There is no generous interpretation available for AngelaMichaels, a team that enters 2026 ranked last in the Fortnite division and in the 1st percentile of the field after a 2025 season that produced wins at a 31 percent clip. The draft log reads like a case study in self-inflicted damage: three major reaches in five rounds, zero steals, and a draft board that kept getting jumped by a manager who apparently could not wait. Baker Mayfield alone cost nearly four rounds of draft capital when his ADP sat at round seven, and what AngelaMichaels bought is a QB18 projection on a quarterback whose supporting cast just lost Mike Evans in free agency and whose 2025 showed real regression from his 2024 peak. Then in round five, RJ Harvey was hauled in more than four rounds ahead of consensus, which is a staggering price for a RB28. Drake Maye projects as a genuine asset at QB2, but one legitimately strong piece cannot paper over a draft that spent its currency wrong at nearly every turn.

There is a version of this roster that looks fine on the surface, and then you look closer and the floor starts to creak. Jonesy sits 11th in the Fortnite division and in just the 12th percentile of the field, and the construction of this team helps explain why. The WR group has genuine upside anchored by CeeDee Lamb (WR5), Drake London (WR7), and DeVonta Smith (WR14), but those bright spots make the gaps elsewhere harder to ignore. The backfield projects as a drag, with TreVeyon Henderson (RB19) and Bhayshul Tuten (RB25) leading a group that grades out middling at best. The draft did not create much room to maneuver either, with 14 chalk selections and only one real value found on the board. Worse, the Bryce Young (QB26) selection came 3.2 rounds before consensus, a costly bet on a quarterback projecting well outside the top 20. When your most expensive mistake is a QB26 and your projected sixth starter is Matthew Golden (WR52), there are not many levers left to pull.

There is something almost melancholy about watching a 95th-percentile team dissolve into a 24th-percentile projection, and ArmstrongMcCall is living that dissolution in real time. The engine of last year's 31-5 juggernaut is gone in feel if not entirely in name, replaced by a roster that projects 10th in the Fortnite division and looks like it was assembled by someone who remembered the 2025 version of this team but could not quite recreate it. Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 is genuinely elite, and George Pickens at WR10 gives this team a receiver corps that most managers would envy, but the quarterback situation is where the reputation gap becomes painful: Jared Goff was drafted nearly two full rounds ahead of his QB16 projection, and the safer-feeling alternative, C.J. Stroud, projects as the weakest starter on the entire roster at QB22. Dalton Kincaid is the wild card, a TE11 talent paired with Josh Allen if his knee cooperates, but Bills GM Brandon Beane could not even promise that much. The 2025 version of this team earned its glory. This one is borrowing its name.

Renegade Raiders did almost everything right on draft day, and that is precisely what makes the result so maddening. The team logged three legitimate values and zero reaches across the entire board, a nearly flawless execution of the wait-and-pounce approach. Yet here they sit at ninth in the Fortnite division and 43rd percentile overall, which is what happens when disciplined process runs headlong into mediocre outcomes. The top of the roster is genuinely exciting: Justin Jefferson at WR6, Christian McCaffrey at RB3, and Patrick Mahomes, who is reportedly ahead of schedule recovering from the torn ACL and LCL that cost him most of 2025, projecting as QB12 if he suits up Week 1. That is a core worth building around. The problem is the fall-off is steep and arrives quickly. Blake Corum lands at RB35, Tucker Kraft gives you TE5 value but only because the position is shallow, and Dalton Schultz projects as the weakest projected starter at TE22. Getting the process right but not the players is the cruelest kind of draft-room loss.

@FortNate ZB ran a disciplined draft, landing 14 chalk picks and three genuine values, including Jake Ferguson at TE12 a full round after his ADP and Jauan Jennings falling nearly two rounds into round 16. The process was sound. The product is a team sitting eighth in the Fortnite division and at just the 45th percentile of the field, which is the quiet cruelty of fantasy drafting: do everything right and still end up ordinary. Lamar Jackson is a real asset at QB3, and the Lamar Jackson and Zay Flowers stack gives the roster a credible upside ceiling. But Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and Kenneth Walker III at RB10 are the only genuinely elite projected starters, and the rest of the lineup grades out as functional rather than threatening, with Jayden Reed at WR48 penciled in as the weakest projected starter. After a 33 percent win rate in 2025, this team needed a draft that moved the needle. Disciplined and forgettable is still forgettable.

General Grievous sits at 53rd percentile and seventh in the Fortnite Division, which tells you everything: this is a team built to beat the teams it should beat and lose to the ones it shouldn't. The receiving corps is the engine worth watching, headlined by Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3, with Chris Olave, Garrett Wilson, and Mike Evans all projecting as starters. That is a legitimately dangerous top end. The concern is the floor. Jakobi Meyers projects as the weakest starter at WR45, and in a format decided by margins, that bottom slot is where points bleed out quietly week after week. The drafting was mostly chalk, which is fine, but two major reaches loom: Caleb Williams cost nearly a full round of early capital at QB6, and J.J. McCarthy was pulled four rounds ahead of his WR37 projection. Those bets need to hit. A 61 percent win rate and 76th-percentile scoring in 2025 suggest the talent is real. Whether this roster can squeeze efficiency out of every slot is the question the whole season rides on.

Last year, Zero Points Sprite finished in the 2nd percentile in scoring, a 4-32 record that reads less like a fantasy season and more like a public apology. The 2026 version of this roster looks nothing like that. The receiving corps alone could carry a contender, with A.J. Brown (WR8) and Nico Collins (WR9) projected as two of the best at their position, supported by legitimate contributors in Jameson Williams (WR21), Jaylen Waddle (WR23), and Carnell Tate (WR29). Then there is Brock Bowers (TE1), the top projected tight end in the tournament, drafted first overall, half a round ahead of his ADP, meaning the manager knew exactly what they were doing. Brian Thomas Jr. (WR31) adds further depth after falling nearly a round and a half past his ADP, a quiet value that rounds out a lineup with serious upside. Sitting at the 72nd percentile and 6th in the Fortnite division, Zero Points Sprite is not sneaking up on anyone, but after 2025, they have earned the right to arrive loudly.

There was no heist here, no moment where porterporter fleeced the room on a single pick, just a draft that kept finding the right player at the right time. Josh Allen at QB1 slipping one spot past his ADP in the first round set the tone, and the rest of the board cooperated. Ladd McConkey fell a full round, Tyjae Spears fell two-and-a-half, and Zach Charbonnet fell nearly two, each one a quiet confirmation that this manager was paying attention. The result is a starting group that holds up at the top, with Allen paired to McConkey in a Herbert stack that gives the offense genuine upside, and a collection of tight ends headlined by Harold Fannin, Travis Kelce, and Mark Andrews that is simply hard to match. AJ Barner rounds out that group as a developmental piece whose path to a larger role depends on Seattle evolving away from their run-heavy scheme. At 78th percentile in the field and fifth in the Fortnite division, porterporter did not luck into this position. The work was in the margins, and the margins added up.

The Dark Voyager lands at 78th percentile in the field, and when you trace back why, it reads less like a moment of genius and more like a draft that just kept making sensible decisions. The RB group is the backbone: Bijan Robinson at RB2, De'Von Achane at RB6, Chase Brown at RB11, and Jeremiyah Love at RB13 give this roster a level of depth that compounds with each round. Then there are the quiet wins scattered through the middle and late rounds. Bucky Irving fell a full round and a half past his ADP before The Dark Voyager grabbed him at RB21, and Rhamondre Stevenson slipped even further before landing here as RB31. Jaxson Dart at QB11 was similarly available past his expected price, and while his playing style comes with real injury risk, the upside is priced in at that value. The receiver group carries more uncertainty, with Michael Pittman projecting as the weakest projected starter at WR44, but in a positionless format, the sheer quality at the top of this roster gives the manager plenty of ways to make up for it.

Last year was a long season for tigercoolidge, a 9-27 record and a 17th-percentile scoring finish that left plenty of room for soul-searching. The 2026 roster looks like the answer. The foundation is genuinely elite: Joe Burrow at QB4 and Trey McBride at TE2 are the kind of cornerstones managers spend entire drafts hunting, and Tyler Warren at TE4 running alongside McBride means the tight end position alone could carry weeks. Breece Hall at RB14 and Quinshon Judkins at RB22 keep the production coming in the backfield, and Dak Prescott at QB7 was a legitimate value, slipping nearly a full round past his ADP. The receiver group is the one place where optimism requires a little faith, with KC Concepcion projecting as the WR50 and the weakest projected starter on the roster, but when your floor looks like this, you can afford one soft spot. The team sits third in the Fortnite division and at the 82nd percentile of the field. After 2025, tigercoolidge has earned some good news, and this roster delivers it.

The Bush Campers didn't manufacture their spot in the 84th percentile with one flashy gamble. They earned it the hard way, pick by pick, consistently coming out ahead. The anchor is Puka Nacua, the WR1 in this format, paired with Matthew Stafford in a stack that gives the lineup a high floor and a legitimate ceiling every single week. Around that core, the manager added Malik Nabers at WR12, landing him a full round past his ADP, and paired Saquon Barkley at RB8 with Josh Jacobs at RB16 to build a backfield that can carry a bad passing week without breaking a sweat. What stands out in the draft sheet isn't a single dramatic reach or a heist at a premium spot, it's the patient accumulation of value: three picks that fell past ADP, fourteen chalk selections that hit their number, and a major reach on Dontayvion Wicks late enough in the draft that the downside is essentially negligible. This roster doesn't have a signature moment. It just keeps showing up.

Elite Agent didn't win the Fortnite Division with one memorable swing. They won it by consistently being on the right side of draft decisions, and sitting at 95th percentile in the field is the receipt. The four-value haul tells the story: Jalen Hurts at QB9 slid nearly a round and a half past his ADP, Kyle Pitts at TE7 came a round cheaper than the market wanted, and both players landed as projected starters. Pitts is particularly worth lingering on, because after years of fantasy circles treating his potential as a punchline, he finished as a top-five TE in 2025 and arrives in 2026 with a new quarterback situation in Atlanta that, frankly, doesn't seem to matter much as long as he keeps playing at that level. Pair him with Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 and you have a ceiling that most managers in this field would envy. The two late-round reaches on Jaylin Noel and Rashod Bateman leave minor question marks, but Elite Agent built so much equity in the middle rounds that there is real margin to absorb them.
