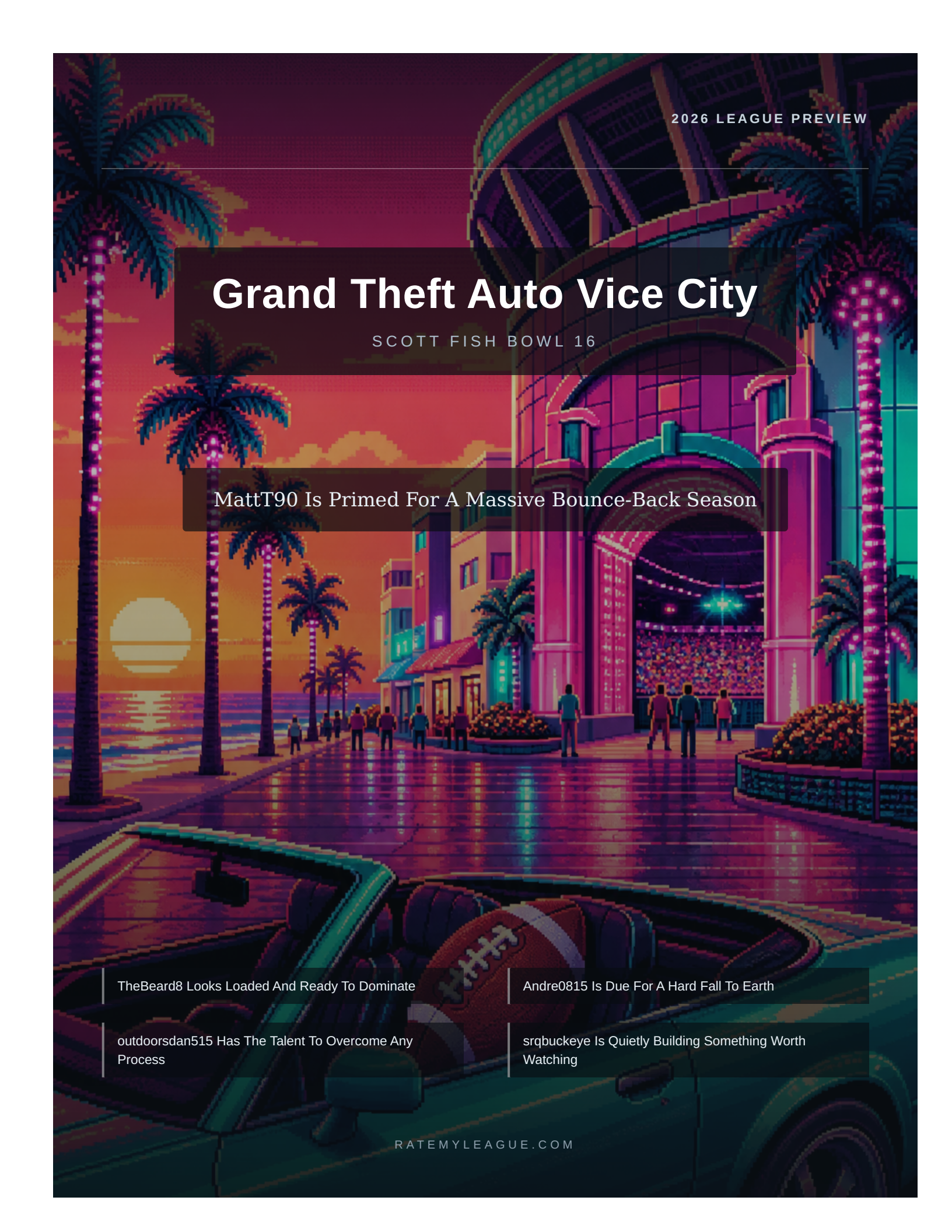

Kw867233 finished last season in the 15th percentile of scoring and somehow responded by drafting worse. The signature move was spending a second-round pick on Caleb Williams, a full round before Williams came off the board for anyone else, then doubling down with major reaches on Oronde Gadsden and Kenyon Sadiq back-to-back in rounds seven and eight, collectively burning nearly six rounds of draft equity on two tight ends who project at TE16 and TE21. The roster that emerged from those decisions sits at 24th percentile and dead last in the Grand Theft Auto Vice City division, which is what happens when four of your picks qualify as major reaches and you collect zero steals across an entire draft. Bijan Robinson at RB2 and Malik Nabers at WR12 are real, and both came at genuine value, but they are doing load-bearing structural work for a building that was condemned before they moved in. Everything this manager touched on the way down the board confirmed the instinct that started the whole spiral: reach early, reach often, and trust the process while it walks you off a cliff.

TheSpinZone sits 11th in the Grand Theft Auto Vice City division and in the 26th percentile of the field, and the roster explains both numbers without much argument. The foundation looks passable on paper: Josh Allen is a genuine QB1, and Omarion Hampton projects as RB9, which is real value at a premium position. The problem is that the draft did not generate much separation. TheSpinZone logged zero steals and reached on four players, including Cooper Kupp at WR88, taken nearly three rounds before his ADP, which is the kind of move that costs a roster a useful late pick and returns a WR88 in exchange. The projected starters outside Allen and Hampton thin out quickly, with Tony Pollard grading as the weakest of the bunch at RB30. A 15-21 finish at 50th percentile scoring last season suggested a team that hovered just below the margin, and this roster, built heavily on chalk with one costly overpay at the back end, does not offer an obvious path to climbing past it.

There is a version of this roster that looks fine on paper, and then you squint at the bottom half and the weariness sets in. TwoSeven enters 2026 ranked tenth in the Grand Theft Auto Vice City division and in just the 36th percentile of the field, and the draft did not do much to improve the outlook. Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and James Cook at RB5 are genuine stars, and they will keep the lights on. But the supporting cast frays quickly, and the draft decisions compound the problem. Jared Goff was taken 4.01, a full 2.2 rounds ahead of his QB16 projection, which is the kind of investment that echoes through every round that follows. Michael Mayer was similarly grabbed 6.2 rounds early only to project as TE39. Those early overpays have a cost, and you can trace it through the rest of the roster. TwoSeven went 61 percent last season and scored in the 62nd percentile of the field. The bones were there once. Right now, it is hard to find the lever that turns this around.

Andre0815 finished 2025 in the 94th percentile, went 28-8, and scored over 5,000 points. That team earned its reputation. This one is projected 44th percentile, sitting ninth in the Grand Theft Auto Vice City division, and the distance between those two data points is where the real story lives. The foundation is not nothing: CeeDee Lamb at WR5 and Rashee Rice at WR13 are legitimate weapons, and Joe Burrow at QB4 gives the offense a real ceiling. But the draft work that surrounds them is shaky in ways that matter. Matthew Stafford, projected QB14, was taken two full rounds ahead of his ADP, which is a significant price to pay for a backup. Carnell Tate, projected WR29, offers intrigue as he links up with Cam Ward in Tennessee, but that pairing still needs to prove itself before it can be counted on. Last year's version of this team was built to win. This year's version is built to hope the ceiling players stay healthy and a few unproven bets cash in at the right time.

sfly enters 2026 sitting at the 46th percentile of the field and eighth in the Grand Theft Auto Vice City division, which tells you just about everything you need to know about where this season is headed. The backfield is legitimately elite, anchored by De'Von Achane (RB6) and Saquon Barkley (RB8), but the rest of the roster keeps undercutting that foundation at every turn. Jordan Love (QB17) was the most glaring draft mistake, taken more than two rounds ahead of his ADP, and the price paid for a QB17 projection stings considerably more when the alternative was letting that capital flow somewhere useful. The quarterback situation compounds further with Sam Darnold (QB21) as the backup, meaning sfly is paying above-market prices for what grades out as below-average QB play. Ja'Marr Chase (WR2) is a genuine weapon, but he is largely doing his best work propping up a roster that otherwise grades average at receiver and weak at tight end. Achane and Barkley are not enough to carry a tournament entry when the rest of the cards keep coming up short.

fantasyfootballchick is a team that lives and dies in the margins, and right now the margins are just slightly uncomfortable. The foundation is genuinely excellent: Brock Bowers at TE1, Kyle Pitts at TE7, and Sam LaPorta at TE8 give this roster an elite top of the depth chart that most managers would envy, and Drake London at WR7 and Nico Collins at WR9 keep the scoring floor respectable. But the team sits 7th in the Grand Theft Auto Vice City division and in the 47th percentile of the field, which means "respectable floor" is not going to cut it. The swing piece is Patrick Mahomes, reached a full round early at QB12, who is reportedly ahead of schedule recovering from a torn ACL and LCL suffered in Week 15 of 2025. If Mahomes is on the field in Week 1, this roster has a legitimate ceiling. If he is not, C.J. Stroud at QB22 is the fallback, and a QB22 does not win you a Scott Fish Bowl. fantasyfootballchick is not dangerous and not dismissible. She's a coin flip wearing very good tight end shoes.

jparrott83 is the kind of team that wins ten and loses ten and makes you feel nothing either way, which in a field this competitive might be exactly the problem. The tight end pairing of Trey McBride (TE2) and Colston Loveland (TE3) is legitimately elite, a top-of-the-position anchor that keeps the floor from caving in. The receiver group has enough projected starters to stay afloat, with George Pickens (WR10), Tee Higgins (WR19), and Jameson Williams (WR21) doing the heavy lifting while Quentin Johnston (WR41) sits at the projected weakest starter spot, a number that will matter in the weeks everything else goes sideways. What concerns the eye here is the draft process: seventeen chalk picks, one value, and a Baker Mayfield reach two full rounds ahead of his ADP at the QB18 slot. This roster did not beat the market, it matched it, and at 48th percentile entering the season, matching the market just leaves you right where you started, one bad week from falling out of contention and one good one from briefly mattering.

keto06 didn't swing for the fences and whiff, didn't load up on upside and pray. This roster was built the old-fashioned way: pick after pick that made sense, and a starting group that quietly reflects it. Puka Nacua at WR1 is the kind of anchor that makes everything downstream easier, and the surrounding cast of Jayden Daniels at QB5 and Kenneth Walker III at RB10 means keto06 is competing at the top of the position rankings in multiple places simultaneously. The draft itself was about as clean as it gets, fourteen chalk picks and only three minor reaches, none of which represent a real gamble. The one name worth watching is Michael Pittman, projected at WR44 and the team's weakest projected starter. Pittman landed in Pittsburgh alongside DK Metcalf on an offense still searching for an identity under a new coaching staff, with Aaron Rodgers at age 43 running the show. That is a lot of uncertainty for one receiver. But one uncertain piece does not define a roster this well-constructed, and at 53rd percentile in the field, keto06 has the floor to prove it.

outdoorsdan515 built something real here, and the draft log makes it look almost accidental. Three major reaches, zero steals, and yet the roster sits at the 52nd percentile with genuine upside threaded through the top of the lineup. Jaxson Smith-Njigba at WR3 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 are the kind of names that make a roster sheet look serious before you read anything else, and Tyler Warren at TE4 gives this team a consistent advantage at a position where most managers are guessing. The reaches are where the story gets complicated. Jaxson Dart, grabbed a full round before his ADP, is exactly the sort of electric, hard-to-trust quarterback who can either justify that conviction or make it look foolish by October, and his history of cutting games short for the wrong reasons only sharpens that edge. What keeps outdoorsdan515 worth watching is that the core is good enough to carry a few speculative calls. Dart stumbles, the rest still competes. Dart delivers, this team climbs out of fifth place in the Grand Theft Auto Vice City division in a hurry.

srqbuckeye didn't need a lottery ticket to build this roster, just a steady hand and enough patience to let the board come to them. The clearest example is Drake Maye, a projected QB2 who slid half a round past his ADP before srqbuckeye calmly stepped in. That kind of draft discipline compounds quickly: pair Maye's ceiling with a Jalen Hurts and Dallas Goedert stack providing a built-in correlation bonus, and the scoring floor gets very comfortable very fast. On top of that, Jahmyr Gibbs projects as the RB1, giving the roster an elite anchor while names like Garrett Wilson (WR17) and Ladd McConkey (WR20) keep the supporting cast genuinely competitive rather than just respectable. The weakest projected starter is Khalil Shakir at WR51, which says more about the overall quality here than it does about any vulnerability. Sitting third in the division and at the 56th percentile of the field, srqbuckeye is the kind of team that doesn't announce itself loudly but shows up in the later rounds of every conversation about contenders.

TheBeard8 did not come to the Scott Fish Bowl to make mistakes, and the draft sheet backs that up completely. Five values, zero reaches, and a starting group that reads like a committee voted on it in advance. Jonathan Taylor at RB4, Breece Hall at RB14, and Kyren Williams at RB15 give this roster a top-end that most managers would trade half their bench to own, and Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 ensures the receiving talent keeps pace. What elevates this from good to genuinely impressive is the discipline shown in the middle and late rounds, where TheBeard8 kept finding players who slipped. Cam Skattebo fell a full round and a half before landing at RB20. KC Concepcion drifted two full rounds past his ADP. These are not flukes, they are a manager paying attention when others blinked. The one projection worth watching is Cam Ward, who enters a Tennessee offense that quietly upgraded its weapons with Carnell Tate and Wan'Dale Robinson, meaning Ward either validates the dart throw or reminds everyone why he fell to QB23. At 75th percentile and second in the Grand Theft Auto Vice City division, TheBeard8 looks like exactly what a clean SFB draft is supposed to produce.

Last year, MattT90 finished in the 5th percentile in scoring and went 9-27. That's not a rough patch, that's a crater. The 2026 roster looks like a genuine excavation crew. Lamar Jackson at QB3 is the kind of anchor that makes everything downstream easier, and MattT90 got him with the first overall pick, a minor reach off ADP that already looks justified. The real construction work happened in the middle rounds, where the draft rewarded patience: Emeka Egbuka fell 1.6 rounds past his ADP and landed as a projected WR18 starter, and D.J. Moore slipped a full round to give the roster a projected WR26 to pair alongside Justin Jefferson at WR6. Stack those three receivers behind Jackson and add Chase Brown at RB11 and Derrick Henry at RB12, and this roster sits first in the Grand Theft Auto Vice City division and at the 79th percentile of the field. After 2025, MattT90 didn't just rebuild. They loaded up.
