There is no charitable read on MileHighStello's 2026 roster, and the draft log makes that painfully clear. This team committed eight major reaches across the board, zero steals, and zero values, which means every advantage surrendered on draft night was surrendered for nothing in return. The most damning evidence sits at the top: Colston Loveland, Kyle Pitts, Travis Kelce, Chigoziem Okonkwo, and T.J. Hockenson are all projected starters, a collection assembled by repeatedly paying premium draft capital at positions where the manager was already covered. Meanwhile, the best non-tight-end starter is Stefon Diggs at WR56, a player who doubles as the team's weakest projected starter, and that detail alone tells you where the draft went sideways. A 9-27 record and a 10th-percentile scoring finish in 2025 suggested this manager needed a reset. Instead, MileHighStello doubled down on the same instincts that landed them at 11th in the Donkey Kong division, and the 2026 projections show no reason to expect a different destination.

There is no charitable read available for CodyFagley in the Donkey Kong division, and the draft sheet confirms it in ink that hasn't dried. Six major reaches define this roster, and the most damning of them sits at pick 2.06, where Ladd McConkey, a WR20, was yanked 2.3 rounds before the market came to him. That is a second-round pick doing third-round work at best, and it set the tone for everything that followed. Tyreek Hill, now a WR77 projection clinging to roster relevance, was taken 5.2 rounds early in round twelve, which is the kind of move that makes a draft room go quiet. The lone grace note is Brock Bowers at TE1, but one elite tight end cannot carry a team sitting second percentile in the tournament and twelfth in the division. CodyFagley had the board in front of him and still managed to build something that looks less like a fantasy team and more like a cautionary tale printed and laminated for next year's draft prep.

EmilyKluge lands in the Donkey Kong division ranked tenth, sitting at the 36th percentile of the field, and the roster map does not hide the problem. The receiver group is genuinely impressive, Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4, A.J. Brown at WR8, and Zay Flowers at WR16 headlining a depth chart that would make most managers envious, but in a positionless format the ceiling of a roster is only as high as its weakest projected starters, and Cam Ward at QB23 is a ceiling cap. Tennessee did upgrade around Ward, drafting Carnell Tate fourth overall and adding weapons in free agency, which should help him develop, but "should help him develop" is a prayer, not a projection, and EmilyKluge needed a sure thing. Making it worse, the draft offered no relief: two major reaches, including Darnell Washington taken more than four rounds before his ADP, while every quarterback on the roster

was a value pick because nobody else wanted them either. Coming off a 74th-percentile scoring season in 2025, the arrow is pointing the wrong direction and there is no obvious lever left to pull.

TebowsYouthGrup played the draft about as correctly as a team can without it mattering. Thirteen chalk picks, two genuine steals, and almost nothing taken before its time, yet here they sit at 39th percentile and ninth in the Donkey Kong division, which is the kind of outcome that makes you question whether process even deserves its good reputation. The foundation is real: Jayden Daniels at QB5 and Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 give this roster a ceiling most managers in this field would trade for. But the connective tissue is where the dream curdles. Rashee Rice at WR13 is a projected starter who has spent more time in legal proceedings and medical offices than on a football field, currently sidelined for months following a knee procedure and facing a jail stint for a probation violation, and that is before you factor in the concussion history. The major reaches on Oronde Gadsden and AJ Barner compounded the problem at the margins. TebowsYouthGrup did the work and got the wrong answer anyway.

queenroxanne12 played the draft about as cleanly as anyone could ask. Sam Darnold fell nearly four rounds past his ADP and landed in the final round of picks, Derrick Henry slipped almost a full round, and the overall profile breaks down to eleven chalk selections against zero major reaches. Disciplined, patient, textbook. And yet here sits a team at 52nd percentile, eighth in the Donkey Kong division, projected to tread water in a tournament that rewards boldness as often as it rewards process. The backfield headlined by Omarion Hampton at RB9 and Kenneth Walker III at RB10 is genuinely good. Puka Nacua projects as WR1. But the supporting cast behind those names fades fast, and Sam LaPorta stacking with Jared Goff is the kind of upside play that tends to age poorly when Goff is your actual QB situation. queenroxanne12 did the homework, bought value where the board offered it, and ended up with a team that is fine. Spending correctly on wrong answers is still spending correctly on wrong answers.

claytongr4y is the kind of team that wins a Scott Fish Bowl season in the margins, and the margins here are genuinely interesting. The floor is real: Justin Jefferson at WR6 and Tucker Kraft at TE5 are both projected starters acquired past their ADPs, which means claytongr4y got top-end production at a discount before a single game was played. Drake Maye projecting as a QB2 with a stack between Jalen Hurts and DeVonta Smith gives the lineup multiple explosive ceilings to chase on any given week. The ceiling, though, is where the math gets honest. Jordan Addison projects as the weakest projected starter at WR43, and in a format where every point matters, that slot is the soft tissue this roster has to protect. A 61 percent win rate and 66th percentile scoring in 2025 says claytongr4y already knows how to grind, and a 53rd percentile projection in 2026 says the margin for error is roughly the width of a paper cut. Seventh in the Donkey Kong division feels like the right place to start a conversation, not end one.

thorhalla did not chase the blockbuster pick or mortgage late rounds chasing upside. They just drafted well, over and over, and the board reflects it. Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and Saquon Barkley at RB8 anchor the roster with the kind of projected production that makes weekly decisions feel easy, and Nico Collins at WR9 and Tee Higgins at WR19 give the top of the receiving corps real teeth. The draft was almost entirely chalk, which sounds boring until you realize chalk means getting what you paid for, and thorhalla paired that discipline with a late gift in Alvin Kamara, a projected RB50 who tumbled nearly three full rounds past his ADP before landing at 18.12. That is the kind of find that separates tidy rosters from dangerous ones. The concern is Troy Franklin, a significant reach who projects at WR80, and a quarterback room that does not project to crack the top ten at the position. But this format

rewards having good players, and thorhalla has a lot of them. Sixth in the Donkey Kong division and 60th percentile in the field feels like a floor, not a ceiling.

Last year RyanButz finished in the bottom 18 percent of the field in scoring, the kind of season that makes you question your life choices. The 2026 roster reads like a quiet, determined apology for all of it. The receiver group is the engine of this rebound, with Drake London (WR7), George Pickens (WR10), Garrett Wilson (WR17), and Jaylen Waddle (WR23) all projecting as starters, a murderers' row of top-25 options that Buttz mined with genuine draft discipline: Pickens fell nearly a full round past his ADP, Wilson fell nearly two. Christian McCaffrey (RB3) anchors the backfield as one of the three best running backs in the game, and Harold Fannin (TE6) gives the roster a legitimate weapon at a position that usually produces waiver-wire grief. The one honest concern is at quarterback, where Malik Willis (QB24) projects as the starter and the ceiling is modest. But when the rest of your projected starters look like this, modest quarterback play is a problem you can live with. Buttz lands at the 61st percentile, fifth in the Donkey Kong division, and a full resurrection from 2025 is absolutely on the table.

jeffro303 came into the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl draft swinging with conviction, and the receipts are complicated. Four minor reaches and two major ones dot the board, including Dalton Schultz pulled more than two rounds early and Christian Kirk taken nearly five rounds ahead of his price tag. On paper, that looks like a manager who kept outbidding himself. On the roster, it looks like someone who knew exactly what they wanted and went and got it. The anchor is real: Trey McBride at TE2 is a genuine difference-maker in a positionless format, James Cook at RB5 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 give the lineup a punishing top end, and Patrick Mahomes, even taken a round early at QB12, is still Patrick Mahomes. The question was never whether jeffro303 wanted good players. It was whether the price was worth it. Sitting at 73rd percentile tournament-wide after a 41st percentile finish in 2025, the answer is trending toward yes, and the only thing left to settle is whether jeffro303 saw something the board missed or just got lucky that it shook out this way.

There was no lottery-ticket gamble anchoring this roster, no moment where wtfaneers swung for the fences and either saved or sank their draft. Instead, they just kept coming out ahead on exchange after exchange. Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and Malik Nabers at WR12 give this team a top-end that most managers would trade their entire draft for, and those two are joined in the starting lineup by Joe Burrow at QB4, making the Dart-Nabers stack a genuine secondary weapon rather than a desperation play. The draft chart tells the rest of the story: Jaxson Dart fell more than three rounds past his ADP, David Montgomery came at a discount late in the draft, and Deebo Samuel was sitting there in round 18 like the league forgot about him. One major reach on Nicholas Singleton is a reasonable price for an otherwise disciplined board. A 2025 record of 22-14 confirms this manager knows how to convert draft value into actual wins, and finishing third in the Donkey Kong division while sitting in the 80th percentile of the field suggests the formula is working.

KaceyKasem did not win the draft on one flashy swing. This roster was built pick by pick, round by round, with the kind of quiet discipline that only shows up clearly in the final tally. The foundation starts with Jonathan Taylor, a RB4 projection who slid nearly a full round past his ADP, and De'Von Achane right behind him at RB6, also acquired below market. That is not luck operating twice in the same direction, that is a manager reading the room better than the competition. Layer in Josh Allen at QB1 and George Kittle at TE9 anchoring a Purdy-Kittle stack, and the lineup carries genuine upside at every level. The supporting cast, from Kyle Monangai to Dallas Goedert, gives KaceyKasem options when the unexpected arrives, because it always does. After finishing at the 80th percentile in scoring in 2025, the infrastructure for a deep run is already proven. Sitting second in the Donkey Kong division and 84th percentile tournament-wide, this team belongs exactly where it is.

Sitting first in the Donkey Kong division and in the 93rd percentile of the entire field, montylow14 did not get here by accident. The foundation starts with Bijan Robinson, a projected RB2 snagged at 1.08 when his ADP sat at 1.04, a small gap that still represents genuine board discipline. Then the draft kept delivering: D'Andre Swift, projected RB24, slid more than two full rounds past his ADP and landed at 10.05, the kind of quiet heist that separates sharp managers from the rest. Layer in Lamar Jackson at QB3 paired with Caleb Williams at QB6, with Williams connecting to Luther Burden in a live stack, and the upside architecture here is hard to argue with. The weakest projected starter is Parker Washington at WR35, and if that is the thing to criticize, there is not much to criticize. Fifteen chalk picks kept the roster grounded, four values and one steal built the ceiling, and zero reaches means montylow14 never panicked. This is what a clean draft looks like.
