The 2025 season for Jeff Thompson (@Fbcpastorjeff) is shaping up to be a challenging one, with early signs pointing to another struggle in the FaberCollegeMongols division. Currently ranked 11th, the team faces an uphill battle, especially considering its overall position in the bottom 2 percentile of the massive tournament. The quarterback situation is particularly concerning, with Trevor Lawrence underperforming at QB19 and Matthew Stafford even further behind at QB25, both of whom were drafted earlier than their ADP suggested. Luther Burden, unfortunately, epitomizes the team's struggles, occupying a starting spot with a dismal WR57 ranking. While Evan Engram brought some drafting value, the team's decision to reach for

numerous other players like Joe Flacco and Kirk Cousins has proven costly, leaving them ill-equipped to compete effectively. Their chances of climbing out of the division's basement seem bleak, as a lack of depth and questionable draft choices continue to haunt their season outlook.

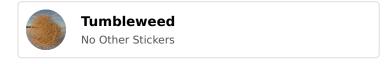

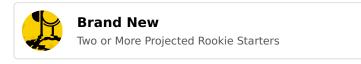
