Maximum Bowers built their roster the way someone shops at a farmers market with no list and bad judgment, reaching on player after player until the cart was full of things that look fine individually but don't add up to a meal. Brock Bowers at TE1 is genuinely elite, and Tucker Kraft at TE5 gives the team a second projected starter most managers would envy, but the draft capital spent to get there tells the real story: Kraft was taken nearly two full rounds before his ADP, and the roster is littered with seven major reaches in all. Justin Herbert was pulled 0.8 rounds early despite a situation where Mike McDaniel's arrival offers intrigue but Jim Harbaugh's ball-control philosophy has already dented Herbert's attempt volume two years running. Then there's the receiver group, where Rome Odunze was reached two full rounds early, Alec Pierce nearly three, and the back end of the projected starters bottoms out at Wan'Dale Robinson at WR47. Third in the Pikachu division, third percentile in the field, this team drafted urgently and arrived nowhere.

There is no soft landing in this preview. neverenough drafted six major reaches and zero steals, which is less a draft strategy than a controlled demolition of draft capital. The most damning entry on the ledger is Oronde Gadsden, a TE16 projection yanked off the board 6.3 rounds ahead of consensus, at pick 3.02, in a spot where the field was still selecting players projected to start and contribute at the top of lineups. That is not a calculated gamble on upside, that is a reach so severe it distorts the entire middle of the draft. Travis Kelce, taken 2.2 rounds early and now projecting as TE10, compounds the problem: two of the team's earliest investments at tight end arrived at a premium and are projecting as the 10th and 16th best players at their position. Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 is real, and the Burrow-Chase stack gives the roster a genuine anchor, but one elite wideout cannot bail out a draft profile that spent its best picks chasing ghosts. The 2025 record was 9-27. Nothing here suggests the math improves.

There is no spin available for BarDad, and at this point the weary observer stops looking for one. The draft log tells the whole story: six major reaches, zero steals, zero values, and a roster that sits in the 8th percentile of the field. The reaches were not random, either. They were systematic and directional, as if BarDad had a plan and then executed it badly. Brian Robinson came off the board 4.6 rounds ahead of his ADP. James Conner went 4.7 rounds early. Trey Benson was taken a staggering 6.2 rounds before the market agreed he was worth selecting. Those are not aggressive bets on upside. Those are rounds of draft capital spent acquiring players the rest of the field had politely declined. The floor here is propped up by Josh Allen and Saquon Barkley, both legitimate stars, but even that foundation gets undermined when Rico Dowdle, a free-agent back splitting time in Pittsburgh, lands among your projected starters. BarDad finished 45th percentile last year and appears to have drafted toward something worse.

There is not much to argue with here, and that is the problem. MasterSwordSwipes sits 9th in the Pikachu division and in just the 21st percentile of the field, and the roster does not hide why. The wide receiver and tight end groups are genuinely strong, Puka Nacua at WR1 and Tyler Warren at TE4 are legitimate difference-makers, and Sam LaPorta at TE8 gives this team real depth at the position. But the quarterback situation is where hope goes to quietly expire. Tyler Shough is the projected starter at QB20, an aging signal-caller whose Year 2 leap feels more like a philosophical question than a realistic expectation, and the stack with Chris Olave at WR11 is the kind of thing that sounds clever until Shough reminds you he grades out as a fringe starter. The draft offered no relief, producing zero steals and two major reaches, including Jadarian Price pulled nearly two and a half rounds early to become the projected weakest starter on the roster. This team is not broken in every direction, it is simply stuck, with a ceiling defined by a quarterback who may not be able to reach it.

Xxplosive drafted with genuine discipline: nine chalk picks, two steals, and most of the roster landing at or after ADP, including Baker Mayfield at QB18 falling more than two rounds to round ten and Dalton Kincaid at TE11 sliding a similar distance to round nine. The value was real. The problem is that value-hunting rewarded this team with a receiver group stacked eight deep in projected starters, led by Justin Jefferson at WR6, George Pickens at WR10, and DeVonta Smith at WR14, a player who finally gets to prove he is an alpha with A.J. Brown out of Philadelphia. That is a genuinely elite top end. But the rest of the roster never got built, and the draft's two major reaches, Josh Downs at WR46 and Dontayvion Wicks at WR96, represent early capital spent reinforcing the one area that did not need help. You can buy low all draft long and still walk out with a lopsided cart. Xxplosive sits eighth in the Pikachu division and at the 40th percentile, which is exactly what a disciplined draft that somehow missed the point looks like.

PetFries sits at 57th percentile, division rank seven, the exact temperature of lukewarm water, and the roster reflects that cosmic mediocrity with uncomfortable precision. The ceiling is real: CeeDee Lamb at WR5, Rashee Rice at WR13, and Garrett Wilson at WR17 give this team a genuine top-end that can beat anyone on a given week, and the Patrick Mahomes and Rice stack adds the kind of tournament-breaking upside that turns a forgettable season into a deep run. But the margins are where PetFries bleeds out. Three major reaches in the draft, including Zachariah Branch at WR75 taken 3.2 rounds early and Romeo Doubs at WR53 grabbed two full rounds before the market agreed, suggest a manager who drafted with optimism where patience was required. The projected weakest starter is Michael Wilson at WR39, himself a steal taken at 11.10 against an ADP of 9.04, which tells you the floor is survivable. Survivable, though, does not win a Scott Fish Bowl. In a format where the margins decide everything, PetFries has just enough quality to make those margins agonizing to watch.

Jigglypuff didn't need a splashy moment to build something worth watching. The foundation starts with Ashton Jeanty (RB7) and Omarion Hampton (RB9), two projected starters who give this team a backfield core that most managers in the Pikachu division would trade for without hesitation, and Breece Hall (RB14) and Javonte Williams (RB17) push the depth even further. Amon-Ra St. Brown (WR4) is the kind of receiver who quietly makes a roster look better than it might otherwise, and the supporting cast filled in at reasonable cost: DK Metcalf (WR36) slipped a full round past his ADP, Hunter Henry (TE18) fell nearly two rounds before Jigglypuff scooped him, and Travis Hunter (WR62) came in more than three rounds late as the draft's clearest steal. Jalen Hurts (QB9) anchors the quarterback group as a projected starter. The draft chart shows fourteen chalk picks against zero major reaches, which sounds boring until you realize it means this team almost never overpaid. Sitting at 62nd percentile overall with a collection this tidy, Jigglypuff has quietly earned the right to surprise people.

Tizwak didn't swing for the fences and miss, didn't chase upside at the expense of a foundation. This roster was built pick by pick, and the cumulative effect is a team sitting at the 72nd percentile that feels like it belongs higher. The backfield alone could carry a season: De'Von Achane at RB6, Chase Brown at RB11, and Kyren Williams at RB15 give this team a projected starting group that most managers would trade their entire draft for. Williams was a reach at 1.5 rounds early, fair enough, but the rest of the draft more than covered the tab. Matthew Stafford fell 2.2 rounds past his ADP before Tizwak scooped him up at QB14, and Trey McBride at TE2 quietly anchors the back end of the lineup in a position where most of the field is scrambling. The receiver corps is thinner on star power, but in a positionless format, Achane and Brown make that a secondary concern at worst. Fifth in the Pikachu division is the current read. That number should move.

There are no heist stories here, no moment where rwormeli reached into the draft and pulled out a hidden gem nobody else saw coming. What this roster reflects instead is something quieter and arguably harder: a draft that simply kept winning on the margins. Brock Purdy sliding more than two full rounds past his ADP to land at 7.11 is the headliner, and Tee Higgins falling a round and a half to provide a projected WR19 starter at a discount is the supporting act that makes the whole thing feel intentional rather than lucky. Anchor that with Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and Jonathan Taylor at RB4, both projected starters, and the foundation is about as solid as it gets in this field. The draft was otherwise chalk, which is not a criticism, because chalk built around genuine value at the top produces exactly the kind of roster that sits at the 78th tournament percentile. rwormeli enters 2026 without a signature narrative, just a well-constructed team that quietly belongs in the conversation.

SpacemanSpiff91 sits third in the Pikachu division and in the 83rd percentile of the field, and the draft explains exactly how that happened: not through one audacious swing but through a pattern of consistently getting more than fair value. Davante Adams landing at WR25 while falling more than two full rounds past his ADP is the headline, but Drake London coming in at WR7 a few picks later than the market expected quietly matters just as much, and those two join A.J. Brown at WR8 to give this roster a murderer's row of projected starters. George Kittle at TE9 adds another projected starter, though the Achilles tear that ended his 2025 season introduces real uncertainty about whether that projection ever materializes in full. The Isaiah Likely reach at TE13 is the one moment SpacemanSpiff91 blinked, but with Jahmyr Gibbs projected at RB1 anchoring the whole thing, this roster has the kind of quiet, compounding quality that tends to show up in win columns without ever asking for credit.

Down-B FC did not build a fantasy roster so much as engineer a set of detonators, and the whole thing goes up or nothing does. The twin stacks anchoring this team, Jayden Daniels paired with Terry McLaurin and Jaxson Dart paired with Malik Nabers, are not hedges or happy accidents. They are the architecture. When a quarterback throws a touchdown, his receiver scores too, and Down-B FC has that principle baked into both of its primary passing game investments. The Nabers piece carries the most intrigue: after a torn ACL that his own coach called "not simple," Nabers avoided the PUP list and reportedly looked like himself in training camp, which means his WR12 projection could be the floor rather than the ceiling if he is genuinely whole. Dart, meanwhile, was the draft's clearest bargain, falling more than two rounds past his ADP. If those two stacks fire in concert across a season, this roster, sitting at 98th percentile in the field, has the ceiling to match its billing. If they do not, the correlation that makes this team dangerous is the same thing that buries it.

Deuce1184 did not win this draft with one thunderbolt pick. They won it the way a good poker player wins a session, consistently getting more than they paid for. Lamar Jackson at QB3 slipped four picks past his ADP. Dak Prescott fell nearly two full rounds before Deuce1184 scooped him at QB7. Kyle Pitts landed a round late. Courtland Sutton landed nearly two rounds late. None of those individual gaps are shocking, but stack them together and the cumulative edge is real, which is exactly what a 99th-percentile tournament ranking reflects. The projected starting group is genuinely loaded: Jackson pairs with Zay Flowers as a live stack, Bijan Robinson sits at RB2, Nico Collins checks in at WR9, and Pitts anchors the position at TE7. Deuce1184 did carry one meaningful blemish, reaching nearly three rounds early for Jonah Coleman at RB51, but one overpay on a dart throw does not undo a draft built on discipline. First in the Pikachu division heading into 2026 looks exactly right.
