BloodBathNByond enters 2026 sitting 12th in the Dr. Mario division and in the bottom 10 percent of the field, and the roster does not hide why. The wide receiver group is the soft underbelly of this thing, with DK Metcalf and Courtland Sutton projecting at WR36 and WR37, and Makai Lemon at WR40 rounding out the starters, none of them anywhere near a top-tier fantasy asset. The draft did not help matters either, offering zero steals and two major reaches, including Sutton himself, taken 2.5 rounds ahead of his ADP. Christian McCaffrey and Lamar Jackson give the team a legitimate ceiling, but the rest of the projected starters are a collection of maybes and hopefuls, including Bhayshul Tuten, whose path to relevance depends entirely on whether Jacksonville hands him a lead role after Travis Etienne walked out the door. That is a real possibility, not a guarantee, and building a tournament run around possibilities is exactly the kind of leverage BloodBathNByond does not have room for right now.

There is no polite way to say this: tswanson55 is staring down a long season from the wrong end of the telescope. Sitting 11th in the Dr. Mario division and projecting in just the 22nd percentile of the field, the roster has real pieces but not quite enough of them. Bijan Robinson at RB2 is a genuine anchor, and Nico Collins at WR9 gives the lineup a second player worth building around, but the drop-off is steep and fast. D'Andre Swift at RB24 and Tucker Kraft at TE5 round out the projected starters well enough, and the Love-Kraft stack adds a small structural bonus, but Jordan Love grading out as QB17 means that bonus is buying at a discount. The draft offered no help, producing 17 chalk picks, zero steals, and zero values, which means this roster is exactly what it looks like on paper with no hidden upside waiting to emerge. Last year's 36 percent win rate was not a fluke. This year's projection suggests it was a preview.

There is not much to spin here for bryanking221 in the Dr. Mario division, where the team sits tenth and projects out near the 28th percentile of the field. Jaxson Smith-Njigba at WR3 is the genuine centerpiece, a top-tier asset that any manager would build around, but the rest of the projected starters drop off in ways that are hard to paper over. Omarion Hampton and Kenneth Walker III grade out as RB9 and RB10 respectively, solid but not the kind of lottery-ticket upside that rescues a roster from the middle of the pack, and bryanking221 reached almost a full round early to land Walker. The draft did the team no favors more broadly, producing zero steals, zero values, and two major reaches, with Khalil Shakir, the projected weakest starter at WR51, coming nearly two and a half rounds ahead of his ADP. Smith-Njigba is a real asset, but one elite piece surrounded by mediocrity is a tough way to compete in a field this deep. The ceiling here is frustratingly visible and the floor is closer than bryanking221 would like to admit.

No Punt Intended finished 2025 in the 82nd percentile, and whoever is running this team in Dr. Mario is probably still cashing that check mentally, because the 2026 projection, 28th percentile and ninth in the division, is a hard reset. The core tension is right there in the roster: the wide receiver group is legitimately impressive, with A.J. Brown at WR8, Tetairoa McMillan at WR15, and Emeka Egbuka at WR18 all projecting as starters, and Brock Bowers at TE1 anchors the whole thing. But last year's version of this team apparently ran on something that isn't here anymore, because when you scroll down past those names you hit Jordan Mason at RB41, Brian Robinson at RB45, and a quarterback room where Brock Purdy and C.J. Stroud project at QB13 and QB22 respectively. The draft was almost entirely chalk, fifteen of nineteen picks landing right at ADP, which reads less like a plan and more like someone hoping the 2025 magic was still in the bag. It wasn't.

jerry926 enters 2026 sitting eighth in the Dr. Mario division and hovering right around the 42nd percentile of the field, and nothing about the roster construction suggests that gap is about to close. The WR group is the one genuine bright spot, with Amon-Ra St. Brown (WR4), Chris Olave (WR11), and DeVonta Smith (WR14) all projecting as starters, and the Jared Goff / St. Brown stack gives the team a real ceiling in any week those two go nuclear together. The problem is that everything else is asking a lot. Matthew Stafford grades out as a QB14 and Goff as a QB16, meaning both quarterbacks project as mid-tier options. Jonathan Taylor (RB4) is legitimately elite, but the projected starter pool drops off sharply from there, with Quinshon Judkins (RB22) and Chuba Hubbard (RB29) as the next options and Travis Kelce sliding to TE10. For a team that went 64 percent in 2026, this roster feels like it is drawing down on savings it no longer has.

POCKETDOGZ drafted with genuine discipline. Fourteen chalk picks, only three reaches of any consequence, and value found late where it mattered. The process was sound. The roster that emerged is still sitting seventh in the Dr. Mario division and projecting at the 43rd percentile, which is the kind of outcome that makes you question everything you thought you knew about drafting. The floor here is real: Ja'Marr Chase at WR2, Malik Nabers at WR12, Rashee Rice at WR13, and Garrett Wilson at WR17 give this team a projected starting group that would anchor most contenders. But this format rewards depth and positional breadth across starters, and when you scroll past that receiver core the cupboard gets sparse fast. Bo Nix projects as a QB15, Bryce Young as a QB26, and the stack with Jaylen Waddle is a thin hope rather than a structural advantage. POCKETDOGZ found value correctly and still landed here. Sometimes the draft does everything right and the math just refuses to cooperate.

RedZone Remedy sits at the 49th percentile and sixth in the Dr. Mario division, which is basically the fantasy equivalent of a restaurant with a 3.1-star Yelp rating: not a destination, not a warning, just a place where things could go either way depending on the night. The ceiling here is real. De'Von Achane, Derrick Henry, Jeremiah Love, and Breece Hall give this team a genuinely frightening top end, and CeeDee Lamb anchors the receiver group at WR5. The problem is the margins, and two draft decisions in particular tighten them considerably. Jakobi Meyers, the projected weakest starter, was taken two full rounds before his ADP, and Chimere Dike was pulled 3.1 rounds early, making him the single most aggressive reach on the board. Those picks compressed the capital that could have built a cushion elsewhere. Oronde Gadsden at TE16 was a reasonable anchor at the position until the Chargers signed David Njoku late, which doesn't sink Gadsden but adds exactly the kind of quiet uncertainty a 49th-percentile team can't really afford.

GazRam did not swing for the fences and miss. They just kept hitting singles, and now they're standing on third base. The clearest evidence is at quarterback, where Drake Maye and Caleb Williams landed as values, Maye slipping to 2.06 despite projecting as QB2, Williams falling a full round past his ADP to land at QB6. Those are not lottery tickets, they are confirmed assets acquired at a discount. The James Cook reach at 1.07 is the one moment where GazRam paid a premium, but when you are pulling QB2 and QB6 talent below market price elsewhere, you have earned the right to be aggressive on a projected RB5. The Caleb Williams and Luther Burden stack adds a ceiling layer to what is otherwise a quietly methodical roster. Coming off a 78 percent win rate and 84th-percentile scoring in 2025, GazRam enters the Dr. Mario division sitting fifth, right at the tournament median, which feels less like a ceiling and more like a conservative floor for a team that consistently drafted smarter than the board expected.

The draft board will tell you that It ain't EZ being cheesy reached twice in a major way and twice more in a minor way, which sounds like a manager gambling with house money. The roster will tell you something different. Chris Godwin, pulled two-plus rounds before his WR38 ADP, lands in a lineup already anchored by Puka Nacua at WR1 and Tee Higgins and Ladd McConkey projecting as WR19 and WR20 respectively, and suddenly that reach looks less like impatience and more like someone who knew exactly which receiver room they were building. Then there is Colston Loveland at TE3, a genuine difference-maker at a position where most managers are scraping for crumbs. The conviction extended to the later rounds too, where Parker Washington came in a round and a half early and still profiles as a projected starter. None of these picks were safe. All of them worked. At 72nd percentile entering the season, this team sits fourth in Dr. Mario, but the gap between fourth and first is a lot smaller than the draft sheet would have you believe.

StraightCashHomie didn't walk away from the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl draft with one transcendent pick that made the room gasp. What they walked away with was a roster that quietly won round after round, and that kind of consistent execution tends to show up in the standings. The foundation is genuinely impressive: Saquon Barkley at RB8, Trey McBride at TE2, and Tyler Warren at TE4 give this team a ceiling that third-in-the-division doesn't quite do justice to. Yes, Barkley is 29 and the Eagles have reportedly grown more protective of his workload after a 2025 that reminded everyone statistical gravity exists, but RB8 is RB8, and the risk is already priced into that projection. Where StraightCashHomie really separated itself was in the middle rounds, landing Javonte Williams at RB17 and Bucky Irving at RB21, both falling over a round past their ADPs. Pair that with the Jayden Daniels and Terry McLaurin stack, where Daniels himself fell nearly a full round and a half, and you have a team that didn't need a miracle. It just needed to be right, consistently, and it was.

Dr. JJ didn't build this roster with one big swing. The whole thing was assembled pick by pick, with the draft log telling a quiet but convincing story. Landing Josh Allen at QB1 half a round late would be enough for most managers to call it a win, but then Joe Burrow, the QB4, slid all the way to 3.11 against an ADP of 2.05, essentially a round and a half of free value on a quarterback who belongs in the same conversation as the guy drafted ahead of him. From there, the roster just kept compiling. Justin Jefferson at WR6 anchors a wide receiver group that stretches six deep with projected starters, including Alec Pierce, who brings genuine big-play upside if he clears the PUP list before the season starts, and Jameson Williams at WR21, taken slightly before his ADP but well within reason given his ceiling. The draft chart shows 13 chalk picks and only one major reach, which is about as clean a process as you'll see in a field this competitive. At 83rd percentile overall and second in the Dr. Mario division, Dr. JJ looks like a team that earned its position rather than stumbled into it.

mrsfantasydetes didn't build this roster on one splashy swing. They built it pick by pick, coming out ahead on the margin every time, and the standings reflect it: division leader, 91st percentile in the field, a 69 percent win rate in 2025. The foundation is real, with Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and Drake London at WR7 anchoring a starting group that holds up against any roster in the Dr. Mario division. But the draft craft shows up most in the quarterback room, where Dak Prescott fell more than a round past his ADP and Justin Herbert followed a round and a half later, giving mrsfantasydetes two QB1-range arms at a steep discount. Herbert comes with a legitimate ceiling question, playing behind a team that has won 11 games two years running and may lean on ball control again, but as a value at QB8, the risk is already priced in. Prescott and George Pickens even run as a stack. This is what a draft that quietly wins the room looks like.
