There is no spin available for MrBen23, and the numbers do not reward the attempt. Sitting 12th in the Elden Ring division and projected in the 11th percentile of the field, this roster is the product of a draft that produced zero steals, zero values, and three major reaches, which is a particular kind of achievement. The most glaring: Elijah Sarratt, projected WR98, taken four and a half rounds before his ADP, a pick that lands like a confession. Meanwhile, the draft capital spent tripling up at tight end, including Harold Fannin at TE6 and Isaiah Likely at TE13 as projected starters alongside Hunter Henry at TE18, reflects priorities that are hard to defend when the overall roster is this thin at the top. Christian McCaffrey at RB3 is real, and DeVonta Smith at WR14 finally gets his chance as a genuine alpha with A.J. Brown gone to New England. But two legitimate anchors cannot carry a roster this poorly constructed underneath them, and the rest of this draft offers little reason for optimism.

jmuellerpt sits 11th in the Elden Ring division and in the bottom 15 percent of the field, and the draft did nothing to change the trajectory. Zero steals, zero values, and a draft sheet that reads like fourteen rounds of paying full price at a bad grocery store. The saving grace is at the skill positions: Brock Bowers at TE1 and George Pickens at WR10 are genuine difference-makers, and Jaylen Waddle, moving from Miami's dysfunction to a Denver offense where Bo Nix led the league in pass attempts last year, is a quiet upside play projected at WR23. But the roster thins out fast after that, and when the lineup calls for a tenth starter, the answer is Malik Willis at QB24, a projection that doubles as a prognosis. There is no obvious lever left to pull here, no buried value waiting to surface, no timebomb reach that might look smart in October. Bowers and Pickens can carry a week, but they cannot carry a season from the 15th percentile.

jurgenhuck sits tenth in the Elden Ring division and in just the 27th percentile of the field, and the roster does not hide why. The top of the lineup is genuinely good: CeeDee Lamb (WR5) and Justin Jefferson (WR6) are legitimate difference-makers, and Kenneth Walker III (RB10) gives the team a strong floor on the ground. The problem is everything below that tier, where the drop-off is steep and the draft did little to soften the landing. The board offered jurgenhuck 21 picks to build depth and find late value, and the answer was 15 chalk selections, two major reaches in MarShawn Lloyd (RB66) and Kayshon Boutte (WR76), and zero steals. Quentin Johnston (WR41) projects as the weakest starter, which tells you something about how thin the margin for error is. When Lamb and Jefferson are clicking, this team is watchable, but fantasy tournaments punish managers who have no fallback plan, and jurgenhuck drafted like someone who assumed the stars would never need one.

There is no sugarcoating the math here. M1A2 sits ninth in the Elden Ring division and checks in at just the 30th percentile of the field, and nothing in the construction of this roster suggests a dramatic reversal is coming. The foundation is real enough: Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Malik Nabers at WR12 give the team genuine upside at the top, and Omarion Hampton at RB9 keeps the floor from caving in completely. But the drop-off after that is where the season gets difficult. C.J. Stroud projects as the team's weakest projected starter at QB22, Trevor Lawrence sits at QB10 with the asterisk that matters, and the supporting cast beyond the top handful fades quickly into the kind of depth that rarely decides playoff races. A draft that produced zero steals and zero values, just seventeen chalk selections and a handful of minor reaches, means there are no late-round surprises waiting to rescue the projections. Last season ended at .500 and 43rd percentile in scoring. Nothing here suggests the trajectory bends upward.

PurpleReign drafted like a student who read every chapter of the textbook and still failed the exam. The process was nearly impeccable: thirteen picks at chalk, two genuine values in Chuba Hubbard and Matthew Golden, and a steal in Jacoby Brissett, who tumbled nearly three rounds past his ADP before this team scooped him up at QB28. That is disciplined work. The problem is that discipline at the margins cannot rescue a roster whose ceiling is defined by Sam Darnold starting as a projected QB21. Jonathan Taylor and James Cook give this team a genuinely strong backfield foundation, and Tetairoa McMillan and Terry McLaurin are serviceable contributors, but the projected starters collectively land PurpleReign at eighth in the Elden Ring division and the 33rd percentile of the field. You can do almost everything right in a draft and still watch the math refuse to cooperate, and that is exactly what happened here. PurpleReign found value wherever value existed. It just was not enough value.

chrispalmer33 drafted a textbook patient draft, 17 chalk picks, one minor reach, zero major reaches, and still landed in the 39th percentile. That is the cruelest verdict a draft can return. The pieces look credible in isolation: Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and Caleb Williams at QB6 anchor a lineup that projects as genuinely strong at the top. But the roster flattens out fast. The running back group peaks at Josh Jacobs at RB16 and Travis Etienne at RB18, two backs whose ceilings feel more like floors than accelerants, and the tight end situation offers T.J. Hockenson at TE23, which is a drain on any week it gets forced into a starting spot. Meanwhile, Jalen Hurts arrives without AJ Brown for the first time in years, and if Philadelphia's passing game stumbles, the rushing touchdowns that inflated Hurts' five straight top-10 finishes become a lot harder to count on. ChrisPalmer33 did almost nothing wrong at the podium. The result is a team that finishes 7th in the Elden Ring division anyway.

Awill1 didn't win the draft room with one splashy pick. They won it by being right, consistently. Josh Allen at QB1 anchors the whole operation, and the Allen to D.J. Moore stack gives this team a built-in bonus that compounds every time Buffalo's offense clicks. Around that core sits a receiver group that quietly did the damage: Chris Olave at WR11, Ladd McConkey at WR20, Jameson Williams at WR21, and Moore at WR26, all projected starters, all drafted at or near consensus value. Seventeen chalk picks sounds boring until you remember that chalk means the market agreed and Awill1 still walked away with it. The 2025 campaign was a rough one, a 36 percent win rate that left plenty of room for growth, and this roster looks like the answer. Mason Taylor at TE35 is the one spot where the projections thin out, but in a positionless format the rest of this lineup has enough upside to absorb it. Sitting 62nd percentile entering the season, Awill1 has the pieces to climb.

Scoto did not force anything in this draft, and the roster reflects it. The foundation starts at the top, where Lamar Jackson at QB3 and Trey McBride at TE2 give the team two projected top-tier players at their positions, both earning starter asterisks without a hint of overpaying. Jayden Daniels, projected QB5, fell nearly a full round past his ADP and lands here as genuine upside behind Jackson. The RB group reads like a manager who kept finding reasonable prices on reasonable players: Jeremiyah Love at RB13, Kyren Williams at RB15, and Javonte Williams at RB17 project as starters, with Kyle Monangai arriving as the clearest draft-day value after sliding 1.6 rounds. Travis Kelce at TE10 adds a second projected starting option at tight end. The 64th percentile ranking and fifth-place division projection suggest a team sitting just inside the good side of average, but the draft itself, 18 chalk picks and two genuine values with zero reaches, reads like a manager who understood what they were building and never got in their own way.

ikethepug didn't try to be clever. The draft reads like someone who showed up with a plan and executed it, picking chalk on chalk until the board handed them something worth celebrating. Fourteen chalk picks sounds boring until you look at what that chalk got them: Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1, De'Von Achane at RB6, and Tyler Warren at TE4 anchoring a starting group that would make most managers in the Elden Ring division quietly jealous. Then Davante Adams slid a full round past his ADP and ikethepug was right there to pick him up at WR25, turning a disciplined draft into a quietly profitable one. The one blemish worth noting is J.J. McCarthy, reached for 6.4 rounds early at QB37, which is a steep price for a quarterback who projects as a fringe starter. But the foundation is strong enough to absorb that kind of luxury bet. This team finished at the 93rd percentile in scoring in 2025 and enters 2026 sitting 71st percentile in the field. The floor is high, and the upside is real.

tperez34 didn't win the draft with one flashy pick. They won it by making better decisions than almost everyone else, round after round, and the roster reflects that quiet discipline. Jaxon Smith-Njigba projects as WR3 and anchors the whole operation, and the tight end group is genuinely elite, with Colston Loveland at TE3 and Tucker Kraft at TE5 both projected starters alongside Jake Ferguson at TE12 and Mark Andrews at TE14. That is not luck, that is a manager who identified value at a position and took it before the field caught on. The Dak Prescott and Ferguson stack adds another layer, connecting two of those assets into a ceiling-raising combination. Patrick Mahomes arrives as a bonus: ahead of schedule in his ACL recovery and potentially back under center in Week 1, his presence as QB12 gives tperez34 genuine upside most teams simply cannot match. Landing at 80th percentile in the tournament and second in the Elden Ring division, this roster did not stumble into its spot. It earned it, pick by methodical pick.

Fuzzyy lands at third in the division and the 80th percentile of the field, and the draft sheet tells you exactly why: this roster was built pick by pick, not rescued by one late miracle. The foundation is genuinely elite. Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 and Drake Maye at QB2 give this team a pair of top-shelf starters, and Maye came at a discount, sliding to 3.04 against an ADP of 2.02. That kind of quiet efficiency compounds. Nico Collins at WR9, Kyle Pitts at TE7, and Dalton Kincaid at TE11 fill out a starting group with almost no weak links. Even the one legitimate question mark, Rhamondre Stevenson at RB31, is a projected starter on a team this loaded, which says more about the overall floor than it does about any individual concern. The 2025 squad went 32-4 and scored at the 100th percentile, so the process has receipts. Fuzzyy did not try to outsmart the draft. They just kept winning individual picks, and the standings tend to notice that kind of thing eventually.

michaelklos23 sits atop the Elden Ring division and checks in at the 92nd percentile of the field, and the draft sheet tells you exactly why: this was an exercise in discipline, not desperation. The two clearest examples are Joe Burrow and Sam LaPorta. Burrow, projected QB4, slid nearly a full round past his ADP and landed at 3.02, a quiet windfall for a manager willing to let the board come to him. LaPorta, projected TE8, fell a full round beyond his expected spot and was sitting right there at 7.02. Those two picks alone represent the kind of accumulated edge that separates competent drafters from dangerous ones. Layer in the Burrow and Tee Higgins stack, with Higgins projecting as a WR19 starter, and the team has a connected scoring engine baked into the core. Puka Nacua at WR1 anchors everything from the top. There were no headline-grabbing steals here, no lottery tickets cashed. Just a manager who kept showing up to the right spot at the right time, seventeen times over.
