The running back lineup provides depth with the likes of Josh Jacobs and Omarion Hampton, though Najee Harris' value remains questionable after a draft reach. As Campey embarks on this season, they'll need to leverage every ounce of their strengths while addressing glaring weaknesses to climb out of their current standing and rekindle the hope of a successful campaign.

Isaiah Likely rounds out this illustrious crew as the starting tight end, ensuring that opponents will be blissfully unconcerned about covering him too tightly. In a triumph of misplaced optimism, they snagged Josh Downs just a tad after his expected

draft position, because who doesn't love a bargain? All in all, These Go To 11 are poised to be the dark horse of the season, assuming the racecourse is paved exclusively with banana peels.
