Stumpalicious50 arrives in the Geralt of Rivia division sitting 12th and in just the 11th percentile of the field, and the roster explains why without much argument. The receiver group is the soft underbelly here, with Carnell Tate (WR29), Rome Odunze (WR30), and Josh Downs (WR46) all projecting as starters but none cracking the elite tier that separates contenders from also-rans. The draft did not help matters: three major reaches, headlined by Justin Fields taken a staggering 6.2 rounds ahead of his ADP for a player who projects as WR38, suggest a manager who fell in love with upside that the numbers do not yet support. Drake Maye (QB2) is a genuine asset at the top of the roster, and the Caleb Williams (QB6) and Odunze stack at least gives this team a ceiling game or two. But good quarterbacks cannot carry a fantasy roster alone, and with no steals on draft day and a projected starter as modest as Hunter Henry (TE18) anchoring the bottom of the lineup, Stumpalicious50 is going to need things to break exactly right just to escape the basement.

SteveLawson93 drafted like someone who knew exactly what they wanted and had no idea what anything cost. The receiver room is legitimately good, CeeDee Lamb at WR5, Tetairoa McMillan at WR15, Davante Adams at WR25, Christian Watson at WR28, Brian Thomas Jr. at WR31, and Marvin Harrison Jr. at WR33 all projecting as starters, and Joe Burrow at QB4 gives this team a real engine. But the draft board tells the whole story: zero steals, zero values, fourteen chalk picks, and six reaches, three of them major. Blake Corum came off the board two and a half rounds early. Kaytron Allen arrived four rounds ahead of schedule. Trey Benson cost three and a half rounds more than he should have. Every one of those picks is a late-round gamble that ate into the capital that could have shored up the rest of the roster, and the result is a team sitting eleventh in the division and in the 12th

percentile of the field. SteveLawson93 went 96th percentile in scoring last year. This year, the draft did the damage before a single game was played.

There is no pretty way to say this: ThaGovenana is staring at a 23rd-percentile ceiling and sitting tenth in the Geralt of Rivia division, and the draft did not provide much reason for optimism. The roster features zero steals, zero values, and six reaches, including two painful ones. Tyler Allgeier, projected RB46, was taken four-plus rounds before his ADP. Braelon Allen, projected RB58, cost nearly four rounds of premium on top of that. Those are the kinds of early-round investments that are supposed to buy upside, and instead they bought two backs grading out well below the starting-caliber line. The genuine bright spots are real, Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 give this team a legitimate top-end core, and the Justin Herbert / Ladd McConkey stack adds some ceiling if the Chargers click. But when your projected weakest starter is Jacory Croskey-Merritt at RB40 and there are no obvious trades left unmade on draft day, you are essentially hoping the good players carry the bad ones. History suggests that is a heavy lift.

There is a version of this roster that looks fine on paper, and that version lives entirely in the backfield. Jahmyr Gibbs projects as RB1, James Cook as RB5, and Travis Etienne as RB18, a trio of projected starters that would anchor any contender in the Scott Fish Bowl. The problem is that beyond that group, FantasyHolics grades out near the bottom of their division and sits at just the 30th percentile of the field, and the draft gave them almost no path out. With 16 chalk picks, zero steals, and two major reaches, the roster was built with almost no margin for error, and the reaches did not even land at positions where the team needed a boost: Khalil Shakir at WR51 and Malik Washington at WR71 arrived well before their ADPs and sit well outside the projected starting lineup. Jalen Hurts and Jordan Love offer some optimism at QB, but optimism is not a strategy when the rest of the roster asks them to carry weight the supporting cast was never built to share. This team is not broken, just outgunned, and that is sometimes the harder situation to fix.

ToeyD lands at 32nd percentile in the tournament and seventh in the Geralt of Rivia division, and the roster construction does not offer an obvious path out of that standing. The foundation looks appealing on paper: Josh Allen is the QB1, Tyler Warren projects as TE4, and Harold Fannin slots in at TE6, giving this team genuine upside at the top. The problem is that the supporting cast falls off a cliff. The wide receiver group is headlined by Jerry Jeudy at WR66 and Cooper Kupp at WR88, both of whom were reached for before their ADPs, meaning ToeyD paid a premium for production that ranks near the bottom of the position. Meanwhile, Chuba Hubbard, the projected weakest starter, was drafted nine picks ahead of where the market had him. The draft did produce real value in Fannin and Zach Charbonnet, but the minor reaches outnumber the steals and values combined, and when your ceiling players cannot carry the floor alone, a roster built like this one tends to get exposed over a long tournament. There is no obvious lever left to pull here.

Team Mrorz arrives in the Geralt of Rivia division sitting eighth, projecting out at just the 32nd percentile of the field, and the roster itself explains why. The receiver group is legitimately impressive, anchored by Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 and Nico Collins at WR9, but that strength gets undermined by a running back corps that grades out weak across the board, with D'Andre Swift at RB24 and RJ Harvey at RB28 serving as the projected starters in a group where the talent falls off fast after that. The draft did not generate much surplus to compensate: thirteen chalk picks, a handful of minor reaches, and a major reach on Dontayvion Wicks, taken three rounds ahead of his ADP and projecting all the way down at WR96. The one genuine steal was Harvey himself, grabbed two-plus rounds past his ADP, but a player projecting as the weakest starter on the roster is a thin reward for the market's indifference. Patrick Mahomes and Travis Kelce deliver a reliable stack, yet even that feels like rearranging furniture in a house that needs structural work.

Gert of Dania is the kind of team that wins exactly as many games as it deserves, which is either reassuring or quietly terrifying depending on your tolerance for mediocrity. The floor here is real: Jonathan Taylor at RB4, Trey McBride at TE2, and Rashee Rice at WR13 form a starting core that can beat anyone on a given week. The ceiling, though, is where the margins start whispering. Brock Purdy was the one meaningful draft swing, taken a full 1.6 rounds before his ADP of QB13, and if that gamble curdles even slightly, the drop to Tyler Shough at QB20 is the kind of quiet disaster that costs a team two or three wins it never gets back. Last season's 39 percent win rate and 32nd-percentile scoring suggest a franchise that has been here before, sitting just close enough to the playoff line to stay interested but not close enough to matter. Makai Lemon projected at WR40 rounds out the starters, a perfectly average punchline for a perfectly average team.

jacobr519 is the team that beats you when you're not paying attention and loses when you are, which is exactly what 43rd percentile feels like from the inside. The roster's ceiling runs through Justin Jefferson at WR6 and Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4, a Goff stack that at least gives those two a shared engine, and the floor gets propped up by Chase Brown at RB11 and Jadarian Price at RB26 doing quiet, necessary work. What keeps this from being a comfortable projection is the draft construction: seventeen chalk picks and a Darnell Mooney reach nearly three rounds early suggest a manager who drafted what he knew rather than hunting edges, and in a field this competitive, neutral drafting means the margins have to fall your way. They fell pretty well in 2025, a 75 percent win rate that landed in the 76th percentile of scoring. Whether 2026 repeats that or regresses toward the 43rd percentile projection depends less on any one player and more on whether Jacob gets the right matchups in the right weeks, which is the most honest and least satisfying answer fantasy has to offer.

There was no lottery ticket moment in turt1es' 2026 draft, no single swing that defined the room. Just round after round of quiet competence, and a roster that ended up better for it. The anchor is Bijan Robinson, a projected RB2 who gives this team a ceiling most managers can only sketch on a napkin. Pair him with Kenneth Walker III at RB10 and turt1es already has more backfield equity than the majority of the field before the receiver corps even enters the conversation. And that corps is legitimately good: Drake London projected WR7, Chris Olave at WR11, and Jameson Williams at WR21 all project as starters, with Olave arriving as one of the draft's cleaner values after sliding nearly a full round past his ADP. The team finished in the 73rd percentile in scoring last season and projects 69th percentile this year, which is not a dramatic ascent but reflects what turt1es actually built: a team with no obvious soft spots in the starting lineup and enough depth behind it to absorb a bad week without flinching.

Back2SkolTime lands at 89th percentile in the field and third in the Geralt of Rivia division, and the draft sheet tells you exactly why: no major reaches, one outright steal, and three genuine values. That steal is Sam LaPorta, a TE8 projection snagged more than two rounds after his ADP, which is the kind of inefficiency that separates disciplined managers from lucky ones. Jake Ferguson at TE12 fell another round and a half on top of that, meaning Back2SkolTime walked away with two legitimate contributors at a premium position without ever overpaying. The skill group anchoring the rest of the lineup is just as clean: Christian McCaffrey at RB3, Saquon Barkley at RB8, Breece Hall at RB14, and Malik Nabers at WR12 give this roster a ceiling most managers in this field would envy. The one question mark is C.J. Stroud, a QB22 who has spent the last couple of seasons drifting from the promise of his explosive early play, but with Lamar Jackson as the QB3 anchor, Stroud is depth rather than dependency. This is a roster built with patience and paid off in production.

BucJordan sits at 93rd percentile in this field, and the draft record tells you exactly why: seven values, thirteen chalk, zero reaches. Not a single round where panic set in or the board got chased. The foundation is immaculate, with De'Von Achane at RB6 sliding a full round past his ADP and Brock Bowers anchoring the lineup as the TE1. But the real signature of this roster is the discipline layered on top of that talent. Mark Andrews, projected TE14, fell nearly two rounds before BucJordan scooped him. Kyle Pitts, TE7, same story. Managers who draft this way are not getting lucky, they are reading the room and waiting, and the patience compounds. A.J. Brown at WR8 and Garrett Wilson at WR17 give the lineup a starting core that most teams in this division would envy. The weakest projected starter is Chris Godwin at WR38, which is the kind of complaint that only exists on a very good team. Second in the Geralt of Rivia division, and built to climb.

There is not much to nitpick here, and that is the point. Nube sits first in the Geralt of Rivia division and at the 98th tournament percentile, and the draft record tells you exactly why: six values, fourteen chalk, zero reaches of any kind. That kind of discipline is harder to execute than it sounds. The headline is Puka Nacua at WR1 anchoring a starting group that also includes George Pickens at WR10 and Zay Flowers at WR16, but the quieter win is how nube kept finding players after their ADP. Jaxson Dart fell nearly two full rounds to be taken at QB11. Dallas Goedert slipped almost two rounds as well, and the knock on Goedert heading into 2026 is hard to locate, given that he was about the only reliable piece in the Philadelphia passing game a year ago and chose to stay. When your weakest projected starter is a TE15 who signed back with his team and arrives with momentum, you have built something worth paying attention to.
