There is no diplomatic way to say this: evdokios finished 25th percentile or worse last season and the 2026 outlook is not arriving with a rescue plan. The roster grades out at the 12th percentile of the field, and with zero steals and zero values across the entire draft, there is no hidden gem quietly waiting to outperform his price tag. The best hope for a genuine leap is Justin Jefferson, who projects as WR6 after a 2025 season that looked more like a McCarthy problem than a Jefferson problem, and the arrival of Kyler Murray in Minnesota gives that theory its best audition. Jonathan Taylor at RB4 is genuinely elite. But below that top tier, the depth trails off into a collection of speculative names, and the projected weakest starter is Kenneth Gainwell at RB34, which is not the kind of depth chart situation that closes gaps. Caleb Williams and Justin Herbert give the quarterback room real upside, yet in a

positionless format, quarterback ceiling only matters if the rest of the roster can hold the floor, and right now that floor looks very far down.

Floorkillah won 69 percent of their matches last year and scored in the 88th percentile, which is the kind of résumé that makes a manager feel bulletproof heading into a draft. The 2026 numbers are a quiet correction to that confidence. The team sits 11th in the Disco Elysium division and projects to the 29th percentile, a gap wide enough to raise questions about whether last year was construction or luck. The core is genuinely good: Bijan Robinson at RB2 and George Pickens at WR10 are real assets, and the projected starters hold up reasonably well through the middle of the roster. But the draft did not add much edge, logging zero steals and 15 chalk picks, and the one aggressive swing that stands out is Garrett Wilson, taken 1.3 rounds ahead of his ADP at a projected WR17. That is a fine player acquired at a price that assumes he outperforms his projection. When your best draft story is a reach on a WR17, the roster is leaning hard on 2025 karma it may not have earned.

Sorry Cop finished 2025 at the 97th percentile, and the 2026 projection of 30th percentile is not a typo. The roster that built an 86% win rate is mostly gone in spirit if not in name, replaced by a group that projects as a middling tournament entry, sitting tenth in the Disco Elysium division. Christian McCaffrey at RB3 is the loudest reminder of what this team was, but McCaffrey has been loudest reminder material before and it rarely ends the way you need it to. Lamar Jackson at QB3 keeps the ceiling from collapsing entirely, and the Dak Prescott and Jake Ferguson stack adds some floor, but with fourteen chalk picks, zero steals, and two major reaches in Tank Dell and David Njoku that burned a combined six-plus rounds of draft equity, Sorry Cop drafted like a manager who expected the 2025 version of this roster to simply show up again. It did not. The reputation is real. The gap between what this team was and what it projects to be is realer.

Magnesium Based Life Form finished 2026 at the 36th percentile, and the roster explains why. The draft delivered zero steals and zero values across the entire board, which is a miserable return in a tournament where small edges compound over a long season. The bright spots are real: Ja'Marr Chase projects as WR2, Omarion Hampton as RB9, and Breece Hall as RB14, so the top of the lineup can hang with most teams in the Disco Elysium division. The problem is everything underneath it. Two major reaches, Mac Jones at QB39 and Pat Bryant at WR86, consumed precious late capital on players who grade out as clear non-contributors. That capital is gone, and no obvious waiver or trade lever remains to correct the math. Chase and Hampton can have spectacular weeks, and this team will still get ground down by depth, because when your projected starters include Dallas Goedert at TE15 and Kenyon Sadiq at TE21, you are not building a winner, you are just managing the descent.

The Hardie Boys finished 21-15 last season and scored in the 69th percentile, which makes their current 36th-percentile projection feel like a trapdoor opening beneath them. The receiver corps is genuinely excellent, with CeeDee Lamb (WR5), Drake London (WR7), and Chris Olave (WR11) all projecting as starters, and Harold Fannin (TE6) and Travis Kelce (TE10) give this team a tight end room that most managers would sell a kidney for. But the scoring engine sputters everywhere else. Kyler Murray checks in at QB19, TreVeyon Henderson at RB19, and those two are supposed to be the pillars holding up the rest of the lineup. The draft didn't offer much salvation either: Henderson and Murray were the headlining values, both taken only slightly past ADP, and Tre Harris was pulled 2.8 rounds early at WR72, which is the kind of reach that tends to look worse in October than it did in August. When your best draft-day move is a tight end in round 17, there are no levers left to pull.

Tequila Sunset finished 2025 in the 85th percentile, and the manager has apparently decided the best way to honor that achievement is to build a completely different team. The 2026 roster projects to the 37th percentile and sits seventh in the Disco Elysium division, which is a long way from where the reputation points. The core is real: Joe Burrow at QB4 stacks with Tee Higgins at WR19, and Jahmyr Gibbs projects as RB1, so the ceiling exists. But the draft was almost aggressively cautious, producing zero steals and fifteen chalk picks against a single notable value in Burrow, who fell half a round. The most telling move is Makai Lemon, reached 2.2 rounds early at WR40 and slotted as a projected starter, suggesting the manager saw something in a player the market hasn't priced in yet or, less charitably, burned draft capital on hope. When your weakest projected starter is KC Concepcion at WR50, the margin for those kinds of bets is thin. Last year's Tequila Sunset was a buzz. This one is mostly ice.

Just Normal Men is a team that will be decided by the players in the middle of the roster, not the stars at the top. De'Von Achane at RB6 and Trey McBride at TE2 are legitimate difference-makers, and A.J. Brown arriving as a good value at WR8 gives this team a ceiling worth believing in. But the margins are where this season lives or dies, and the margins are murky. Jordan Love, projected at QB17, is the clearest example: he is the kind of quarterback whose real value outpaces his fantasy output, and until Green Bay's receiving room proves otherwise, that gap is unlikely to close. Patrick Mahomes at QB12 costs a minor reach but provides real upside if the stars align. Rico Dowdle at RB32 is the weakest projected starter, and in a format where the best players play regardless of position, that means Dowdle is simply one of the ten players this team is counting on. Sixth in the Disco Elysium division and sitting at the 45th percentile, Just Normal Men is not dangerous enough to fear and not vulnerable enough to target. The margins decide everything.

atfantasynav built something genuinely good here, and the receipts are messy. Three major reaches dot this draft, no steals, and the ADP sheet looks like someone kept jumping their own queue. But then you look at the roster and the counterargument assembles itself: Ashton Jeanty at RB7, Tyler Warren at TE4, Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 stacked with Jared Goff, and a Kyren Williams at RB15 holding down a projected starting spot. That is a legitimate core. The reaches that drew the eye, Jakobi Meyers taken nearly three rounds early and Jack Bech grabbed more than three rounds ahead of consensus, are the kind of moves that look stubborn in the moment and prophetic if they hit. The 2025 campaign, a 34th-percentile finish, gives this team real reason to want a reset, and the talent is there to get one. Whether atfantasynav is a visionary drafter or someone who got away with it lands at 47th percentile for now, which feels like a verdict waiting to be appealed.

The Buffalo Waterbuffalos didn't make any one move that will be the talk of the Disco Elysium division, and that might be exactly the point. This roster was built pick by pick, and the results speak quietly but clearly: six projected starters at receiver, headlined by Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and Rashee Rice at WR13, with Jameson Williams, D.J. Moore, Rome Odunze, and Marvin Harrison Jr. rounding out a group that gives the manager real options every single week. Colston Loveland at TE3 adds another blue-chip piece without requiring anything dramatic around him. The one genuine concern is at quarterback, where Jaxson Dart checks in at QB11 after being taken roughly two rounds earlier than his ADP suggested, meaning Buffalo paid a premium for its most uncertain position. That's a real cost. But when the rest of the roster consistently delivers at or above projection, you can absorb an overpay. Sitting at 47th percentile heading in, the Waterbuffalos aren't a favorite, but they are absolutely a problem for whoever draws them.

There is no single flashpoint moment that defines thescrewer's 2026 roster, no audacious gamble that either validates genius or exposes recklessness. What there is instead is a draft that simply, repeatedly, came out ahead. Five values landed across the board, against just one major reach, and the compounding effect is a lineup that sits at the 70th percentile of the field and third in the Disco Elysium division. Brock Bowers at TE1 anchors everything, the kind of positional advantage that quietly inflates a roster's ceiling every single week. Josh Jacobs at RB16 arrived nearly two rounds after his ADP suggested he would, and Bhayshul Tuten at RB25 followed a similar script, falling 1.3 rounds into thescrewer's lap. Add Nico Collins at WR9 and Malik Nabers at WR12 projecting as starters, and the top of this roster has genuine weight behind it. Sam Darnold at QB21 is the honest blemish, but you do not need a great quarterback when almost everything else was drafted with this much quiet discipline.

Scrabbleff came to the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl draft with a plan and executed it cleanly, landing in the 84th percentile of the field without a single reach on the board. The foundation is exactly what you want: Josh Allen at QB1 and Saquon Barkley at RB8, both acquired at a discount past their ADPs, anchoring a projected starting lineup that projects to be among the better ones in the Disco Elysium division. Then add Kyle Pitts and George Kittle as projected starters at tight end, and you are looking at genuine positional value layered on top of genuine positional value. The steal of the draft was Colby Parkinson, a TE31 projection scooped nearly three full rounds after his ADP suggested he would go. That kind of discipline compounds. Fifteen chalk picks tells you scrabbleff was not gambling, and zero reaches tells you they were never rattled into overpaying. Coming off a 97th-percentile scoring season in 2025, this roster looks less like a rebuild and more like a reload with better fundamentals.

LuvBomber is sitting at the top of the Disco Elysium division for a reason, and that reason is not luck. It is a draft executed with the kind of cold precision that makes other managers stare at the recap and wonder where their afternoon went. Puka Nacua at WR1 anchors a starting group that also includes DeVonta Smith at WR14 and Tetairoa McMillan at WR15, with McMillan arriving a full round after his ADP because LuvBomber simply waited him out. Jayden Daniels at QB5 gives the passing game a legitimate headliner, and James Cook at RB5 slid just enough past his ADP to qualify as a minor gift from an inattentive room. The draft sheet shows two outright steals, four additional values, and a single minor reach across the entire roster. That is not a fluke distribution. That is a manager who came in with a plan, adjusted in real time, and left almost nothing on the table. At the 91st percentile of the field, LuvBomber is not sneaking up on anyone.
