dynastygurunfl reached early and reached often, and the draft sheet reads like a cautionary tale somebody should have laminated before round two. Five major reaches across the board, zero steals, and the centerpiece of it all is a backfield anchored by Kenneth Walker III, Kyren Williams, and Quinshon Judkins, each taken well before the market agreed they were worth it. Walker alone cost a full round of premium capital before his ADP, and Williams and Judkins followed the same script, meaning dynastygurunfl spent down like a sailor on shore leave and still landed a receiver room headlined by Marvin Harrison Jr. at WR33 and a projected starter in KC Concepcion at WR50. That is the punchline. The best player on the receiving side of this roster is projected outside the top 30 at his position, and the only meaningful value on the entire sheet is Michael Wilson falling one round past his ADP. One minor discount on a WR39 does not offset a draft strategy that treated ADP as a dare. The division already has dynastygurunfl slotted last, and that projection is being generous.

There is no gentle way to say this: Dbaker91 is sitting at 10th percentile in the tournament and 11th in the FIFA Football division, and the draft log explains exactly how they got there. The biggest culprits are the quarterback picks, where Joe Burrow was taken at 1.09 despite an ADP of 2.05, and Patrick Mahomes was grabbed at 3.09 when he was going closer to round five. Paying early-round prices for a QB4 and a QB12 in a positionless format is the kind of move that hollows out the middle of a roster before the season even starts, and the downstream damage shows. RJ Harvey, projected as a RB28, was reached for nearly three rounds early at 7.09 and projects as the weakest starter on the team. CeeDee Lamb was a genuine value at WR5, and Chase Brown at RB11 is a legitimate piece, but two bright spots cannot paper over a roster that grades out near the bottom of the field with no obvious correction in sight. Dbaker91 needed this draft to go right, and it did not.

There is no charitable read available for Messi Mahomies, a team sitting at the bottom of the FIFA Football division and in the 10th percentile of the entire field. The draft tells you everything you need to know: zero steals, zero values, and three major reaches that would make a seasoned drafter wince. Tony Pollard, projected RB30, was taken three full rounds before his ADP. Demond Claiborne, projected RB63, was yanked nearly five rounds early. Christian Kirk, projected WR100, was grabbed five rounds ahead of schedule, which is a remarkable level of enthusiasm for a WR100. The team does have genuine talent at the top, Justin Jefferson at WR6 and Jonathan Taylor at RB4 anchor a roster that looked promising on paper before the reaches started compounding, and Caleb Williams at QB6 gives the lineup a real ceiling. But a 2025 campaign that produced a 47 percent win rate is the baseline here, and a draft built almost entirely on chalk and wishful early pulls suggests the manager has learned nothing from it.

Manifest Destiny enters the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl sitting ninth in the FIFA Football division and projected at just the 36th percentile of the field, and the draft record offers little reason for optimism. The manager landed four major reaches across the board, most damaging among them Fernando Mendoza at QB27, scooped up nearly five rounds ahead of his ADP, and Michael Mayer at TE39, taken more than six rounds early. Those are not calculated gambles on upside, they are points squandered on players who grade out as fringe contributors at best. The one genuine bright spot is a loaded group headlined by Colston Loveland at TE3, Tyler Warren at TE4, and Kyle Pitts at TE7, all projected starters, which is legitimately elite depth at the position. But that strength cannot carry a roster where the best available quarterback is a QB27, and the wide receiver group leans heavily on Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and Zay Flowers at WR16 before dropping off sharply. There is no obvious lever left to pull here, and the standings projection already knows it.

Cape Verde drafted like a patient accountant, waiting for value to fall rather than chasing names, and the ledger still does not balance. Courtland Sutton slid nearly two rounds past his ADP, Pat Freiermuth dropped almost three, and the manager quietly pocketed both without overpaying. The receiver group is genuinely strong, anchored by Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and Rashee Rice at WR13, and the tight end depth behind Tucker Kraft is real. But this roster projects 38th percentile in the tournament, and that number is hard to argue with. The discipline on draft night only exposes the core problem: the best player here is WR3, not the kind of foundational piece that drives a championship run. Dak Prescott was the one moment of impatience, grabbed a round early, and he still only grades as QB7. Cape Verde played the process correctly and arrived at a middling outcome anyway, which is somehow worse than simply making obvious mistakes, because there is no easy diagnosis and no obvious fix.

Horse With No Name is a team that will win or lose on inches, and the draft map tells you exactly where those inches are being gambled. Puka Nacua at WR1 is the kind of projected anchor that makes a roster functional before the season even starts, and pulling him four spots past his ADP at 1.05 is the sort of quiet efficiency that compounds over a long tournament. The problem is that the back end of this roster was built with a different philosophy entirely, one that mortgaged late-round precision for running back upside that the market did not share. Mike Washington Jr. was taken 4.1 rounds ahead of his ADP, Trey Benson came off the board 2.8 rounds early, and Jonah Coleman followed at nearly 3 rounds early, three consecutive bets on dart-throw backs that the field collectively shrugged at. Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 keep the ceiling honest, but at the 44th percentile, this team is not built to coast. The margins decide everything, and right now the margins are split straight down the middle.

careatl didn't win the draft with one thunderbolt pick. They won it by being right, over and over. The foundation is genuinely elite: Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Saquon Barkley at RB8 give this roster a ceiling that most managers in the field can't match, and Nico Collins (WR9), Garrett Wilson (WR17), and Tee Higgins (WR19) round out a starting group with real firepower. The draft itself was almost entirely chalk, which sounds boring until you realize chalk means careatl simply identified value and took it, no panic, no lottery tickets. The one question mark worth acknowledging is at quarterback, where Sam Darnold (QB21) and Daniel Jones (QB25) are the options. Jones is the more interesting story: he looked like a legitimate fantasy asset through 13 weeks of 2025 before a ruptured Achilles ended his season, and if he comes back healthy for the Colts, that projection could look conservative. This team finished 48th percentile in scoring last year and sits sixth in the division. The talent is here to do better.

No Skattebo No Party did not win the draft on one flashy pick. They won it by repeatedly getting players a tick later than they should have been available, and the cumulative effect is a roster that sits at the 71st percentile without a single moment that required a standing ovation. The foundation is Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1, a projected starter who anchors everything, but what quietly separates this team is how the supporting cast materialized at a discount. Dallas Goedert landed at TE15 nearly two rounds after his ADP suggested he would be gone, and Josh Downs came in as a steal at WR46 despite an ADP that had him going more than two and a half rounds earlier. Fifteen chalk picks sounds like passivity, but when the chalk includes Cam Skattebo and A.J. Brown as projected starters, chalk is just another word for not making mistakes. This roster did not arrive here by accident, and fifth in the FIFA Football division feels more like a floor than a ceiling.

Victorious Secret didn't win the draft on one big swing. They won it on volume, picking up value almost every time it was available and rarely overpaying. Jalen Hurts fell nearly two full rounds past his ADP, and Christian McCaffrey slid half a round before this team pounced at RB3. Those aren't flukes, that's a manager who came in with a plan and executed it. The top of this roster is genuinely hard to attack: Trey McBride at TE2 is a weekly difference-maker, Hurts gives you elite dual-threat production at QB9, and McCaffrey at RB3 anchors the entire operation. There's even an interesting subplot in the TE room, where T.J. Hockenson, now 29 and looking to recapture something close to his 2023 form, could benefit directly from Kyler Murray's arrival in Minnesota. If Murray wins that starting job, Hockenson beats his TE23 projection and this team gets even deeper than advertised. A 74th-percentile finish doesn't happen by accident, and nothing about this roster looks accidental.

marioloizides lands third in the FIFA Football division and sits in the top 10 percent of the field, and the draft log tells you exactly why: no dramatic swings, just a steady accumulation of players who kept falling past their ADP. James Cook, a projected RB5, slid nearly a full round before this team snapped him up. Brock Purdy, projected QB13, drifted more than a round past his number and landed here too, bringing a ready-made stack with projected starter Mike Evans. Jadarian Price at RB26 and Quentin Johnston at WR41 each fell over a round past their ADP and added late-round upside at a discount. The one reach that matters, Josh Allen first overall, is defensible when you believe in your QB1, and Allen's projection backs it up. Fourteen chalk picks and four values with zero major reaches is not a flashy draft story, it is a disciplined one. This roster did not get built on one lucky swing. It got built pick by pick, and that tends to hold up.

Rayan FC didn't need a lottery ticket to land in the 89th percentile of the field. They just kept winning exchanges. Chris Olave fell nearly a full round past his ADP to land at WR11, Harold Fannin slipped 1.2 rounds to give them a TE6 starter, and Isaiah Likely dropped 1.7 rounds into their lap as a TE13 with genuine upside. None of those are splashy moments on a draft board, but they compound. Pair that with Brock Bowers at TE1 and Omarion Hampton at RB9, and the foundation here is genuinely difficult to argue with. The QB situation is thin, Baker Mayfield projecting as QB18 and Tyler Shough as QB20, but in a positionless format the question is whether the rest of the roster covers for it, and Drake London at WR7 and Breece Hall at RB14 suggest it can. This is not a team built around one bold swing. It is a team built around being right, over and over, and that tends to hold up.

It's Coming Mahomes sits at the top of the FIFA Football division and in the 98th percentile of the entire field, and the draft sheet explains exactly why. The foundation is elite: Lamar Jackson at QB3 and Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 are the kind of cornerstones that make the rest of a roster's job easy, and the manager landed both of them past their ADPs. From there, the discipline never wavered. Seven values and just one minor reach across the whole board is the draft equivalent of a tax return with no errors, every line filled in correctly and not a dollar wasted. De'Von Achane slipped to RB6 value at pick 3.04. DeVonta Smith and Ladd McConkey anchor a deep receiver group as projected starters at WR14 and WR20 respectively. Even the late rounds held up, with Geno Smith emerging as the clearest steal on the sheet, falling more than three full rounds past his ADP. The weakest projected starter is Jayden Reed at WR48, which on most rosters would be a genuine concern and here reads more like a footnote.
