As the 2025 fantasy football season unfolds, Ben Rolfe (@BenRolfePFN) faces an uphill battle. Coming off a strong performance in 2024, expectations were high, but the early signs are less than promising. The team languishes near the bottom of the standings, with a concerning 11th place in their division and only the 16th percentile in broader competition. Their once-dominant performance now seems more like a fleeting moment of glory. Despite having a couple of standout tight ends, Trey McBride and Dallas Goedert, the overall roster struggles, particularly at running back, where Austin Ekeler, a shadow of his former self, ranks a dismal RB47 yet is still a starting fixture. The wide receiver corps is similarly troubling, with Nico Collins leading as WR7 but lacking substantial support from Jordan Addison and Jakobi Meyers, both mired in middling positions. Strategic missteps have

compounded their woes; reaching for players like Jonathan Taylor, Austin Ekeler, and others has diluted the team's potential. While there were some draft bargains, they pale in comparison to the significant reaches that have cost crucial value. It's a tough road ahead for Ben Rolfe, and the once bright prospects of a successful season are fading fast into the distance.

As the 2025 fantasy football season approaches, Chris Cipriano (@chrismcipriano) is bracing for yet another challenging year. With a division rank hovering at 10 and sitting in the 24th percentile overall, the outlook appears bleak. The quarterback situation is particularly dire, with Tua Tagovailoa and Aaron Rodgers both struggling to make an impact at QB24 and QB29, respectively. While the wide receiver lineup boasts some talent with Justin Jefferson at WR2 and Malik Nabers at WR4, the depth tapers off quickly, leaving Rashid Shaheed, an uninspiring WR54, as a starter. The running back corps, led by Breece Hall and Kenneth Walker III, fails to inspire confidence, ranking ninth in the division. Additionally, the tight end position offers little hope with Isaiah Likely at TE18. Though there were a few strategic draft picks that provided value, the decision to reach significantly on others has cost the team dearly, setting a grim tone for the season. Overall, without significant improvements

or surprises, it's hard to envision this team climbing out of the lower ranks and making its mark this year.

As Liz Ballard (@lizballard09) embarks on the 2025 fantasy football season, the team finds itself in a precarious position, sitting at ninth in their division and nestled in the 27th percentile overall. Last season's finish in the 58th percentile hinted at potential, but this year demands more resilience. Much of the season's success hinges on Jaydon Blue, ranked RB42, whose performances could swing the team's fortune in either direction. The wide receiver group, despite being talented with names like Davante Adams, DeVonta Smith, Chris Olave, and Deebo Samuel, finds itself lagging at tenth in division rank, suggesting inconsistency at the crucial WR position. Notably, Jared Goff was an astute pick later than expected, offering some glimmer of hope, especially when paired with Sam LaPorta. However, reaching for players like Deebo Samuel and Sam LaPorta earlier than their ADP, and significantly overestimating DeAndre Hopkins and Taysom Hill, has left the team with a challenging

climb ahead. As they navigate through this season, they will need strategic ingenuity and perhaps a touch of luck to improve their standing.

As the 2025 fantasy football season kicks off, Josh Brickner (@joshbrickner) finds itself in a somewhat precarious position. Currently ranked eighth in their division and falling into the 42nd percentile overall, the team is no stranger to challenges. Last year's below-average finish, coupled with a 38th percentile scoring rank, reflects a performance that left much to be desired. However, with a blend of seasoned talent and strategic draft decisions, there is room for optimism. Anchored by a strong collection of running backs, including De'Von Achane and Christian McCaffrey, this team boasts one of the most formidable backfields. Yet, the trajectory of their season might hinge significantly on the performance of Javonte Williams. As a projected starter, his contributions could

prove pivotal, especially given his ranking as RB35 and the investment made to secure him earlier than anticipated. While the running game appears promising, the wide receiver lineup raises some concerns, currently ranked near the bottom of the division. Despite the presence of Garrett Wilson and the acquisition of good value picks like Courtland Sutton and Stefon Diggs, there's a void of star power that might be challenging to overcome. Additionally, the team took a gamble with some early selections in their draft, notably Justin Fields and T.J. Hockenson. While this strategy comes with its risks, it also brings the potential for high rewards, particularly with the stack bonuses they offer alongside Garrett Wilson and J.J. McCarthy. As the season unfolds, Josh Brickner will need to navigate these uncertainties, banking on their top-tier running backs and hoping that their quarterback and wide receiver investments pay off. The team's success will likely depend on striking the right balance between leveraging inherent strengths and addressing evident vulnerabilities.
