As TheIncredibleMeg enters the 2025 fantasy football season, expectations are decidedly low. Despite ending 2024 on a high note, finishing in the 72nd percentile, the team now faces daunting challenges that threaten to derail any hopes of success. Currently languishing at the bottom of their division rankings, this team's strategy appears flawed from the outset. Rashid Shaheed, pegged as WR54, is alarmingly projected as a starter, casting doubt on their wide receiver core's ability to compete effectively, despite having the likes of Amon-Ra St. Brown and A.J. Brown. The decision-making in the draft room raises eyebrows further, with substantial value lost through premature picks like C.J. Stroud and Rhamondre Stevenson, while reaching significantly for players like Joe Burrow and Tua Tagovailoa failed to inspire confidence. Although Kenneth Walker III was snatched up at a favorable point, his potential impact seems insufficient to counterbalance other questionable

roster choices. With their current trajectory, TheIncredibleMeg's presence in both division and overall standings appears bleak, leaving much to be desired as they navigate an uphill battle against far more formidable opponents.
