The backfield depth is not much better, especially given the questionable draft choices like Nick Chubb and Tank Bigsby, who were taken earlier than most expected. TripsP's season is likely to be a struggle, marked by a series of strategic missteps and underwhelming performances that could lead to yet another year of disappointment.
