friscojosh enters 2026 sitting third in Diablo II and in the bottom five percent of the field, and the roster tells you exactly why. The running back group is genuinely impressive, headlined by Christian McCaffrey (RB3) and Ashton Jeanty (RB7), with Jeremiyah Love (RB13) and Cam Skattebo (RB20) providing legitimate depth behind them. But in a positionless format, the ceiling of your roster is set by your worst projected starters, and that is where this team gets painful. Patrick Mahomes projects as a QB12, which is already uninspiring, and the receiver corps reads like a waiver wire snapshot: Jayden Reed (WR48) leads a group that also includes Tyreek Hill at WR77. The draft offered no salvation either, logging zero steals and zero values against fourteen chalk selections and six minor reaches. friscojosh did not build value, they paid full retail for everything and still came up short at the positions that matter most. The running backs are excellent, and they are mostly irrelevant to closing that gap.

Winnerswin2233 sits 11th in Diablo II and in just the 14th percentile of the field, and the draft record offers little reason for optimism about the path forward. The most damning evidence is at the top of the board: Jaxson Dart was pulled 2.5 rounds ahead of his ADP at pick 2.12, making him the costliest investment on the roster, and he projects as merely QB11. That is an expensive price for a player who grades out as average at his position, and it set the tone for a draft that logged two major reaches and four minor ones against zero steals. The lone bright spot is the Dart/Malik Nabers stack, which at least gives the team a ceiling game when those two connect. Nabers projects at WR12 and is a legitimate starter, but he was also taken slightly ahead of his ADP, so even the roster's best piece was not acquired at a discount. With the weakest projected starter grading out at WR43, Winnerswin2233 is not hiding a lever to pull. They drafted their way here, and the standings are just catching up.

Entanglement Theory arrives in Diablo II's 2026 season sitting 10th in the division and in the 32nd percentile of the field, and the roster does not offer much reason to argue with either number. The backfield is genuinely impressive, with Kenneth Walker III (RB10), Derrick Henry (RB12), Kyren Williams (RB15), and Josh Jacobs (RB16) all projected as starters, but in a positionless format that firepower only carries a team so far when the receiver group grades out as one of the weakest in the tournament. Alec Pierce (WR32) and Michael Pittman (WR44) top that group, and neither projects as a difference-maker. The draft did not help matters: the board produced zero steals and zero values against 15 chalk picks, two major reaches, and three minor ones. Reaching nearly five rounds early for Christian Kirk (WR100) was particularly brutal, and Blake Corum (RB35) projects as the weakest starter

on the roster after being taken more than two rounds ahead of his ADP. This roster reads less like a team waiting to catch fire and more like one quietly hoping nobody notices it ran out of matches before the season started.

Rakanishu enters 2026 sitting ninth in the Diablo II division and at the 43rd percentile of the field, and the roster construction does not suggest a dramatic reversal is coming. The top of the lineup is genuinely appealing: Justin Jefferson projects as WR6, Trey McBride slots in at TE2, and Rashee Rice adds real starter-quality depth at WR13. The problem is that this team is built like a house with a spectacular second floor and a crumbling foundation. Jordan Love checks in at QB17 and Kyler Murray at QB19, meaning the quarterback position projects as one of the weakest in the entire tournament regardless of which one starts. In a positionless format where every scoring contribution matters, dragging that kind of dead weight at the most impactful position is genuinely difficult to overcome. The Kyler Murray and Jefferson stack offers some upside if the two connect more than projections suggest, but banking on a stack to bail out a roster that produced zero steals and zero values on draft day is a thin prayer, not a plan.

Doogie448 enters 2026 sitting eighth in Diablo II, and the roster tells you why. The foundation looks deceptively solid: Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and Saquon Barkley at RB8 are genuine difference-makers, and Caleb Williams projects as a QB6. But this is a format where depth of quality matters up and down the lineup, and past that top cluster the drop-off is steep. Tee Higgins at WR19 and Davante Adams at WR25 are serviceable, not scary, and Jaylen Warren projects as the weakest projected starter at RB27, a slot that will cost points week after week. Worse, the draft offered almost no relief: zero steals, zero values beyond a marginally late Dallas Goedert, and a James Conner reach of nearly five rounds that lands a player projected RB56. When your best draft move is a TE15 you landed a round late, the math is working against you. At 50th percentile overall and eighth in the division, doogie448 is not rebuilding, just hoping the projections are wrong.

The Achane Sanctuary sits at the 51st percentile, and that number tells you almost everything: this roster is decided by execution, not by talent gap. The wide receiver group is genuinely loaded at the top, with Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4, Emeka Egbuka at WR18, and Ladd McConkey at WR20 all projected as starters, and the Herbert-McConkey stack gives the team a scoring correlation that can turn a good week into a great one. But the margins close quickly down the depth chart. Quentin Johnston projects as the weakest projected starter at WR41, and that ceiling matters in a format where every point counts. Isaiah Likely, now following John Harbaugh to a light tight end room in New York, offers real upside at TE13 if the Giants lean on him the way Baltimore never quite did. De'Von Achane at RB6 is the kind of high-floor anchor that keeps a team competitive even on bad weeks. This team went 22-14 last season and scored in the 67th percentile. It knows how to win close. The question is whether the margins break its way again.

MoockNasty sits at the 51st percentile, which is another way of saying this roster will live and die by the thinnest of margins, and right now the evidence cuts both ways. The receiving corps is the engine here: Jaxon Smith-Njigba projects at WR3, Jameson Williams at WR21, and a Goff-Williams stack gives the team a correlated upside path when Detroit has a big week. That ceiling is real. But the floor is what keeps you up at night. Last season produced a 36 percent win rate and 22nd-percentile scoring, and nothing in this draft screams course correction. Sixteen chalk picks out of eighteen total is a conservative sheet, and the one moment the manager swung early, a three-round reach on Chris Bell at WR87, landed on a player projected well outside the starting conversation. Tyjae Spears at RB47 was the lone genuine steal, but one bargain does not reshape a roster built this close to the median. In Diablo II, seventh place is exactly where you end up when the margins break the wrong way.

The Pindleskin Farmers finished last season at 59th percentile and somehow came out of this draft looking like a legitimately better team, which raises the question of how much of that is skill and how much is nerve. The answer might be: some of both. The core is real. Jonathan Taylor at RB4, CeeDee Lamb at WR5, and Breece Hall at RB14 give this roster the kind of top-end talent that actually wins weeks in the Scott Fish Bowl. The reaches are real too, three minor and one major, the most glaring being Chris Brazzell II taken 7.5 rounds before consensus said to. That is either a conviction play or a wasted pick, and Brazzell's WR101 projection currently votes for the latter. The more interesting reach question is Bhayshul Tuten, taken as RB25 with Travis Etienne now gone to New Orleans and Jacksonville's backfield genuinely open. If Tuten claims that role, the manager looks like a visionary. If he splits it, the optimism was just optimism. Fifth in the Diablo II division feels right for a team this good and this unresolved.

There was no lottery ticket, no moonshot pick, no moment where @Lopes_Matthew swung for the fences and either won the crowd or embarrassed himself. Just round after round of getting it right. The foundation is genuinely elite: Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 and A.J. Brown at WR8 give this roster a top-end that most managers in Diablo II cannot match, and Nico Collins slotting in at WR9 means the drop-off from starter to starter is nearly nonexistent. Tucker Kraft at TE5 and Kyle Pitts at TE7 add another layer of projected production that keeps the lineup humming even when the injury tax comes calling. The one real piece of intrigue is Tyler Shough, who enters Year 2 with an experienced hand and a legitimately dangerous supporting cast in New Orleans, including Chris Olave and top-10 pick Jordyn Tyson. Whether Shough takes a step forward at 27 is uncertain, but the weapons around him are not in question. Sitting at the 75th percentile, this team did not need a heist to get there. It needed a good eye, applied consistently, and that is exactly what the board shows.

Wirt's Leg landed at 82nd percentile in this field and third in the division, and the draft sheet makes that achievement look either inspired or reckless depending on your tolerance for conviction. The board will tell you they reached three times in meaningful fashion, hauling in Malik Willis two full rounds ahead of consensus and Daniel Jones more than two rounds early, burning real draft capital on a quarterback room that projects as a weakness. And yet the roster underneath those decisions is genuinely formidable: Puka Nacua as the WR1, James Cook as the RB5 taken nearly a full round after his ADP, Tetairoa McMillan and Garrett Wilson adding legitimate WR15 and WR17 production to a starting lineup that has real teeth. The quarterback spending looks stubborn in isolation, but if Willis outperforms QB24 projections, this exercise in confident mispricing becomes a masterclass. If he does not, Wirt's Leg will have bought a beautiful car and left the engine on the table.

I am Over Burden-ed did not win the 2026 draft with one splashy moment. They won it by consistently coming out ahead, pick after pick, in a way that quietly adds up to something serious. Brock Bowers at TE1 anchors the roster, and pairing him with Dak Prescott as a stack gives this team a built-in scoring connection that compounds value across the lineup. Prescott himself was a genuine find, a QB7 projection taken nearly a full round after his market price. Then there is Luther Burden, the player this team is arguably built around. After barely cracking 30 percent snap share through Week 9 of 2025, Burden exploded over the final eight games at a pace suggesting a 72-catch, 1,000-yard season, and now Ben Johnson is publicly comparing him to Amon-Ra St. Brown heading into training camp. Burden is still proving the hype is real rather than living off it, but the upside here is genuine. A 23-13 record and second in the Diablo II division is what disciplined, cumulative drafting looks like in practice.

Burrows to Hell drafted like a team that already knew where the bodies were buried. Josh Allen at QB1 and Joe Burrow at QB4 give this roster two of the most dangerous weapons in the field at the position, and the Allen-Dalton Kincaid stack adds a layer of coordinated upside that most managers can only envy. The receiving group is headlined by George Pickens at WR10 and DeVonta Smith at WR14, both projected starters delivering genuine top-tier production. What makes the draft truly clean, though, is the efficiency underneath: Cam Ward slid more than three full rounds past his ADP before this team grabbed him, and Parker Washington, Chris Godwin, and Xavier Worthy each fell at least a round beyond their market price. Four values and a steal across the board, against a single minor reach in Travis Kelce, is the kind of draft ledger that holds up to scrutiny. Sitting first in the Diablo II division at the 85th percentile, Burrows to Hell did not get lucky. They were disciplined, patient, and precise.
