There is a version of USBB that looks interesting on paper, and then there is the version that actually has to compete in the Dark Souls division. Trey McBride, Colston Loveland, and George Kittle give this roster a genuinely elite group at tight end, rated TE2, TE3, and TE9 respectively, but strength at one position cannot carry a team when the rest of the projected lineup is this thin. Jordan Love grades out at QB17, which is fine, but his backup is Cam Ward at QB23, the weakest projected starter on the roster, and the running back corps is led by Cam Skattebo at just RB20. DeVonta Smith and Ladd McConkey offer some credibility at WR14 and WR20, yet the team still sits 12th in the division and in just the 11th percentile of the field. Perhaps most telling, USBB produced zero steals and zero values across the entire draft, leaning instead on chalk picks and six reaches, including Theo Johnson taken nearly four rounds ahead of his ADP. The lever everyone would look for simply is not there.

There is no polite way to say this: RicosModernWorld is in trouble, and the 2026 season is shaping up to look a lot like 2025, when this roster finished in the 9th percentile of scoring and went 6-30. Lamar Jackson at QB3 is a genuine asset, and De'Von Achane at RB6 gives the team a legitimate top-end piece to build around, but the supporting cast falls off quickly and the draft did nothing to change that trajectory. Fourteen chalk picks and zero steals means this roster is essentially what it says on the label, no hidden upside waiting to emerge. Worse, the one aggressive swing that deviated from the script was David Njoku, taken 7.2 rounds ahead of his ADP only to project out as TE29, a move that cost premium capital for a player who grades out as a streamer. Sitting 11th in the Dark Souls division and in just the 17th percentile of the field, RicosModernWorld has Jackson and Achane, and after that the math gets very discouraging very fast.

There is no kind way to say this: X112WW1X is sitting at 17th percentile in the field and dead last in the Dark Souls division, and the draft chart does not offer much cover. The manager reached on Josh Jacobs by 1.3 rounds and burned an 18th-round pick on Justin Fields, a QB38 who grades out as a streaming afterthought. The saving grace is supposed to be the backfield, headlined by Saquon Barkley and Omarion Hampton, but Barkley at RB8 is less the engine he was than a cautionary tale in progress, a player the Eagles are reportedly looking to shield from heavy workloads at age 29. Hampton was reached for in Round 2 before his ADP, so at least there is some faith baked in there. The receiver corps, though, is where the floor drops out: the weakest projected starter is Xavier Worthy at WR49, and Davante Adams at WR25 is the clear top option. When Adams is your best pass-catcher, you are not building toward something, you are hoping not to fall apart first.

There is no flattering angle here. VideoPokerJag sits ninth in the Dark Souls division, projected at just the 22nd percentile of the field, and the draft board explains exactly why. The roster produced zero steals and zero values across the entire draft, a clean sweep of missed opportunity that is almost impressive in its consistency. Bijan Robinson at RB2 is a genuine anchor, and the quartet of Emeka Egbuka, Jameson Williams, Mike Evans, and DK Metcalf gives the starting group some real texture, but the rest of the draft reads like a series of panicked decisions. Jaxson Dart was taken 2.4 rounds ahead of his ADP, a significant overpay for a QB11 when the position had plenty left on the board. Then, deep in the draft where patience is free, VideoPokerJag reached 3.8 rounds early on Darnell Mooney and nearly 3 rounds early on Malachi Fields, two WR80-range players who did not need to be chased. The foundation is not the problem. The construction is.

TJE85 sits at 29th percentile and eighth in the Dark Souls division, and the draft sheet does not offer much comfort about how they got there. The roster produced zero steals and two major reaches, including J.J. McCarthy pulled nearly five rounds ahead of his ADP and slotted as a QB37 with no realistic path to the starting lineup. The running back group is legitimately strong, with James Cook (RB5), Chase Brown (RB11), and four other projected starters forming a deep, productive core. But the receiving talent thins out quickly past Jaxon Smith-Njigba (WR3), and the quarterback situation is a drain on the whole operation, with Sam Darnold checking in as a QB21 on the best day. Even David Montgomery, who fled Detroit's backfield for what he hopes is a cleaner opportunity with Houston, arrives as RB23 still competing for top billing against Woody Marks. The pieces to climb are not obvious, the draft capital was not maximized, and the division is not forgiving. This one grades out as a long season before it starts.

BuyInDonator sits at the 52nd percentile, seventh in the Dark Souls division, which is exactly the kind of positioning that keeps a manager refreshing their phone at 11 p.m. on a Sunday. The margins here are real. The upside is genuine: Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 form a legitimate top-end core, and the manager added McCaffrey at 2.03 when ADP had him going nearly half a round earlier at 1.09, a quiet win that compounds over a full season. Malik Nabers at WR12, Terry McLaurin at WR24, and Brian Thomas Jr. at WR31 give the projected starters real depth of quality. The drag comes from the edges: Brenton Strange projects as the weakest starter at TE17, and Jack Bech, taken 5.2 rounds ahead of his ADP, is the kind of early commitment that looks visionary or wasteful depending almost entirely on factors nobody controls. This roster does not lose the season in the draft room. It wins or loses it one close week at a time.

Adam1880 walked out of the draft holding Joe Burrow (QB4), Jonathan Taylor (RB4), and Harold Fannin (TE6), and honestly that trio alone is enough to make the case. In a positionless format where you simply field your best players, concentrating elite talent at the top of the roster is the entire strategy, and this team executes it as cleanly as anyone in the Dark Souls division. Taylor and Derrick Henry (RB12) give Adam1880 two projected top-15 backs, and Burrow is a QB4 with Williams (QB6) sitting behind him as insurance. The wildcard is Fannin, who outplayed his veteran competition in Cleveland last year and enters 2026 with the starting job all to himself. The Browns' quarterback situation remains a concern, but any offensive improvement could push a TE6 projection even higher. The draft was tidy and disciplined, twelve chalk picks and zero major reaches, which means the upside here is baked in rather than borrowed. Sitting 61st percentile with a roster this top-heavy, Adam1880 has real room to climb.

kenflott didn't win the draft with one thunderclap pick. This roster was built pick by pick, round by round, with a quiet consistency that adds up fast. Brock Bowers at TE1 anchors the whole operation, and pairing him with Oronde Gadsden at TE16 means kenflott is fielding elite production at that spot without leaning on it. The receiver group carries real weight too: Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 and Jaylen Waddle at WR23 form a projected starting duo that most managers would take without blinking, and the fact that Waddle fell more than a full round past his ADP means kenflott didn't even have to overpay for him. Alec Pierce at WR32 arriving nearly two rounds late is the same story. Ashton Jeanty at RB7 gives this team a genuine difference-maker in the backfield, and a Bo Nix and Waddle stack adds another layer of upside. The tournament percentile of 61st doesn't scream elite, but a draft this clean, with three legitimate values and almost no reaches, tends to look better once the season actually starts.

Billclctr didn't win the draft with a single thunderbolt moment. They won it by being right more often than everyone else. The top of this roster is legitimately elite: Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 and A.J. Brown at WR8 give this team a ceiling that most managers in the Dark Souls division simply cannot match, and Rashee Rice at WR13 keeps that ceiling from depending on a single game-changing performance. Kenneth Walker III came at a slight premium at RB10, but pairing him with Bhayshul Tuten at RB25, a player the board left sitting a full round past his ADP, turns that reach into something more forgivable. The same pattern shows up again with Rhamondre Stevenson, taken a round and a half late at RB31, and Chris Rodriguez falling nearly a round and a half to become a late-round asset. Four values on one roster is not luck, it is process. Sitting 68th percentile overall with a draft that generated this kind of positional talent suggests Billclctr has real upside left to unlock once the season starts sorting itself out.

TrihardJoel isn't going to blow anyone's mind with a single flashy acquisition, but that's kind of the point. This is a roster built on consistent, quiet competence, and the draft bears that out: mostly chalk with a handful of well-timed values, including Drake Maye sliding to 2.10 despite projecting as QB2. Maye already finished second in MVP voting last year working with modest weapons, and now he has A.J. Brown added to the mix in New England, which makes projecting him forward genuinely exciting rather than an act of faith. Beyond Maye, the projected starters read like a function of steady process: Nico Collins at WR9, Zay Flowers at WR16, Garrett Wilson at WR17, and Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 give this team a ceiling that explains the 81st percentile tournament standing. TrihardJoel sits third in the Dark Souls division, which means there's work to do, but the foundation here was laid the right way, pick by pick, without needing a single moment to save it.

There was no flashy gamble that defined jch28's draft, no moment where the room collectively gasped. Just round after round of quiet, compounding advantage. Drake London fell nearly a full round past his ADP and landed at WR7. Dak Prescott slipped past his number and arrived at QB7 with a ready-made stack in Jake Ferguson at TE12. Tyler Shough, the kind of depth quarterback most managers treat as an afterthought, came off the board more than two rounds after his ADP suggested he should, giving jch28 a QB20 essentially for free. Add Puka Nacua at WR1 and Tyler Warren at TE4 anchoring the lineup, and the starting group is genuinely difficult to attack. The 2025 record, 72 percent wins and an 89th-percentile scoring season, suggests this is not a manager who got lucky once. Landing in the 88th percentile of the 2026 field and second in the Dark Souls division, jch28 built this thing the boring way, and the boring way worked.

nickbayer sits first in the Dark Souls division and in the top 10 percent of the field, and the draft board tells you exactly why. There are zero reaches on this roster, zero. Every pick landed at or below market value, and several fell significantly further than that. CeeDee Lamb at WR5 and Justin Jefferson at WR6 give this team a foundation that most managers would trade their depth charts to own, and both are projected starters. The value story gets more interesting down the ballot: Tucker Kraft came off the board a full round and a quarter after his ADP to land as TE5, and Isaiah Likely followed a similar pattern to slot in as TE13. Geno Smith and Tua Tagovailoa both fell over three rounds from their ADPs, giving nickbayer late-round upside at a position this format does not penalize you for waiting on. The weakest projected starter is Makai Lemon at WR40, which means the floor on this roster is genuinely high. Clean draft, disciplined execution, and a lineup that looks like the work of someone who did the homework.
