There is a version of this SPEEDZ roster that looks functional on paper, and then you actually look at it. Brock Bowers is a genuine asset at TE1, and A.J. Brown at WR8 gives the lineup a real anchor, but the draft surrounding those two pieces tells a discouraging story. SPEEDZ burned early capital reaching for Terry McLaurin a round and a half ahead of his market price, then doubled down by taking Stefon Diggs more than two rounds early, and Christian Kirk nearly five rounds before consensus had him going. Three major reaches in a single draft is not bad luck, it is a philosophy, and that philosophy has left this team sitting at the bottom of the Forza division and in just the 15th percentile of the field. A 47th-percentile scoring season in 2025 offered no real foundation to build on, and with Matthew Golden projecting as the weakest starter at WR52, the ceiling here is low. Bowers and Brown are doing their part. The draft did not do its.

There is not much reason for optimism in the Forza division if you are 00Topher00. Sitting 11th in the division and in just the 16th percentile of the field, this roster grades out as one of the tournament's harder sells, and the draft did not generate the kind of surplus value that might paper over thin projections. Three major reaches headlined the board, including Jayden Daniels at 1.12 when his ADP sat a full round later at 2.12, and Jake Ferguson taken 2.4 rounds before the market expected him. Paying early for QB5 and TE12 is the kind of math that leaves you short everywhere else, and everywhere else is exactly where the damage shows. The projected starters at running back are Rhamondre Stevenson at RB31 and RJ Harvey at RB28, which is a ceiling, not a floor. Trey McBride at TE2 is a genuine asset, and the wide receiver group carries some real names in Chris Olave and Garrett Wilson, but those bright spots feel more like decoration on a roster that is running out of levers to pull.

Last year, LaQuan Jones finished in the 92nd percentile and went 27-9. This year, the projection has him sitting at the 22nd percentile and dead last in the Forza division, and the distance between those two numbers is genuinely hard to look at. The roster tells you why. Josh Allen anchors everything as the QB1, and the tight end group is legitimately elite, with Colston Loveland, Tyler Warren, Tucker Kraft, and Sam LaPorta all projected as starters and ranked TE3, TE4, TE5, and TE8 respectively. But in a positionless format where you start your best players regardless of position label, the quality of your non-elite contributors matters enormously, and beyond that tight end group Jones is leaning on Michael Pittman at WR44, Jakobi Meyers at WR45, and Romeo Doubs, the weakest projected starter, at WR53. The draft did him no favors either, with Chigoziem Okonkwo and T.J. Hockenson taken 3.9 and 3.2 rounds before their ADPs, premium capital spent to double down on the one position that was already covered. Jones built a cathedral with no doors.

The Forza division table does not lie, and __MATTO__ sitting ninth in the division while projecting out at just the 37th percentile of the field is the kind of double confirmation that should make any manager uneasy. The top of the roster has real names, Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Justin Herbert stacking nicely with Ladd McConkey at WR20, but the draft process hints at how this team got into trouble: David Njoku, a TE29, was pulled nearly six full rounds ahead of his ADP, and Jalen Hurts was grabbed more than a round early at a position where the lineup carries zero required starters. Those reaches cost capital that could have shored up the back end, which now leans on the likes of Juwan Johnson, the team's own weakest projected starter, and a cluster of wide receivers grading out in the WR60s. Robinson and Herbert can carry a week, but in a positionless format where depth wins the coin-flip weeks, __MATTO__ has too many soft spots and too few late-round steals left to paper over them.

Hkhotsskhotb managed the draft about as correctly as you can manage it, landing Jordan Addison more than two rounds after his ADP and picking up Omarion Hampton and Jayden Reed at genuine discounts. Fourteen chalk picks and just one major reach across the entire board is a disciplined draft by any measure. The reach, unfortunately, was Kaelon Black, taken more than eight rounds before his ADP and projecting as RB71, which is a late-roster body at best. That one decision matters because this format is unforgiving of dead weight, and the rest of the roster, for all its discipline, never quite delivered the upside that justifies the value-hunting approach. Lamar Jackson and CeeDee Lamb anchor real production, but the projected starters below them taper off fast, with Addison sitting as the weakest projected starter at WR43. Getting the process right and still landing at 48th percentile is the quiet cruelty of fantasy drafts: you followed the map correctly and the treasure just was not there.

PiBK enters 2026 as the tournament's most honest mirror, sitting at the 52nd percentile and seventh in the Forza Division, a team that earns exactly the record it deserves and not a point more. The floor is real: Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and James Cook at RB5 give this roster a backfield core that most managers would trade their lunch money to own, and Courtland Sutton sliding to WR37 after falling more than two full rounds past his ADP is the kind of quiet bargain that wins seasons in March. But the ceiling has a leak. Jaxson Dart is the starting quarterback, a QB11 projection built on the promise of what he could become rather than the consistency of what he has been, a player whose highlight reel and his injury log grew at roughly the same rate last year. The draft also carries three major reaches, including George Kittle pulled nearly two and a half rounds early. None of those decisions are fatal, but in a season where the margins decide everything, none of them are free, either.

BigRich20 finished last season at the 76th percentile, and the draft chart suggests they spent this offseason ignoring every lesson about patience. Two major reaches, three minor ones, zero steals. And yet the roster that came out the other side is genuinely good, sitting at the 55th percentile in a field where most managers would kill for that kind of floor. The reaches tell the real story. Hunter Henry at TE18 cost BigRich20 nearly three rounds of draft capital before his market price, and Kayshon Boutte at WR76 went more than three rounds early for a player who may not crack the starting lineup at all. Those are bold calls, not accidents. The ballast underneath them is real: Kenneth Walker III at RB10 and Chase Brown at RB11 give this team a punishing foundation, and Justin Jefferson at WR6 is exactly the kind of anchor you build around. The question hanging over the whole operation is

whether BigRich20 knew something the board did not, or just got away with it. Either way, the roster is good. The conviction versus luck debate can wait until October.

LauraluvTed didn't build this roster with one splashy move. They built it by being right, consistently, when the board gave them an opening. Five values against only one major reach tells the story: Ashton Jeanty at RB7 slipped to pick 3.08 when his ADP suggested he'd be long gone, and Kyren Williams fell nearly two full rounds before LauraluvTed scooped him at RB15. Those aren't flukes, that's a manager who came in with a plan and executed it. At the top, Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 and Jeanty anchor a lineup with genuine upside, and the Caleb Williams to Rome Odunze stack adds a ceiling that flat rosters rarely carry. The one wrinkle worth watching is David Montgomery, who left Detroit after his role shrank and now heads to Houston to compete for carries against Woody Marks. If Montgomery reclaims a featured role, he's a bonus. If not, the floor here is still comfortable. Sitting 58th percentile in the Forza division, LauraluvTed isn't a favorite, but they drafted better than their rank suggests.

Viperman84 sits 61st percentile in the field and fourth in the Forza division, which sounds like a middling outcome until you look at what it cost to get there. The centerpiece of this roster is a receiver corps that would make most managers weak in the knees: Ja'Marr Chase at WR2, Nico Collins at WR9, Malik Nabers at WR12, and Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 all projecting as starters, with Tee Higgins at WR19 right behind them. That group did not come cheap, and the draft board shows it. Dalton Schultz was taken 2.5 rounds before his ADP, AJ Barner another 2.0 rounds early, the two of them burning draft capital that might have bought more at other positions. It looks reckless on paper. But Viperman84 apparently decided elite receiver talent was worth the inefficiency, and the projections back that conviction up. Whether those reaches at tight end quietly cost the season or the top of this roster simply overpowers the math is the question the Forza division is going to answer for them.

Meanswell11 looked like a manager playing chicken with the rest of the draft board, and somehow they blinked last every time. The reach count is ugly on paper, four major reaches against just one steal, but the roster that came out the other side lands at 68th percentile in the field, third in the Forza division, with Christian McCaffrey sitting at RB3 after falling nearly a full round past his ADP. That is the steal that makes the whole thing work. Pair McCaffrey with Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and George Pickens at WR10, stack Baker Mayfield with Emeka Egbuka at WR18, and suddenly the conviction reads less like stubbornness and more like a plan. The reaches on Jacoby Brissett and Kirk Cousins, taken 2.1 and 3.2 rounds early respectively, are the one place where the faith feels thinly rewarded. But in a positionless format, you do not need your quarterback to carry you when your skill players look like that.

After finishing 2025 in the bottom 11 percent of scoring, kaylechips has rebuilt into something genuinely worth admiring, and the centerpiece of that turnaround is a receiving corps headlined by Puka Nacua at WR1. Nacua alone would be a foundation worth bragging about, and he is surrounded by Drake London (WR7) and Zay Flowers (WR16), giving this roster a projected starting group that most managers in the field would envy. The draft work behind those names is equally impressive: Cam Skattebo landed at RB20 after falling more than two rounds past his ADP, and Makai Lemon came two full rounds late as well, both steals that quietly elevate a roster that already had legitimate star power at the top. Saquon Barkley (RB8) carries some real uncertainty after a down 2025 season, and with whispers of a reduced workload in Philadelphia, he is more of a boom-or-bust piece than his RB8 projection suggests. But this team sits second in the Forza division and at the 80th percentile of the field, which tells you everything about how far kaylechips has come.

Paeno sits first in the Forza division and in the 86th percentile of the field, and the draft record explains most of why: four steals, three values, and zero major reaches across the board. The steals alone tell the story. Joe Burrow, projected QB4, slid nearly a full round and a half past his ADP and landed here. Bucky Irving at RB21 and Quinshon Judkins at RB22 both fell over two and a half rounds before Paeno scooped them up. Jadarian Price, the projected weakest starter at RB26, was taken a full two rounds after his ADP. That is a manager who sat on their hands and let value come to them rather than chasing names up the board. Harold Fannin rounds out the projected starters at TE6 and also arrived a round late, meaning Paeno found a top-six tight end at a discount too. The 2025 campaign was a rough one, but the 2026 roster looks nothing like that version of this team.
