Last year's performance, finishing well below average, already set a concerning precedent, and with a current division rank of 10 and a tournament standing in the low percentile, hopes for significant improvement appear dim. As the season unfolds, bigpoppathomp will need more than just a few bright spots; they require a drastic turnaround to compete meaningfully in both their division and the overall rankings.
