As the 2025 fantasy football season looms on the horizon, the outlook for Tom Strachan (@NFL\_TStrack) feels more like a grim endurance test than a thrilling contest. With a ranking of 12 in the division and languishing in the 2nd percentile overall, hope is a rare commodity. Anchored by strong running backs, including De'Von Achane and Derrick Henry, there's a flicker of potential there, but it seems like a lone bright spot. The receiving corps, with Rashee Rice leading the charge, falls behind expectations, barely lifting its head above the competition. Meanwhile, Dallas Goedert holds the questionable honor of being one of the weakest projected starters at TE16, further dragging down an already shaky lineup. Despite reaching for some key players like Kyler Murray far before their ADP suggested, the team is left with little to show for it, as the aggressive drafting strategy appears to have backfired spectacularly. As Tom Strachan faces the daunting road ahead, it seems

the team may be doomed to endure a season of quiet desperation, clinging to the fragile hope that fortune might somehow, improbably, turn in their favor.

As the 2025 fantasy football season approaches, Chris Charles (@ccharles83) finds itself in a challenging position with little room for optimism. Ranked second to last in their division and languishing near the bottom in overall tournament standings, the outlook is bleak. The team's glaring weakness at running back, with Brian Robinson and Zach Charbonnet underperforming, sets a troubling tone. Even though the team boasts strong wide receivers like Malik Nabers and Brian Thomas Jr., their potential may be squandered without a balanced roster. Isaiah Likely's presence as the starting tight end only compounds concerns, as he struggles to compete at a higher level. While there were moments of draft strategy brilliance, such as acquiring Jameson Williams at a great value, such rare victories are overshadowed by costly reaches. The early selection of Michael Penix Jr. and Jaylen Wright significantly earlier than their ADPs has lost the team valuable opportunities.

Despite a small boost from the Burrow-Higgins stack, the team's lackluster draft choices and poor positional balance threaten to seal their fate as an afterthought in both divisional and tournament play.
