As Treying Too Hard braces for what could be a grueling 2025 season, the outlook is anything but promising. Stuck at the bottom of both their division and overall rankings, the team appears to be facing an uphill battle. While they boast a formidable quarterback lineup with Joe Burrow, Drake Maye, and Bryce Young, their backfield leaves much to be desired. The running backs are lackluster, with TreVeyon Henderson struggling to shine despite being overvalued in the draft, and Trey Benson and J.K. Dobbins offering little relief. Even with the advantage of a strong tight end like Trey McBride, the receiving corps is inconsistent, with Rashid Shaheed, a projected starter, representing their weakest link. Despite securing some picks below their average draft position, such as Bryce Young, these marginal gains are overshadowed by questionable early picks that drained potential value, notably J.K. Dobbins. With Ladd McConkey leading the receiver group, the team barely rises above mediocrity among its peers, and their chances of climbing up the ranks seem slim. As it stands,

Treying Too Hard is poised for a season fraught with challenges, underwhelming performances, and a struggle to escape the basement of the standings.

As onedavehendo enters the 2025 fantasy football season, the team finds itself in a precarious position. After an impressive 2024 performance, finishing in the 85th percentile and boasting a 69% winning percentage, expectations were high. However, this year started with a thud, as they find themselves languishing at 10th in their division and barely above the 16th percentile overall. The roster is one of the youngest around, with an average starter age of 24.9 years, but youth brings unpredictability. While Travis Hunter continues to shine as WR12, the wide receiver unit struggles with consistency, particularly as Jayden Higgins, ranked WR52, falters in a starting role. Strategic gambles in the draft didn't quite pay off, with significant overreaches on players like Jonathan Taylor, who was taken significantly earlier than his ADP suggested. Meanwhile, they found some hidden

value with Evan Engram, though the broader picture leaves much to be desired. With an inconsistent record in the division and a meager overall standing, onedavehendo faces a steep climb if they hope to recapture last year's success and rise through the ranks once more.

Despite commendable value picks like Jaxson Dart and Jayden Reed, questionable draft decisions and reaching too soon for players like Tyler Shough and Jahmyr Gibbs

have left the roster imbalanced. As the season begins, their forlorn 16th percentile tournament standing suggests another year of uphill battles, where optimism is scarce and victories seem as elusive as ever.

players. Even with the savvy picks of Patrick Mahomes and Nick Chubb offering glimmers of hope, the Bombers face a steep path to improvement against a field of formidable competitors. It seems that once again, they might find themselves languishing in the lower echelons of both their division and the wider league.

Despite securing Isaac Guerendo at a bargain, other drafting missteps have set them back, casting a long shadow over any aspirations of climbing the ranks this season.
