SadisticMrNapier sits at the 8th percentile of the field, dead last in the Ghost of Tsushima division, and the draft chart offers no alibi. Nineteen picks produced zero steals and zero values, two major reaches, and a roster that grades out exactly as chalk-heavy as it looks. The foundation is real enough: Lamar Jackson at QB3 paired with Zay Flowers at WR16 gives this team a legitimate stack, and Jonathan Taylor at RB4 is the kind of asset that keeps a manager in contention on his own. But the floor below that trio drops off fast, and the weakest projected starter tells the whole story. Jonathon Brooks has torn the same ACL twice in three years, missed the entire 2025 season, and now heads into a soft Carolina backfield that nobody is afraid of. He is either a windfall or a week-two obituary, and SadisticMrNapier is counting on him as a starter. When your margin for error is this thin and your swing piece is that fragile, hoping is not a strategy.

BamaGary96 did almost everything right on draft day. Amon-Ra St. Brown fell nearly four rounds past his ADP and was sitting there at 2.02, a genuine gift. Tyrone Tracy slipped more than three full rounds and was scooped up accordingly. Across the board, the draft log reads like a clinic in patience, with 17 chalk picks and only a single minor reach in Trevor Lawrence. The roster that emerged from all that discipline is sitting 11th in the Ghost of Tsushima division and projects in the 22nd percentile of the field, and that is the particular cruelty of it. St. Brown at WR4 and CeeDee Lamb at WR5 are legitimately elite. Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 and D.J. Moore at WR26 are real contributors. But the top-end punch simply does not reach the level the draft efficiency deserved, and the team projects to suffer for it anyway. BamaGary96 did not lose this draft. The draft just did not care.

Frederick5 finished last season at the 70th percentile in scoring, so the floor exists, but the 2026 projections tell a grimmer story. The receiver group is where this roster bleeds out quietly, with Ladd McConkey at WR20 and Rome Odunze at WR30 leading a corps that falls off fast, bottoming out with names like Jaylin Noel (WR83) and Chris Bell (WR87) in the late rounds. Josh Allen at QB1 and Tyler Warren at TE4 are genuine assets, and Ashton Jeanty (RB7) gives the backfield a legitimate anchor, but those peaks cannot carry the weight of what surrounds them when the roster grades out near the bottom of the field overall. The draft did not help close the gap either, producing zero steals, one major reach in Ryan Flounoy at a stiff WR69, and a handful of minor ones. Sitting tenth in the Ghost of Tsushima division and projected at the 25th percentile, Frederick5 is not rebuilding toward something. It is just hoping the right pieces get hot at the right time, which is a strategy only slightly better than hoping.

DonWizzle did almost everything right in the draft room. Christian McCaffrey at RB3, Joe Burrow at QB4, Omarion Hampton at RB9, and two genuine values in RJ Harvey and Zach Charbonnet, both of whom slipped well past their ADPs into waiting hands. Zero major reaches, a patient approach, and a final roster that lands at the 28th percentile of the field anyway, which is the kind of outcome that makes you question whether fantasy drafting is a skill or an elaborate practical joke. The trouble is in the supporting cast. Malik Nabers at WR12 is the only receiver projected to clear the top-25, and Marvin Harrison Jr. at WR33 and Courtland Sutton at WR37 are functional starters who need things to go right to feel like assets. The single tight end is Kenyon Sadiq at TE21, a reach taken nearly two rounds early, and he is the weakest link in a chain that was supposed to hold. DonWizzle graded the market correctly and still arrived here, ninth in the Ghost of Tsushima division, which is the cruelest grade the draft can give.

Davideo did almost everything right in the draft. Fifteen picks landed at chalk, three fell past ADP, and the team avoided any meaningful reaches, with Kyle Pitts the lone exception at just under a round early. The process was disciplined. The result is an 8th-place division finish projected at the 41st percentile, which is what happens when value shopping at a farmers market still leaves you with an unremarkable meal. The top of the roster is genuinely interesting: Jayden Daniels and Caleb Williams give Davideo two QB5-or-better options, and Jaxon Smith-Njigba projects as WR3. But the middle of the lineup is where the air goes out. Parker Washington is a classic case of a player whose production outran his situation once and may not again, with Brian Thomas Jr. and Travis Hunter both ahead of him in the organization's affections, if not last year's target share. When your projected weakest starter is Josh Downs at WR46, the roster isn't broken, it's just quietly undersized in the places that decide tight weeks.

ryanralph sits at 48th percentile in this field, which sounds like a punchline until you look closely at what's actually here. The foundation is real: De'Von Achane at RB6 and Trey McBride at TE2 are legitimate difference-makers, the kind of players who win weeks outright rather than just contribute to them. Breece Hall at RB14 keeps the floor elevated, and the Jared Goff and Jameson Williams stack gives ryanralph a ceiling-raising correlation play in the weeks it fires. The concern is that the margin for error is thin enough to feel it. Brock Purdy was a reach of nearly two rounds at QB13, a price that looks steep for a manager who needed that capital elsewhere, and Michael Wilson projects as the weakest projected starter at WR39, a number that will decide a lot of close matchups. The 2025 season went 42 percent wins. This roster is better than that, but not by so much that ryanralph can afford Purdy going sideways. The margins here are real, and they cut both ways.

aspires is a team built on the knife's edge between contention and irrelevance, and the margins that cut this season will run straight through the backfield. Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1 and Saquon Barkley at RB8 give this roster a ceiling that demands respect, and the draft board only adds to the case: Chase Brown fell to RB11 at pick 4.11, Jadarian Price slid to RB26 in round ten, and Jaylen Warren came off the board nearly three full rounds past his ADP at RB27. That is not luck, that is a manager who knew where the value was pooling. What keeps aspires parked at the division's sixth spot and the tournament's 50th percentile is a receiving corps that tops out at Tee Higgins as a projected WR19 starter, thin support above the lineup threshold. Travis Kelce, officially back after an uncertain offseason and chasing a return to the TE12 conversation, steadies the tight end room alongside Mark Andrews at TE14. This roster does not lose you weeks, but it does not win them on autopilot either. The margins decide everything.

zac1397 did not walk away from this draft with any single jaw-dropping moment, and that is precisely the point. The foundation is a receiver group that would make most managers envious: Justin Jefferson (WR6), Drake London (WR7), Nico Collins (WR9), and Rashee Rice (WR13) all project as starters, and zac1397 landed Collins a full round past his ADP and Jordan Addison (WR43) nearly two rounds late. That is the quiet work of a manager who stayed patient and let the board come to them. Brian Thomas Jr. (WR31) adds another projected starter with genuine upside, though his 2025 was a rough stretch of injuries and inconsistency that leaves some question marks around how much he has rediscovered his connection with Trevor Lawrence. The floor here is real, built draft pick by draft pick without overreaching, and a 53 percent win rate last season against a 60th percentile scoring output suggests this roster, sharpened, has more ceiling than the results have shown.

MaizeRager didn't win the draft in one flashy moment. They won it across eighteen rounds of quiet, consistent execution. The foundation is genuinely elite: Puka Nacua projects as WR1, A.J. Brown as WR8, and Emeka Egbuka as WR18, a collection that gives this roster a ceiling most managers would trade a first-round pick to acquire. Kenneth Walker III at RB10 and Javonte Williams at RB17 keep the fantasy points flowing when the passing game cools off. The one true steal of the draft was Kyle Monangai, snagged at 15.03 against an ADP of 12.01, three-plus rounds of free value on a back who projects as RB33. Yes, the quarterback situation is thin, Sam Darnold at QB21 and Daniel Jones at QB25 are not names that inspire confidence, but in a positionless format the position matters far less than the depth of elite options everywhere else. At 72nd percentile in the field, this is a team built to compete, not just participate, and the draft bears that out.

jhart54 didn't need a lottery ticket to build this roster. The draft was almost relentlessly sensible, with 15 chalk picks forming a foundation sturdy enough that the outliers barely register. Bijan Robinson at RB2 and James Cook at RB5 give this team a backfield that can carry a week all by itself, and the front end of the starting group is genuinely difficult to beat. Chris Olave fell nearly a full round past his ADP before jhart54 scooped him at WR11, which is the kind of quiet efficiency that separates a good draft from a great one. Harold Fannin at TE6 adds another starter who would be the centerpiece of a lesser roster. The one eyebrow-raiser is Kaytron Allen, taken almost five rounds ahead of his ADP, though late-round conviction bets are forgivable when the rest of the board is this clean. Coming off a 64 percent win rate and a 71st-percentile scoring season in 2025, sitting third in the Ghost of Tsushima division and at the 73rd tournament percentile feels less like a ceiling than a launching pad.

mike_chavez didn't need a home run swing to land in the 79th percentile of the field and second in the Ghost of Tsushima division. The draft just kept coming out ahead, pick after pick, in the quiet and convincing way that separates good managers from lucky ones. The foundation is real: Brock Bowers at TE1, Drake Maye at QB2, and George Pickens at WR10 give this roster a ceiling that most teams can only approximate. Maye is particularly interesting because he slid to 2.06 despite projecting as QB2, a clean value that Chavez simply recognized and took. The tight end group extends the advantage further, with Sam LaPorta at TE8 and George Kittle at TE9 providing genuine depth behind Bowers. Rashod Bateman, taken nearly four rounds ahead of his ADP, is the one draft-day gamble that stands out against an otherwise disciplined board, but one reach on a late-round flier barely dents the portrait of a manager who spent sixteen rounds getting more than he paid for.

EIDude arrived at draft day without a single steal on the sheet and still walked away with one of the better rosters in the Ghost of Tsushima division. That is what consistent execution looks like. The foundation is legitimate: Ja'Marr Chase projects as WR2, Jalen Hurts as QB9, and Colston Loveland as TE3, a trio of top-shelf projected starters that most managers would build entire strategies around. What separates EIDude is that the middle rounds held up too. Bucky Irving slid a full 1.4 rounds past his ADP before EIDude grabbed him at RB21, and Jaxson Dart fell more than a round to land at QB11, where he also connects with Isaiah Likely in a stack that could pay real dividends. The floor is not invisible either, Jayden Reed projects as the weakest projected starter at WR48, but that is a reasonable complaint about a roster sitting at 89th percentile in the field. EIDude did not need a lottery ticket. The draft itself was the edge.
