Despite boasting the division's strongest quarterback duo with Jalen Hurts and Joe Burrow, their decision to draft them earlier than necessary has left the rest of the roster in tatters. Stuck at the bottom of the Hendrick Motorsports division and languishing in the 2nd percentile overall, the team's prospects are anything but promising. The running back corps, featuring Brian Robinson and Rhamondre Stevenson, struggles to inspire confidence, barely scraping by with rankings in the lower echelons. Meanwhile, tight end Kyle Pitts fails to deliver as a reliable option, further compounding their woes. The team's wide receiver lineup, while relatively stronger, is marred by questionable choices like Wan'Dale Robinson as a starter. Despite securing stack bonuses with A.J. Brown and Tee

Higgins, the lack of depth and poor early drafting decisions cast a long shadow over their chances. With these glaring issues, Beerguy27 faces an uphill battle to rise from the basement of their division.

As the 2025 fantasy football season approaches, optimism is in short supply for team reedz, currently ranking 11th in their division and in the 21st percentile overall. Despite finishing last season hoping to build on their 33% win record and climbing out of the 16th percentile in scoring, the outlook remains bleak. This team's glaring quarterback issues persist, with Sam Darnold, projected as the starter, epitomizing their struggles as one of the league's weakest options. The decision to reach significantly earlier for Aaron Rodgers has also backfired, further complicating their quarterback woes. While the running back corps boasts depth and talent with the likes of Ashton Jeanty and Jonathan Taylor leading the charge, their impact is muted by a receiving lineup that fails to inspire confidence. Adding to their troubles, drafting decisions have often prioritized perceived

value over strategic need, as evidenced by taking Cam Ward notably higher than his ADP suggested. Despite snagging Mike Gesicki at a more favorable draft position, these isolated moments of astute drafting do little to shift the narrative. Reedz faces a long, uphill battle, with little to suggest a change from last year's dismal fortunes.
