C.J. Stroud, it's hard to envision Bingy3 clawing their way out of the division cellar or making any meaningful impact in the broader competition.

Even the stack advantage of pairing A.J. Brown with Jalen Hurts offers

little solace in the face of these challenges. Overall, Duffers81 seems poised for a season marked more by missed opportunities than victories, needing a dramatic turnaround to change their fate.


