America's Cog Team sits 12th in the Gears of War division and in just the 6th percentile of the field, and the draft record explains most of why. The team produced zero steals and only two values across the entire board, while absorbing two major reaches that did real damage to the roster's ceiling. The worst offender is Kyle Monangai, a projected RB33 who cost a second-round price at pick 9.12 when his ADP sat at 12.01, making him the projected weakest starter on the team and a monument to draft capital misallocated. Caleb Williams landed at 2.01 despite an ADP of 3.06, and while a Williams/Luther Burden stack adds some ceiling, Williams projects as a QB6, which means the early capital spent on him was buying comfort, not advantage. Joe Burrow as a QB4 gives the room genuine upside at the position, but when your draft is built on chalk and reaches rather than value, you are essentially hoping projections break right rather than engineering an edge. For America's Cog Team, that is a thin plan.

There is a particular kind of exhaustion that comes not from catastrophe but from accumulation, and dzastrow's 2026 outlook has that feel. The roster sits at the 8th percentile of the field and ranks 11th in the Gears of War division, and the draft sheet does not offer much comfort: 13 chalk picks, two major reaches, and zero steals across the whole board. The quarterback room is genuinely strong, with Drake Maye projecting as QB2 and Jayden Daniels as QB5, but in a positionless format, quarterback upside only goes so far when the overall roster grade is this thin. The supporting cast keeps coming up short. Kenneth Gainwell grades out as RB34, Zach Charbonnet as RB42, and James Conner as RB56, none of them starters you'd build around. Chris Olave and Zay Flowers give the team a respectable core, projecting at WR11 and WR16 respectively, but after them the depth falls off sharply toward names like Denzel Boston and Tre Tucker. After a 69-percent win rate in 2025, this is a team that knows what a good season feels like, which may make this one sting a little more.

DHurricane finished last season at 8-28 with a 22% win rate, and the 2026 projections offer almost no reason to expect a different story. The roster grades out in the 16th percentile of the field and sits 10th in the Gears of War division, and the draft did nothing to change the math, producing zero steals and fifteen chalk picks against a backdrop of mostly minor inefficiencies. The best hope for a turnaround runs through DeVonta Smith, who finally steps out of A.J. Brown's shadow in Philadelphia and projects as a WR14, but Smith has spent his entire career being very good without being the guy, and 2026 is the first real test of whether he can carry a fantasy team as a true top option. James Cook at RB5 is legitimately excellent, and the rest of the projected starters are serviceable, but serviceable is not enough when the ceiling of your roster keeps landing around the same neighborhood as last year's floor. DHurricane is not without talent; the talent just does not add up to a contender.

There is no charitable read available for sjcobe01 in 2026. The draft tells the story plainly: zero steals, one value, and eight picks arriving before consensus said they should. The most damaging pattern is the quarterback spending. Justin Herbert, a QB8, was pulled a full round early at 2.09, eating premium capital at a position where patience is almost always rewarded. Then, as if to double down on the lesson, Tua Tagovailoa came off the board at 10.09 despite an ADP sitting four rounds later, a reach so aggressive it borders on self-sabotage. That is two high picks committed to signal-callers who do not even crack the top tier, while Bijan Robinson at RB2 and A.J. Brown at WR8 anchor a core that deserved better supporting casts around it. The lone bright spot is Sam LaPorta falling a full round past his ADP into the 7.04 slot, but one reasonable pick cannot undo a draft built on impatience. The result is a team sitting 9th in the Gears of War division, projecting in the 24th percentile of the field, and offering very little reason for optimism.

RayGQue finished 2025 at 32-4 and in the 94th percentile of scoring, which is the kind of résumé that earns genuine respect in a tournament like the Scott Fish Bowl. The 2026 version of this roster, sitting at 47th percentile and ranked eighth in the Gears of War division, is asking you to remember the old team while watching a noticeably different one. The receiver group has names worth admiring, Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and Justin Jefferson at WR6 headlining a long list of projected starters, but the construction underneath them is shakier than the headlines suggest. Parker Washington, projected WR35, is an interesting piece whose entire value rests on whether Jacksonville actually wants him at the front of their target share, a question with no clean answer. The quarterback situation, Patrick Mahomes as a QB12 on average with Sam Darnold as the fallback, pairs Mahomes with Rashee Rice as a stack but introduces real fragility if Mahomes underperforms his projection. This roster is

not bad. It just is not the 94th-percentile juggernaut that name implies, and that gap is going to be the story all season.

ElMarko is the team that lives and dies in the margins, and that is precisely what makes this season so difficult to call. The backfield headlined by Ashton Jeanty (RB7) and Saquon Barkley (RB8) is legitimate top-tier production, and Trey McBride (TE2) anchors the tight end group as well as any manager in the field can hope for. The trouble is that the upside stops there and the rest of the roster is a series of coin flips. Tee Higgins (WR19) and Terry McLaurin (WR24) are serviceable starters but neither is bending a season, and the projected floor drops off quickly once you get to Michael Pittman (WR44), whose projection as the weakest expected starter tells you everything about how thin the margin for error gets on a bad week. The draft was almost entirely chalk, one value, and nothing that suggests ElMarko found hidden upside late. Seventh in the Gears of War division and 51st percentile overall, this roster is not built to run away from anyone. It is built to survive, and survival in the middle requires everything to break right.

bigballer033 sits at 54th percentile and sixth in the Gears of War division, which is exactly the kind of standing that demands precision rather than prayer. The foundation is genuinely impressive: Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and Jonathan Taylor at RB4 give this roster a top-end that can go toe-to-toe with anyone in the field, and Kenneth Walker III at RB10 means the quality doesn't fall off a cliff after the headliners. The problem is that the receiver group projects weakly, with Mike Evans at WR27 leading a group where the next starter, Jakobi Meyers at WR45, is doing real work just to hold the lineup together. The draft itself was almost aggressively cautious, 17 chalk picks with nothing resembling a calculated gamble, save for Pat Bryant taken nearly four rounds ahead of his ADP. That reach could look either prescient or wasteful depending on how Bryant develops, and for a team hovering right at the median, that kind of swing is exactly where seasons are decided.

FYFJohnLuke didn't build this roster with one splashy move. They built it pick by pick, and the cumulative result lands them at 61st percentile in the field with a starting group that holds up under scrutiny. Puka Nacua at WR1 and Omarion Hampton at RB9 give the team a legitimate top-end foundation, and the Jaxson Dart and Malik Nabers stack adds a layer of upside that could swing weeks in their favor. Nabers is the name to watch: after a torn ACL cost him last season and a summer of uncertainty had his redraft value sliding toward WR21, he showed up to training camp looking like himself, and every highlight that follows will keep pulling that number back up. The draft process reflected the same patience the roster reflects, finding Jadarian Price and Jonathon Brooks past their ADPs to shore up depth without overpaying. The floor here is real, the ceiling depends in part on how quickly Nabers finds his rhythm with Dart, and fifth in the Gears of War division understates what this team is capable of producing.

Delta Squad didn't need a lottery ticket to build a winner in the Gears of War division, just a steady hand and a draft that kept returning value. The foundation is genuinely elite: Jahmyr Gibbs projects as RB1 and De'Von Achane as RB6, giving this team a top-of-market backfield before the receiving corps even enters the conversation. Then the pass catchers arrived in waves, with Nico Collins at WR9 and Jameson Williams at WR21 anchoring a group that extends four projected starters deep through Quentin Johnston and Jordan Addison. The draft itself was almost aggressively boring in the best way, logging 17 chalk picks against zero major reaches, which is less a scouting flex and more a sign that the manager simply refused to panic. The one standout value, Malik Willis falling to the 13th round despite an ADP near the 11th, added late-round upside without costing anything meaningful. The result is a roster sitting in the 64th tournament percentile that looks like it could climb considerably once the games start.

FatherDynasty didn't build this roster with one flashy move. They built it by consistently getting good players at prices the market hadn't caught up to yet. Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 and Drake London at WR7 give this team a receiving foundation that most managers in the field simply don't have, and London himself arrived as a genuine value, slipping past his ADP by enough to qualify as a gift. Then FatherDynasty doubled down on the quarterback position the same way, landing Dak Prescott at QB7 and Jordan Love at QB17, both of whom fell more than a round past their expected draft slots. Love carries real questions, his fantasy output has never quite matched his football reputation, and the Packers' receiving room still lacks an alpha, but as a secondary option behind Prescott, that uncertainty is already priced in. Add George Pickens at WR10 and Ladd McConkey at WR20 rounding out the projected starters, and this is a team sitting third in the Gears of War division with a 91st percentile outlook that looks very much earned rather than lucky.

cjharden79 did not build this roster with one audacious swing. The 2026 Gears of War squad was assembled the way good drafts are actually won: round after round of coming out slightly ahead. CeeDee Lamb fell nearly a full round past his ADP and landed at pick 2.06, which is the kind of quiet fortune that compounds over a season. Colston Loveland slipped nearly a round as well, giving cjharden79 a TE3 projection at a TE11 price. Then Dalton Kincaid arrived in round nine at what amounted to a seventh-round cost, and suddenly the Josh Allen stack had two legitimate weapons attached to it, with Allen himself sitting as the QB1. Four values, eleven chalk picks, and zero major reaches later, this roster sat in the 93rd percentile of the entire field and second in the division. The 2025 campaign was a forgettable 42nd-percentile slog, but the 2026 draft reads like a correction, patient, disciplined, and almost quietly devastating.

There are drafts that look fine and drafts that look inevitable, and mhainy's 2026 roster falls firmly into the second category. The foundation starts with Brock Bowers, the TE1, and Amon-Ra St. Brown, the WR4, both of whom landed below their ADP, which means mhainy got elite production at a discount before the field even knew what was happening. Add Derrick Henry at RB12 and Tyler Warren at TE4 as projected starters, and the lineup's ceiling is genuinely hard to attack. What makes this especially clean is the discipline behind it: zero reaches across the entire draft, and Fernando Mendoza sliding to round 17 as a QB27 steal for depth. Last season's 81 percent win rate and 98th-percentile scoring were not luck, they were process, and this roster suggests the process has not slipped. Division-leading, 94th-percentile builds do not usually look this surgical. mhainy brought the board the patience to wait and the eye to recognize when the board was giving something away.
