, and pairing him with Justin Jefferson (WR6) and Rashee Rice (WR13) as projected starters gives this lineup a genuine top-end that can carry a week on its own. The tight end group is where the draft really separates itself, with Kyle Pitts (TE7), Sam LaPorta (TE8), and Isaiah Likely (TE13) all projecting as starters and all acquired at or past their ADP. Kimani Vidal (RB60) was the one notable overpay, taken nearly four rounds early, but in a positionless format that kind of roster depth rarely hurts you the way it might in a traditional league. A 93rd percentile scoring season in 2025 says this manager knows how to put points on the board, and the 2026 draft suggests that hasn't changed.

Nomad1600 finished 91st percentile in the Scott Fish Bowl's John Madden Football division and earned it the old-fashioned way, by consistently coming out ahead on the board rather than swinging on one marquee name. The wide receiver group is the clearest evidence: Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3, Drake London at WR7, Jaylen Waddle at WR23, and Christian Watson at WR28 form a projected starting core that most managers in this field simply cannot match. Omarion Hampton at RB9 anchors the backfield. Then there is Brock Purdy at QB13, snagged three full rounds past his ADP, which is the kind of quiet larceny that separates good drafts from great ones. Yes, the San Francisco receiver situation heading into 2026 is genuinely murky, with Brandon Aiyuk out of the picture, George Kittle recovering from a torn Achilles, and Ricky Pearsall's availability reportedly in doubt. Purdy has navigated thin supporting casts before, and at QB13 the downside risk is already priced in. This is a roster built for a deep run.

swankymars33 didn't build this roster with one flashy move. They built it by consistently getting more than they paid for, round after round. Malik Nabers came off the board a full round after his ADP, which is a gift at WR12. Bucky Irving slid nearly two rounds past his number and landed as a projected starter at RB21. Even the big headline value, Bo Nix at QB15, arrived in round eight when his ADP said round six, which more than compensates for the modest quarterback rating. The foundation underneath all of this is genuinely strong: Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 anchor a starting group that should produce at or near the ceiling week after week. The 2025 results back up the process, a 78 percent win rate and 93rd-percentile scoring suggest this isn't a team that got lucky once. Sitting 4th in the John Madden Football division while projecting in the 91st percentile of the field, swankymars33 has quietly assembled one of the more complete rosters in this tournament.

There was no flashy gambit here, no reaching for a name and hoping it pays off. tjgormley simply drafted better than the room, pick after pick, and the ledger shows it: sitting second in the John Madden Football division and at the 92nd percentile of the entire field. The centerpiece of that consistency is the tight end situation, where Brock Bowers at TE1 would be enough on its own, but Trey McBride fell nearly a full round past his ADP and landed at TE2, a steal that looks even more striking in hindsight. Up at quarterback, Patrick Mahomes slipped almost two rounds past his ADP, and tjgormley was simply there to take the call. The Matthew Stafford situation deserves a note: a 37-year-old coming off a career-high in touchdowns and an MVP award, with the Rams already drafting his successor, is a lot of uncertainty to absorb, but Stafford stacks with Davante Adams, and that connection gives the uncertainty a cushion. This roster did not get lucky once. It got right, repeatedly.

seanpmcdermott sits at the top of the John Madden Football division, in the 97th percentile of the entire field, and the draft tells you exactly why. The discipline here is the story. Fifteen chalk picks keep the roster grounded, but the needle-movers are the steals: Jayden Daniels at QB5 slid nearly two full rounds past his ADP, and Jakobi Meyers at WR45 fell more than two rounds before seanpmcdermott quietly scooped him up. That is not luck, that is patience, and it compounds. Stack Joe Burrow with Ja'Marr Chase, who projects as WR2, and you have a ceiling-raising combination that can single-handedly swing a week. The supporting cast, from Chase Brown at RB11 to Harold Fannin at TE6, fills out a lineup with almost nothing to apologize for. The weakest projected starter is Jordan Addison at WR43, which is the kind of problem most managers would trade their draft boards to have. One minor reach on Jack Bech at WR94 is the lone blemish, and even that barely registers. Clean draft, deep talent, no visible cracks.
