Lawrence sits at the 5th percentile of the field heading into 2026, and the draft record explains exactly how they got there: zero steals, zero values, and a trail of reaches that reads like a cautionary tale for everyone else in the Guitar Hero division. The major reaches are the story here. Tyler Warren is a legitimate TE4, fine, but pulling him at 2.02 when his ADP sat at 3.04 meant Lawrence spent a premium pick chasing a player they could have had a round later, a luxury they couldn't afford when the rest of the board was already going sideways. Then came Rhamondre Stevenson, a projected RB31 yanked more than three rounds before his ADP, who now projects as the weakest starter on the roster. And Shedeur Sanders, taken three rounds early at 14.02 to back up Lamar Jackson and Patrick Mahomes, a pairing that raises the obvious question of why the backup slot warranted that kind of urgency at all. Weary is the right word for watching a draft go this wrong this consistently.

There is no charitable way to frame MikesDrafts' outlook in the Guitar Hero division, where they currently project 11th and sit in just the 5th percentile of the entire field. The draft tells most of the story: three major reaches against zero steals, which is the kind of ledger that makes a team-builder wince. The biggest crime was burning the first overall pick slot on Jayden Daniels at QB5, a move that cost roughly a round and a half in value at a position this format rarely rewards that early. The supporting cast never recovered. Blake Corum projects as the weakest projected starter at RB35, and Dalton Kincaid, the team's best option at TE11, arrives carrying a knee injury so uncertain that Bills GM Brandon Beane couldn't even confirm it would be resolved by 2026. When your upside scenario requires a player whose own front office is shrugging about his health, and your draft capital is already spent, there simply is no lever left to pull. This roster is not in a hole; it built the hole itself.

RhodesToLA is staring down 2026 with the grim résumé of a team that already knows how this ends. Last season's 14-22 record and 31st-percentile scoring weren't flukes, and the 2026 roster doesn't offer much reason to rewrite that story. The top of the roster has genuine star power, Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and Drake Maye at QB2 headline a group that looks formidable on paper, but the supporting cast fades fast, and the receiver corps grades out weak with Zay Flowers at WR16 as the lone credible threat. The draft didn't help matters. Eighteen chalk picks with zero steals means this roster is exactly what it looks like, no hidden gems, no late-round lottery tickets quietly waiting to pop. The one swing the manager did take, pulling RJ Harvey 2.6 rounds ahead of his ADP at pick 7.10, now projects as the weakest starter on the board at RB28. That's the story here: McCaffrey and Maye can carry a roster only so far, and right now the rest of the team isn't holding up its end of the deal.

The Guitar Hero division is not a forgiving neighborhood, and dcarv is walking in with a roster that grades out at just the 32nd percentile of the field. The building blocks are real: Bijan Robinson (RB2) and Saquon Barkley (RB8) give this team a genuinely elite foundation, and Colston Loveland (TE3) and Mark Andrews (TE14) add legitimate upside at the top of the lineup. But the moment you look beyond that core, the picture darkens fast. Jordan Addison (WR43) is projected as the weakest starter, and the receiver group behind her never gets better in a meaningful way. Worse, dcarv spent three major reaches in the draft on Jaydon Blue (RB70), Pat Bryant (WR86), and Elijah Sarratt (WR98), late fliers who project more as wish-list names than contributors, suggesting the draft capital used to chase upside came at the cost of shoring up real weaknesses. Robinson and Barkley can carry a team for a week, but they cannot carry a season, and right now there is no obvious lever left to pull.

KCBeats finished last season at 67th percentile and somehow managed to slide further down the hill for 2026, sitting at 35th percentile and eighth in the Guitar Hero division. The roster is not without talent, Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 and Drake London at WR7 are genuinely elite, but the draft did almost nothing to build around them. Zero steals, zero values, fourteen chalk selections, and the one swing KCBeats took on upside was Jonathon Brooks at RB37, a player taken 2.3 rounds early who projects as the weakest starter on the roster. That is not a calculated risk, that is paying a premium for a question mark. The rest of the board was mostly met at market or overpaid slightly, which means there is no hidden gem waiting to emerge and no draft-day cleverness to point to as a potential correction. Chase and London can carry a lineup for stretches, but when your best move this offseason was paying up for your own worst starter, the ceiling has already introduced itself.

Last year colleenelizas went 27-9 and finished in the top 10 percent of the field, which is the kind of résumé that earns a manager the benefit of the doubt heading into a new season. The 2026 roster is asking for a lot of that benefit. The team sits seventh in the Guitar Hero division and projects to just the 40th percentile in scoring, a gap between last year's reputation and this year's reality that is hard to paper over. The core is genuinely good: Josh Allen at QB1 and Jonathan Taylor at RB4 give the team a ceiling, and a starting group that also includes Jeremiyah Love, Bhayshul Tuten, and Ladd McConkey is nothing to dismiss. But the draft decisions around the edges raise questions. Two of the team's most notable picks were Fernando Mendoza, taken more than five rounds before his consensus ADP, and Tua Tagovailoa, taken nearly two and a half rounds early. Those capital investments in depth that may not pay off are exactly the kind of choices that explain how a 90th-percentile team ends up projected closer to the middle.

Last year aerickson finished in the bottom 6 percent of the field in scoring, a brutal stretch that makes 2026 feel like a different universe. The foundation of this rebound is real: Jahmyr Gibbs projects as RB1, A.J. Brown sits at WR8, and Justin Herbert checks in at QB8, a trio that gives the roster genuine upside at the positions that matter most. Jaylen Waddle (WR23) and Carnell Tate (WR29) extend the quality well beyond the top line, and Isaiah Likely rounds out the projected starters as TE13. The one soft spot worth watching is Michael Pittman, the projected weakest starter, who lands in Pittsburgh alongside DK Metcalf on an offense still searching for an identity under a new coaching staff, with Aaron Rodgers at age 43 under center. That is not nothing. But a roster with this much firepower at the top does not need Pittman to carry weight, it just needs him to stay out of the way. The 62nd percentile projection feels like a floor for a team that was built to climb.

VonRoe didn't build this roster with one flashy swing. They built it by not missing. James Cook at RB5 slid past his ADP at 2.10, and Marvin Harrison Jr. at WR33 arrived nine rounds into the draft still available a full round after the market said he should have been gone. Those aren't lottery tickets, they're just good drafting. Layer in Brock Bowers at TE1, taken third overall in a field where that kind of positional advantage compounds every single week, and the foundation is legitimately hard to argue with. The supporting cast, anchored by Omarion Hampton at RB9 and Cam Skattebo at RB20, keeps the lineup from depending on any single player to carry a week. Keon Coleman at WR91 is the one eyebrow-raiser, taken more than three rounds early, but late drafts allow for conviction bets and this one hardly endangers the whole enterprise. Coming off an 89th-percentile scoring season in 2025, VonRoe arrives in the Guitar Hero division sitting at 65th percentile tournament-wide, which feels like a floor more than a ceiling.

There was no lottery ticket in this draft, no moment where tkelly27 swung for the fences and got lucky. Just round after round of sensible, disciplined construction that quietly added up to something impressive. The centerpiece is a receiver group that would make most managers envious: CeeDee Lamb (WR5) and Justin Jefferson (WR6) give the roster a legitimate top-tier foundation, and Malik Nabers (WR12) is the kind of upside piece that separates good teams from great ones. Nabers looked like his explosive, quick-twitch self in training camp after a concerning offseason following his ACL tear, and every positive report pushes his value back toward where it belongs. The steal that ties it together is Caleb Williams (QB6), landed a full two and a half rounds after his ADP, giving tkelly27 a QB1-caliber producer at a steep discount. When a draft produces that kind of surplus without a single major reach on the board, the result tends to speak for itself. At 67th percentile entering the season, this team looks primed to climb.

Fantasy Fabio finished 2026 at 84th percentile in the field, third in the Guitar Hero division, and did it by ignoring the draft board with a confidence that bordered on performance art. The two moves that will define this team are Deebo Samuel and Cooper Kupp, taken 3.5 and 2.8 rounds early respectively, the kind of reaches that draw groans in draft rooms. Neither was a particularly safe gamble on paper. Yet here they sit, contributing to a receiver corps anchored by Puka Nacua at WR1 and George Pickens at WR10, with Tee Higgins at WR19 right behind them. That is a genuinely elite top end, and it exists partly because Fantasy Fabio spent capital early on Samuel and Kupp and still landed Nacua, Pickens, and DK Metcalf as projected starters. The last roster this successful in 2025 posted 93rd percentile scoring on an 83 percent win rate. Call the reaches luck if you want. The evidence keeps refusing to cooperate with that interpretation.

DoomyMcSlvge sits at 87th percentile and second in the Guitar Hero division, and the draft sheet explains exactly why. Five values landed on this roster, zero reaches, and the whole thing reads like a manager who showed up with a plan and stuck to it. The foundation is a projected WR3 in Jaxon Smith-Njigba and a WR4 in Amon-Ra St. Brown, the latter a half-round gift past his ADP, paired with Tetairoa McMillan at WR15 to give this team three legitimate top-tier options before things even get interesting. Harold Fannin slots in at TE6 and carries real upside: he outplayed a veteran incumbent last year, that incumbent is now gone, and any offensive improvement in Cleveland could push Fannin further into red zone territory. The QB tier is admittedly the thinnest part of the shelf, with Jordan Love at QB17 leading the group, but in a positionless format this deep at receiver and tight end, that is a tradeoff most managers would happily accept. DoomyMcSlvge did not get lucky. They drafted well.

zbeinlich1 didn't win the Guitar Hero division on luck or a single audacious swing. They won it by being right, repeatedly, in ways that compound. The quarterback room alone could carry lesser teams: Joe Burrow at QB4 anchors the operation, backed by a Jared Goff at QB16 who would start for most managers in this field. Then there is Trey McBride at TE2, Tucker Kraft at TE5, and George Kittle at TE9 sitting behind him, a group that turns one of fantasy's most volatility-prone positions into a solved problem. What makes the draft profile even cleaner is the absence of reaches. Zero major reaches, zero minor reaches, and four values pulled from a market that constantly misprices patient managers. Kenneth Walker III fell 1.2 rounds past his ADP and landed at RB10. C.J. Stroud fell nearly two rounds and slots in as a legitimate third option at a position where most teams are hoping one works out. This roster landed in the 94th percentile of the tournament, and nothing about the process looks accidental.
