The team managed to snag some value by drafting Michael Pittman and Hunter Henry later than expected, though the decision to reach for tight ends like Sam LaPorta and Tyler Warren earlier than necessary may prove costly. As they embark on this arduous campaign, the NorsemenMN will need to rely heavily on their quarterbacks and tight ends to navigate the daunting road ahead, hoping to claw their way up in the standings despite the odds stacked against them.


