There is no charitable read available for RyebridgeRockies, and the draft board confirms it. The team sits dead last in the Sensible Soccer division and at the 0th percentile of the entire field, which is less a ranking than a verdict. The carnage starts early: Jordan James was taken at pick 5.01 with an ADP of 22.02, a reach of over 17 rounds that would be the most reckless pick in most drafts but somehow shares a roster with David Njoku, hauled in 7.8 rounds ahead of schedule, and Travis Kelce, taken nearly 2.5 rounds early. Nine major reaches across the draft is not bad luck, it is a philosophy, and this particular philosophy produced a group where Justin Jefferson and Malik Nabers sit atop a starting lineup propped up at the bottom by Jauan Jennings, projected WR63, as the weakest starter. Jefferson and Nabers are real, but no amount of top-end receiver talent papers over a draft built on impulse. RyebridgeRockies did not get unlucky in 2026. They simply reached, repeatedly, and arrived here.

Steve Fake Punts Again sits 11th in Sensible Soccer and in the 2nd percentile of the field, which is about where you land when you draft seven major reaches and zero steals across an entire draft. The crowning achievement is Sam LaPorta at TE8, taken 3.2 rounds early at pick 2.11, which means this manager spent a second-round pick on a tight end while better options waited patiently on the board. That might be forgivable as a one-time lapse of judgment, except the pattern never stopped: Isaiah Likely, taken two full rounds early, Jadarian Price pulled up 4.6 rounds before his time, Khalil Shakir and Xavier Worthy both yanked out of the mid-rounds before the field had any reason to panic. Josh Allen is a genuine QB1 and George Pickens projects as WR10, so the talent ceiling exists, but the floor is built entirely on overpaid guesses. When your weakest projected starter is Worthy and you burned a premium pick getting there, the draft did not go sideways accidentally. It went sideways by design.

MachG1987 sits at the bottom of the Sensible Soccer division and grades out in the 8th percentile of the field, and a close look at the roster makes it hard to argue with either number. The clearest symptom of this team's trouble is the draft: three major reaches in an 18-round format is a punishing tax, and the biggest offender is George Kittle, taken 3.3 rounds early despite coming off an Achilles tear that makes his Week 1 availability genuinely uncertain. Paying a round-three price for a TE9 projection is already a stretch; paying it for a TE9 who may not be healthy enough to collect it is the kind of gamble that quietly poisons a roster's ceiling. Jayden Daniels at QB5 is a legitimate anchor, and Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 stacked alongside him gives this team a pulse, but two strong pieces cannot carry a lineup whose projected weakest starter, Rhamondre Stevenson, clocks in at RB31. There is no obvious lever left to pull here.

Brinty played the value game about as cleanly as you can in a tournament draft. Saquon Barkley fell 1.2 rounds before brinty grabbed him at 4.04. Patrick Mahomes tumbled two full rounds past his ADP and landed at 9.09. Courtland Sutton, Hunter Henry, Blake Corum, all taken after the market had already moved on. By the numbers, this roster should feel like a series of quiet wins. It does not. The wide receiver group tops out at Mike Evans at WR27, and the projected starters behind him, Sutton at WR37, leave brinty fielding the positional equivalent of a value menu that never quite adds up to a meal. The major reach on T.J. Hockenson, pulled 2.4 rounds before his ADP, did not deliver a TE12. It delivered a TE23. That is the particular cruelty of this draft: brinty followed the discipline, collected the discounts, and still sits ninth in Sensible Soccer and at the 23rd percentile of the field, because value only matters if the players were worth finding in the first place.

KeithmcSFB sits eighth in the Sensible Soccer division and in the 31st percentile of the field, and the draft record doesn't offer much reason for optimism. The headline move, Evan Engram at TE36 pulled a full 14.2 rounds ahead of his ADP in round three, is the kind of early commitment that echoes through every subsequent pick, and it shows. The top of the roster glitters convincingly, Christian McCaffrey at RB3, CeeDee Lamb at WR5, and Kyle Pitts at TE7 are all projected starters, but the supporting cast grades out thin fast, and the weakest projected starter, RJ Harvey at RB28, underscores how little margin exists. Mac Jones at QB39, taken more than five rounds early, adds another layer of dead weight in the late rounds where this team needed to find upside. The draft produced four values and zero steals, which is a sheet of ice masquerading as a floor. The stars are real enough. The problem is that everything underneath them looks borrowed from a team that already ran out of answers.

JerrySheaFF did almost everything right at the draft table. Eight values, two major values, and a steal, with Ja'Marr Chase sliding to WR2 at the sixth pick and Harold Fannin dropping more than a round to land as a TE6 starter. On paper, that is the kind of draft that earns a satisfied nod. In practice, the roster sits 7th in the Sensible Soccer division and in the 37th percentile of the field, which tells you something went wrong despite the process. The culprit is concentration: the value hunting built a roster where the upside clusters around players who need things to go right. Dalton Kincaid is a TE11 projection with a knee that Bills GM Brandon Beane would not clear as recently as the offseason, and without Kincaid the bottom of that group thins quickly. The quarterback situation is quietly dire, with Cam Ward projecting as QB23 and backing him up with Malik Willis and Geno Smith is not a plan so much as a prayer. JerrySheaFF found value everywhere and ceiling almost nowhere, and that is the cruelest thing a draft can do to a manager who was paying attention.

chrisdales sits at 50th percentile and sixth in the Sensible Soccer division, which is exactly the kind of position that makes a season feel like it's decided by coin flips. The foundation is genuinely good: Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 give this roster two legitimate difference-makers at the top of the lineup, and the receiving corps has enough projected starters to stay competitive week to week. But the margins cut both ways. Jordan Love was a major reach, taken 2.1 rounds before his ADP with a QB17 projection that doesn't justify the price, and the quarterback room as a whole grades out weak. Terry McLaurin fell 1.5 rounds past ADP and represents real value at WR24, and Chris Olave at WR11 is the kind of find that quietly wins weeks. Still, this roster lives and dies on whether Gibbs and Jeanty stay healthy and whether the receiving depth holds up when the projections get tested. A 2025 record of 18-18 tells you exactly what this team is: fine, unless everything breaks right or wrong.

Stevereaney didn't win the draft on one flashy pick, they won it by repeatedly getting good players at reasonable prices. Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 slid to pick 1.10 when his ADP was 1.06, a small gap that still represents getting a top-three receiver for essentially free. Emeka Egbuka fell more than a full round, Colston Loveland at TE3 was there at 2.03 when most managers expected him gone, and Michael Pittman dropped nearly two rounds to become a late gift in Round 11. Five values across the draft without manufacturing a single one, that is a manager who stayed disciplined and let the board do the work. The wildcard that could make this roster hum is Bhayshul Tuten, who enters 2026 with the Jacksonville backfield genuinely open after Travis Etienne departed for New Orleans. Tuten's athletic profile earned him the opportunity, and if he seizes it, the RB picture improves considerably. Sitting at 71st percentile and fifth in the Sensible Soccer division, Stevereaney has the look of a team that quietly belongs.

There was no single moment where bryanodowd won this draft, which is exactly the point. Rome Odunze fell nearly two rounds past his ADP before landing at WR30 among projected starters. Dak Prescott slid more than a round to become a QB7. Quentin Johnston came off the board a round late at WR41. None of those are lottery tickets, they are just consistently good outcomes, the kind that pile up quietly and add up to something real. The receiver group anchored by Puka Nacua at WR1 and Nico Collins at WR9 is the engine here, and the Stafford-Nacua stack gives bryanodowd a ceiling that shows up when it matters. Last season's 64 percent win rate and 63rd percentile scoring suggest a manager who already knows how to turn roster quality into results. Sitting at 84th percentile in the field after the draft, fourth in Sensible Soccer, this team did not need a heist. It just needed to keep winning small, and it did.

gocall01 sits third in the Sensible Soccer division and at the 98th tournament percentile, and the draft tells you exactly why. This roster was built with patience and precision, and the value column shows it: six picks that beat ADP, two outright steals, and zero major reaches across the entire board. The steals alone are worth lingering on. Trevor Lawrence fell three and a half rounds past his ADP and landed as the QB10, a projected starter who cost a fraction of what he should have. Stefon Diggs slid nearly three rounds and adds meaningful depth behind a receiving corps that already features Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 and Tee Higgins at WR19 as projected starters. Anchor that to Jonathan Taylor at RB4, Trey McBride at TE2, and Tucker Kraft at TE5, and the foundation is not just solid, it is rare. The projected weakest starter is Jakobi Meyers at WR45, which in this context reads less like a

concern and more like a testimonial. After a 12th-percentile finish in 2025, gocal01 drafted like someone with a point to prove, and they made it in April.

The85Bears sit second in the Sensible Soccer division and in the 100th percentile of the entire field, and the draft record explains exactly why: nine values or better against zero major reaches across a full roster. That is not luck, that is discipline. The engine here is obvious, Bijan Robinson (RB2) and De'Von Achane (RB6) give this team a ceiling that most managers in the field simply cannot match, and Caleb Williams (QB6) arriving at pick 4.09 against an ADP of 3.06 means the manager extracted a QB1-caliber player at a discount while everyone else was still sorting out their backfields. The Caleb Williams and Luther Burden (WR22) stack adds another layer of upside, with Burden himself a value taken 1.5 rounds late. Drake London (WR7) anchors the receiving corps at a positional rank that justifies his early selection, and Parker Washington (WR35) as the projected weakest starter is a feature, not a flaw. Clean roster, clean process, nothing to argue with here.

Psalley sits atop the Sensible Soccer division and at the 100th percentile of the entire field, and the draft board tells you exactly why. This roster was built without a single reach, not one, while piling up three steals and nine values across the board. The headliner is Brock Bowers, the TE1 in the tournament, paired with a Drake Maye and A.J. Brown stack that gives Psalley a direct pipeline to two projected starters reinforcing each other every week. Maye came in as QB2, and Brown landed at WR8, yet both fell past their ADP, meaning Psalley paid discount prices for a first-class connection. Rashee Rice fell more than two full rounds before Psalley grabbed him at WR13, and Jaxson Dart, projected QB11, tumbled three complete rounds into the sixth. If the floor of this roster is Jordyn Tyson projecting as WR34, that is a testament to how well every pick landed. Clean board, no apologies, no wasted selections. This is what disciplined drafting looks like when everything goes right.
