There is no charitable read available for IchthysFF, currently projected third in the Dragon Age: Origins division and sitting in the third percentile of the entire field. The draft tells the story: six major reaches across 18 rounds, with not a single steal on the board. The carnage starts early. TreVeyon Henderson, a fine RB19 projection, was hauled off the board nearly three rounds before the market said to, and RJ Harvey followed at a similar premium. That kind of aggressive overpayment signals a manager chasing names rather than value, and the board punished them for it at every turn. Meanwhile, Jared Goff, taken as a stack with Jameson Williams, is the kind of dependable, ceiling-capped asset you deploy when you're managing a contender, not a team already hemorrhaging draft capital. Goff is a safe weekly producer but, as his four-year run makes clear, he is firmly not a league winner, and IchthysFF may have needed one of those. This roster is a lesson in what happens when urgency replaces patience at every single turn.

There is no easy way to dress this up for clemdoggmillionaire: sitting 11th in the Dragon Age: Origins division and hovering around the 16th percentile of the field, this roster is in genuine trouble. The foundation is not without merit, Bijan Robinson projects as RB2 and Kenneth Walker III slots in at RB10, giving the team a legitimate top-end backfield punch. But the draft board tells a story the standings will likely confirm. Fernando Mendoza, a QB27, was taken six full rounds ahead of his ADP, a reach so aggressive it warped the middle of the draft and left the rest of the roster thin on upside. Justin Herbert grades out as a QB8 and steadies things at the position, but the supporting cast beyond Robinson and Walker falls off sharply, with Tee Higgins at WR19 the only credible receiving option among the projected starters, and Juwan Johnson at TE20 the lone tight end on the board. There is no obvious move to make, no sleeper lurking in the late rounds, no lever left to pull.

HankDoge sits 10th in the Dragon Age: Origins division and at the 33rd percentile of the field, and the draft record does little to inspire hope for a turnaround. Four major reaches define the offseason story here, and two of them landed at quarterback: Caleb Williams was pulled 1.1 rounds ahead of his ADP at pick 2.05, and Kirk Cousins was yanked 3.1 rounds early in round 15 for a player who grades out as QB35. That is a lot of draft capital chasing the QB position in a format where you can field whoever you want in almost any mix, and the returns are uneven at best. The floor-raiser that never materialized is Quentin Johnston, the projected weakest starter at WR41, who represents exactly the kind of outcome you dread when the roster is already grading thin. Jonathan Taylor at RB4 and Malik Nabers at WR12 give HankDoge a real foundation, but when the path to contention runs directly through Johnston being good enough, despondent feels like the right operating mood heading into 2026.

HuppBy2TDs sits ninth in the Dragon Age: Origins division and checks in at just the 37th percentile of the field, and the roster construction does little to argue with either number. The saving grace, and really the only one, is a backfield headlined by Christian McCaffrey (RB3) and Ashton Jeanty (RB7), a legitimate top-tier pairing that keeps this team from falling completely off the map. The problem is everything around them grades out thin, and the draft did essentially nothing to change that calculus, producing zero steals and sixteen chalk picks against two minor reaches and a major one. That major reach is the real wound: Justin Fields at QB38, taken 6.2 rounds ahead of his ADP, is the kind of swing that can haunt a roster when it lands that far from consensus. Trevor Lawrence (QB10) steadies the quarterback room, but his 2025 breakthrough came wrapped in enough chaos around him that

projecting a clean repeat requires a certain optimism this roster has not earned. McCaffrey and Jeanty are a real foundation. The floor beneath them, though, is already creaking.

King Henry enters 2026 ranked eighth in the Dragon Age: Origins division and sitting at just the 51st percentile of the field, and there is not much in the construction of this roster to suggest a climb is coming. The quarterback group grades out weak, headlined by Tyler Shough at QB20, with Cam Ward (QB23) and Michael Penix Jr. (QB33) offering little upside behind him, and the Penix selection stings twice because the manager reached 5.6 rounds early to get him. The saving grace is a genuinely strong group led by Trey McBride (TE2), Colston Loveland (TE3), and Tyler Warren (TE4), but elite production at one position only carries a roster so far. Jaylen Waddle (WR23) is an intriguing name given his move from Miami's dysfunction to a Denver offense where Bo Nix threw more passes than anyone in the league last year, but even that upside feels like it is papering over cracks rather than plugging them. With Travis Etienne (RB18) and Zay Flowers (WR16) also in the mix, the floor is not a disaster, but the ceiling looks frustratingly low.

The AARP Warriors are not hedging their bets in 2026, they are doubling down on them, and the whole operation lives or dies by two stacks. Dak Prescott pairs with CeeDee Lamb at WR5, and Kyler Murray pairs with Justin Jefferson at WR6, which means this roster's ceiling is essentially a coin flip on whether Minnesota's quarterback situation resolves cleanly. The Jefferson context matters here: if Murray wins the job and the two build real chemistry, Jefferson's WR6 projection looks conservative, and the Murray/Jefferson stack becomes one of the more dangerous pairings in the field. If Murray never officially takes over, that stack deflates fast and the Warriors are suddenly leaning on a Prescott/Lamb pairing to carry the scoring load alone. The supporting cast, anchored by Derrick Henry at RB12 and Tucker Kraft at TE5, is solid enough to keep the floor respectable, but this team is not constructed to win quietly. It is constructed to win big or explain itself afterward, and after a 3rd percentile showing in 2025, the Warriors have clearly decided that cautious drafting was the problem.

all_biz didn't need a lottery ticket to build this roster, just a steady hand and a sharp eye for value at every turn. The receiving group is where this team announces itself: Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3, Drake London at WR7, and DeVonta Smith at WR14 form a projected starting core that most managers would trade a kidney for, and Terry McLaurin at WR24 is stacked alongside Jayden Daniels, which gives that pairing built-in upside beyond the positional rank alone. The quarterback situation layers in some real intrigue: Daniels projects as QB5, and Brock Purdy at QB13 is a legitimate fallback on weeks when the matchup calls for it, even if Purdy's supporting cast in San Francisco is currently one injury report away from chaos. The draft itself was almost aggressively calm, seventeen chalk picks and just one minor reach, which in this field reads less like timidity and more like a manager

who trusted the board and let the value come to them. Sixth in the Dragon Age: Origins division is the projection, but this team has the pieces to move that number.

clarkbars17 didn't just build a good team, they built a correlated one, and that distinction is where this roster either soars or stalls. The two stacks, Drake Maye with A.J. Brown and Jordan Love with Christian Watson, are the engine here. Maye checks in as QB2 with Brown sitting at WR8, meaning the floor on that pairing is already high before the correlation bonus kicks in. Love at QB17 paired with Watson at WR28 is a lower-probability bet, and the 2.2-round reach to land Love at pick 5.03 signals how badly clarkbars17 wanted that second stack in place. When both pairings fire on the same week, this roster can climb into territory that puts any opponent away. When neither does, the supporting cast, headlined by Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and Tetairoa McMillan at WR15, keeps the floor survivable. The 64th-percentile projection and a fifth-place division standing feel like a roster that got graded on its parts rather than its plan. The plan is the interesting part.

JakeFloriolli did not go hunting for heroes. The draft reads like a series of quiet, correct decisions, the kind that add up to a roster sitting at the 71st percentile without a single moment of flashiness to point to. The tight end group anchors everything: Brock Bowers at TE1 alongside Sam LaPorta at TE8 and George Kittle at TE9 gives this team a ceiling that most managers cannot touch at that position, and Floriolli got both Kittle and Isaiah Likely at discounts of more than a round apiece off their ADP. Yes, Kittle's Achilles tear is a real concern, and his Week 1 availability is genuinely uncertain, but Likely at TE13 means that risk has a cushion. At the top of the receiver group, Chris Olave at WR11 and Rashee Rice at WR13 are legitimate contributors. The one place where Floriolli paid a premium was Omarion Hampton, taken nearly a round ahead of his ADP, though Hampton's projection as RB9 suggests that cost was not unreasonable. This roster did not win the draft on one move. It won it on seventeen smaller ones.

GregWarriorBowl lands at 76th percentile and third in the division not because of one splashy move but because round after round, the ledger tilted the right way. James Cook at RB5 and Saquon Barkley at RB8 give this roster a top-end foundation that most managers would mortgage their middle rounds to acquire, and GregWarriorBowl got there without burning the draft down. Then the real work shows up in the later selections: Javonte Williams falling a full round past his ADP, Alec Pierce dropping nearly two rounds, Jakobi Meyers and Hunter Henry both slipping into value territory as the field moved on. Four players taken meaningfully after their expected spots is not luck, it is a draft that kept finding the market wrong. The one blemish is Bo Nix going at 4.06 against an ADP closer to the sixth round, an early investment at a position this format deprioritizes. But Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and Kyle Pitts at TE7 round out a starting corps built on consistent execution, and consistent execution has a way of compounding.

JKell07 didn't build this roster by accident, and the centerpiece of the whole design is hiding in plain sight: Joe Burrow (QB4) to Ja'Marr Chase (WR2), the most decorated passing partnership in fantasy football, stacked together and pointed at a ceiling that most managers in the Dragon Age: Origins division can only squint at from a distance. Burrow slid to 3.02 despite projecting as QB4, and Chase is WR2, meaning JKell07 essentially bought the stack at a discount, which is the fantasy equivalent of getting two first-class seats for the price of one. The supporting cast around that pairing is where the philosophy gets tested. Quinshon Judkins (RB22), recovered from a late-season fractured fibula that cut short his previous campaign, gives this team a credible secondary weapon if he returns to form in Cleveland. De'Von Achane (RB6) adds another projected starter who can explode on any given week. When the Burrow-Chase connection is cooking, this roster doesn't just compete, it tilts the scoreboard. The entire 2026 season lives and dies on that correlation, and JKell07 bet the draft on it.

RotoWizard didn't win the draft with one flashy pick. They won it by being right, over and over again. Lamar Jackson at QB3 fell nearly a full round past his ADP, and RotoWizard was sitting at the back of Round 2 to collect him. Chris Godwin dropped almost two rounds before landing at WR38 on this roster. Breece Hall slipped nearly two rounds as well, arriving as a projected starter at RB14. None of these are lottery tickets, they are players whose value was sitting on the table and RotoWizard simply did not look away. Add in the Patrick Mahomes and Travis Kelce stack, and there is a real ceiling here if Mahomes returns healthy from his knee injury, and by most accounts his recovery has been ahead of schedule. The result is a squad sitting first in the Dragon Age: Origins division and in the 88th percentile of the field. That kind of draft grade does not happen by accident. It happens when a manager consistently gets a little more than they paid for.
