Slappers Only enters the Goldeneye 007 division sitting 12th in divisional rank and in the 12th percentile of the broader field, and the draft log does not offer much comfort about how they got there. The team leaned hard on quarterback early, reaching 1.5 rounds for Trevor Lawrence at QB10 and spending a mid-round pick on Bryce Young at QB26, a pair of decisions that consumed premium draft capital without returning premium production. Meanwhile, three major reaches and zero steals across the board tell the story of a manager who kept paying above market price and never once got the house back. The receiver group, anchored by Jaxon Smith-Njigba at WR3 and a solid Jordan Love and Christian Watson stack, gives the roster a genuine pulse, but everything below that top tier fades quickly, and the weakest projected starter, Kyle Monangai at RB33, is being asked to carry real lineup weight. Last year's 61 percent win rate shows this organization can compete, but the 2026 construction suggests they may be spending all summer hoping a leaky boat somehow holds water.

There is something almost poignant about Complex - Power Weapons, a team that built its entire identity around correlation and now sits at 11th in the Goldeneye 007 division, projected in just the 19th percentile of the field. The architecture is easy to admire in theory: Joe Burrow stacked with Tee Higgins, Jared Goff stacked with Amon-Ra St. Brown, two of the cleaner quarterback-receiver pairings you can construct. When those connections fire, this roster has a real ceiling. But the margin for error is brutally thin, and the supporting cast does not inspire confidence. Oronde Gadsden, projected TE16, was supposed to provide a reliable third option in the passing game, but the Chargers' late signing of David Njoku clouds his role considerably. Romeo Doubs projects as the weakest starter on the whole team. And with 11 chalk picks, no steals, and two major reaches, this roster was assembled without much market advantage to fall back on. The stack is not a bonus here, it is the entire plan, and plans this narrow have a way of unraveling quietly.

There is no easy way to dress this up: Oddjob cheatcode enters 2026 sitting 10th in the Goldeneye 007 division and projecting in just the 22nd percentile of the field, and the draft sheet offers almost no comfort. Across 19 picks, the manager landed zero steals and zero values, chalked out 14 selections, and reached on two players in ways that genuinely hurt. Jordan James comes in at RB67 despite being taken nearly four and a half rounds ahead of schedule, and Darnell Mooney checks in at WR82 after the same kind of optimistic early investment. Those are not gambles that paid off. The roster does have real pieces, Brock Bowers at TE1 is as good as it gets at the position, and James Cook at RB5 gives the team a legitimate weekly weapon, but everything below that tier falls off sharply, with Quentin Johnston projected as the weakest expected starter at WR41. When your floor is propped up by two players and your draft capital largely evaporated into chalk and reaches, there are no levers left to pull.

Die Another Sunday enters the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl sitting ninth in the Goldeneye 007 division and at the 24th tournament percentile, and the roster tells you exactly why. The saving grace here is Ja'Marr Chase, a WR2 projection that gives this team a genuine anchor, and Nico Collins at WR9 means the top of the lineup can genuinely compete on any given week. The problem is that everything below that tier gets thin in a hurry, and the draft decisions compound the damage. The manager spent a fourth-round pick on Bo Nix, a QB15, in a positionless format where quarterbacks carry far less premium, and then doubled down by reaching for Kyler Murray and Tua Tagovailoa in later rounds, stockpiling at a position where the investment rarely pays off. Meanwhile, the projected weakest starter is Michael Pittman at WR44, which is not a floor anyone feels comfortable with. There are no obvious levers left to pull. Chase is real, but one elite receiver cannot drag a roster out of the bottom quartile by himself.

DK Mode arrived at the 2026 Scott Fish Bowl sitting 8th in the Goldeneye 007 division and in just the 38th percentile of the field, and there is not much in the construction of this roster to suggest a dramatic reversal. The receiver group is legitimately impressive, anchored by A.J. Brown (WR8) and George Pickens (WR10), with Jameson Williams (WR21) and Luther Burden (WR22) adding real depth behind them. But a fantasy team needs a quarterback to unlock all of that, and this one is asking Sam Darnold (QB21) to do the job after being drafted a full two rounds ahead of his ADP. That reach stings even more given the context: Darnold won a Super Bowl in Seattle last year on the back of a dominant running game and a pass-catching corps that funneled almost entirely to Jaxon Smith-Njigba. With Kenneth Walker gone, the hope is that Darnold expands his footprint, but hope is not a strategy. Jahmyr Gibbs (RB1) is a genuine weapon, but one elite building block cannot carry a roster projected this far down the standings.

Senra Says is the kind of team that wins a tournament by threading a needle rather than blowing anyone's doors off, and in 2026 the needle is very much still threaded. The top of the roster is genuinely good: Drake London at WR7, Trey McBride at TE2, and DeVonta Smith at WR14 give this lineup a ceiling that can compete on any given week. The problem is the floor. Malik Willis at QB24 was the most puzzling investment of the draft, taken 2.5 rounds ahead of his ADP, and he projects as the weakest starter on the board. That kind of premium spent on a back-end quarterback is exactly the kind of margin that separates 7th in the Goldeneye 007 division from 4th. The 2025 campaign checked in at 27th percentile in scoring, so the upside here is real, but it requires London, McBride, and Smith to carry their weight every week while Willis does just enough not to sink the ship. Middle of the field, middle of the standings, until something tips the balance.

willson8tor did not need a single heist to build something worth watching in the Goldeneye 007 division. The draft read more like a slow accumulation of correct decisions, and the results speak for themselves: 16 picks landed at or near consensus value, with almost nothing wasted on a gamble that did not pay off. The foundation sits on Jonathan Taylor at RB4 and Justin Jefferson at WR6, two projected starters who give this roster a genuine ceiling, and the depth behind them is not filler. Josh Jacobs at RB16 and Travis Etienne at RB18 are both projected starters, and Etienne arriving a round and a half after his average draft position makes him the clearest sign that willson8tor was paying attention when others were not. Jalen Hurts and Brock Purdy project as QB9 and QB13, respectively, which means the position is covered without stress. Coming off a 61 percent win rate and a 74th-percentile scoring season in 2025, this is a team that already knows how to convert a well-built roster into actual wins, and the 2026 version gives them every reason to do it again.

Cheating Screen Watcher didn't win the draft with one flashy pick. They won it by consistently getting the better end of the bargain. Puka Nacua at WR1 anchors a receiver group that also includes Rashee Rice at WR13 and Mike Evans at WR27, all projected starters, and Rice arrived as a genuine value after slipping nearly a full round past his ADP. Bucky Irving at RB21 similarly fell into their lap, sliding more than a round and a half. That kind of patient accumulation is how you build a starting lineup without mortgaging the back of your draft. The two reaches at quarterback are the asterisk on an otherwise clean sheet, with C.J. Stroud and Daniel Jones each taken more than two rounds early, which is real capital spent on speculative upside. KC Concepcion sits at the floor of the projected lineup as WR50, and his path to relevance runs squarely through Cleveland's unsettled quarterback situation. The 2025 résumé already showed what this manager can do, finishing in the 86th percentile in scoring. The 2026 version looks built the same way, quietly and correctly.

EvilEmpireFF didn't swing for the fences and miss, didn't mortgage the middle rounds chasing a single star. They just kept coming out ahead, pick after pick. The foundation is genuinely impressive: Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 give this roster a pair of projected difference-makers who would anchor almost any contender in the field, and Sam LaPorta at TE8 is a dependable asset at a position where the drop-off after the top options is steep. Then consider where the value showed up in the draft: Travis Hunter landed at WR62 despite an ADP closer to the early fourteenth round, Marvin Harrison Jr. at WR33 fell more than a full round past expectations, and Xavier Worthy at WR49 slid nearly two rounds before EvilEmpireFF scooped him. Eleven chalk picks tell you this manager wasn't gambling, and a 66th-percentile projection with a 2025 record of 72 percent wins suggests the process holds up. This is a team built the boring, effective way, and boring tends to age well.

bhillman42 finished 27-9 last season, scored in the 81st percentile, and now arrives in the Goldeneye 007 division ranked third with a roster that looks considerably better than that modest standing suggests. The draft board will tell you this manager reached, and that is technically true: De'Von Achane went at pick 2.02 against an ADP of 2.07, a minor crime, and Chris Brazzell II got grabbed 5.4 rounds before the market would have allowed it. But conviction has a funny way of looking like luck in the rearview mirror, and the top of this roster is genuinely formidable. Caleb Williams as QB6, Achane at RB6, and CeeDee Lamb at WR5 form the kind of nucleus that wins tournaments, and Harold Fannin, projected TE6, adds another layer of upside now that his target competition in Cleveland has thinned following David Njoku's departure. The reaches are real. The roster is realer. bhillman42 bet on themselves in this draft, and for now, the bet looks good.

Boris Onatopp didn't need a heist to build this roster, just patient, disciplined drafting that kept coming out ahead on value. The clearest example is the backfield, where Kenneth Walker III (RB10), Breece Hall (RB14), Javonte Williams (RB17), and TreVeyon Henderson (RB19) form a collection of projected starters that would make most managers envious, all acquired at or near their expected cost. The values, though, are what elevate this draft from competent to quietly impressive. Chris Olave fell nearly a round to land as a WR11, Jake Ferguson slid a full round to give Onatopp a TE12 at a discount, and Drake Maye arrived two rounds late as a projected QB2 with a QB1 already on the roster in Josh Allen. Five values against zero major reaches across the entire draft is a profile that lands Onatopp at 82nd percentile in the field, second in the Goldeneye 007 division, and very much in the conversation heading into 2026.

Bro, Stop Camping! sits first in the Goldeneye 007 division and in the 94th percentile of the entire field, and the reason is almost embarrassingly simple: this roster accumulated elite talent at the positions that matter most and then dared you to argue with it. Lamar Jackson at QB3 and Patrick Mahomes at QB12 give the manager two genuine difference-makers under center, but this is a positionless format, so what really matters is that Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and Saquon Barkley at RB8 are projected starters, joined by Cam Skattebo at RB20 and D'Andre Swift at RB24, a group that would win most rosters outright on its own. Layer in Colston Loveland at TE3 and Mark Andrews at TE14, with Jackson and Andrews stacked for bonus upside, and you are looking at a roster whose projected starters read like someone forgot to cap the talent. Barkley, Swift, Loveland, and Andrews all

came in as good values relative to their ADPs, meaning the manager built this thing efficiently and still walked away holding the best hand in the room.
