Chweiss drafted like someone who came to the table with a plan and then abandoned it round by round. Tucker Kraft at pick 2.11 is the loudest confession on the sheet, a TE5 pulled more than two rounds before the market came to him, burning premium capital on a position that did not need emergency spending. Then came Bo Nix at 4.11, a QB15 treated like a QB1, claimed a full round and a half before anyone else felt the urgency. The pattern never breaks. Three major reaches across the draft, four minor ones, zero steals, and a team that lands in the 18th percentile of the field despite holding Bijan Robinson as a genuine RB2 anchor. Robinson is real. The problem is everything built around him cost too much and delivered too little, and when Chweiss needed a reliable projected starter to round out the lineup, the answer was Romeo Doubs at WR53. That is not an unfortunate break. That is the draft speaking plainly about the decisions that preceded it.

MattandCheese enters 2026 sitting 11th in the Hogwarts Legacy division and in just the 31st percentile of the field, and the roster construction offers little reason to expect that trajectory to reverse. The receiver group is legitimately elite, anchored by Jaxon Smith-Njigba (WR3) and Drake London (WR7), but in a positionless format elite receivers can only carry you so far when the quarterback situation looks like this: Sam Darnold at QB21 and Bryce Young at QB26, with Young taken a round early despite projecting as the clear backup. That reach on Young is one of two major reaches on the draft sheet, the other being Quinshon Judkins pulled more than two rounds ahead of his ADP to land at RB22, a projection that does not justify the cost. The sum total is a team with a genuine top asset in Smith-Njigba and London and almost nothing behind the wheel steering it. Last season ended at the 48th percentile in scoring. The levers available to change that look about the same this year.

mikeyg93 played the draft almost exactly right on paper. The value column is stacked: TreVeyon Henderson came a round late, Mike Evans slipped past his price, Travis Hunter fell a round and a half, and Geno Smith arrived nearly four rounds after anyone should have expected him. That is a disciplined drafter doing disciplined drafter things. And yet here sits a team ranked tenth in the Hogwarts Legacy division and in the 41st percentile of the field, which is the kind of outcome that makes you question whether the draft board matters at all. The culprit is not the process, it is the players. James Cook projects as RB5 and Zay Flowers as WR16, which sounds fine until you notice that Jordan Addison at WR43 is the projected weakest starter, the ceiling on this roster is soft, and two major reaches, Ray Davis and Malachi Fields, are eating late-round capital that produced essentially nothing. mikeyg93 earned better than tenth. The standings do not care.

iainfish enters 2026 sitting ninth in the Hogwarts Legacy division and at just the 42nd percentile of the field, and the roster construction makes it hard to find a reason for optimism. The QB group is genuinely excellent, with Josh Allen projecting as QB1 and Caleb Williams coming in at QB6, but elite quarterback play is table stakes in positionless formats and that advantage evaporates quickly when the rest of the roster is graded average across the board. What makes the outlook grimmer is how iainfish got here: the draft featured seven major reaches, with late-round lottery tickets like Elic Ayomanor and Chimere Dike being taken nearly four to five rounds ahead of consensus, suggesting the manager was gambling on upside that the market had already priced out. With Kenneth Gainwell projecting as the weakest projected starter at RB34, and a 2025 campaign that finished in the 30th percentile of scoring, this roster looks less like a team one hot streak away from contention and more like one that has already spent its chips hoping the cards would fall differently.

Sitting eighth in the Hogwarts Legacy division and projected at just the 44th percentile of the field, @onlysandro's 2026 roster is a team that looks fine on the surface until you start pulling threads. Lamar Jackson at QB3 and Amon-Ra St. Brown at WR4 are genuinely elite anchors, and the Goff-St. Brown stack adds a ceiling game or two to the calendar. But the supporting cast is where this thing quietly falls apart. Omarion Hampton projects as a borderline top-10 back, yet the depth behind him grades out as filler, with Chuba Hubbard penciled in as the weakest projected starter at RB29. Worse, the draft offered almost no upside cushion: zero steals, one value, and a pair of major reaches in Chris Rodriguez and Cooper Kupp, both taken several rounds before consensus. A manager who reaches that aggressively in the late rounds is essentially betting on house money that rarely pays out. With no obvious reclamation project and no hidden value left to unlock, onlysandro looks like a team that has already spent its best chips.

Toe7685 is the team that will either quietly grind into the postseason or quietly miss it, and the difference lives in a handful of moments that won't announce themselves in advance. The foundation is genuinely strong: Brock Bowers at TE1 was the clearest draft win on the board, snagged nearly a full round past his market value, and Malik Nabers at WR12 and Marvin Harrison Jr. at WR33 give the starting lineup two receivers worth building around. Joe Burrow at QB4 cost a small premium, coming off the board about half a round early, but that is the kind of overpay you shrug at when the player is QB4. Where the margins get thin is at the edges, where Jayden Reed at WR48 profiles as the weakest projected starter and the difference between Reed having a quiet week and having a disaster week is exactly the kind of variance that swings a team from 58 percent wins to something worse. Last year's 84th-percentile scoring says the talent is real. Whether it's consistent enough to climb out of seventh in the Hogwarts Legacy division is the only question that matters.

ProfessorMD finished 2026 at 46th percentile, which is about as median as median gets, and the roster reads exactly the same way. The ceiling is real: Trey McBride at TE2, Harold Fannin at TE6, and Justin Jefferson at WR6 give this team genuine difference-makers, and getting Jefferson at 2.04 against an ADP of 1.12 was the kind of draft-room patience that wins seasons. The floor, though, is shakier than that ceiling suggests. Jaxson Dart was yanked three rounds early at QB11, Josh Downs cost nearly three rounds of premium for a WR46, and Rhamondre Stevenson projects as the weakest starter on the board at RB31. None of those decisions are catastrophic in a positionless format, but they represent capital that could have bought better depth. ProfessorMD is not a team anyone schemes against, and it is not a team anyone dismisses. It is a team that needs McBride and Jefferson to hit, needs Dart to outperform his rank, and needs the margins to break right. Most weeks, they probably will. Probably.

TWV13 did not win the draft with one flashy pick. They won it by being right more often than wrong, and the running back group is where that patient approach shows up most clearly. Christian McCaffrey at RB3 and De'Von Achane at RB6 give this team a foundation that most managers would envy, and then TWV13 kept adding to it. Chase Brown fell nearly a full round past his ADP before landing at 4.05, and Cam Skattebo slipped over a round to 8.05. Neither of those is a lottery ticket, they are simply a manager paying attention while others looked elsewhere. Kyren Williams at RB15 rounds out a starting group that is genuinely hard to attack. The receiver side is thinner on paper, but Jaylen Waddle moving from Miami's dysfunction to a Denver offense that led the league in pass attempts last year is exactly the kind of quiet upgrade that pays off in the standings. Fifth in the Hogwarts Legacy division is a floor, not a ceiling, for a team built this deliberately.

Snitches Get Stiches didn't swing for the fences and miss, they just kept winning rounds. Jonathan Taylor at RB4 slipping to pick 2.06 past his ADP was a quiet gift, and the manager cashed it. Davante Adams at WR25 falling more than a round, Chris Godwin sliding a round and a half down to WR38, the draft had a way of rewarding patience without requiring anything flashy. Layer in the Patrick Mahomes and Rashee Rice stack, with Mahomes projecting as QB12 and Rice sitting at WR13, and there is a meaningful ceiling on the best weeks. CeeDee Lamb at WR5 cost a slight early reach, but that is the price of certainty at the top, and it is hard to argue with the result. Four values, no major reaches, and a legitimate anchor at nearly every tier of the starting lineup adds up to a team sitting 59th percentile in the field. Fourth in the Hogwarts Legacy division is not where this roster belongs if the projections hold.

Scottfish24 didn't need a heist to build this roster, just a relentless series of correct decisions. Jahmyr Gibbs at RB1, Colston Loveland at TE3, George Kittle at TE9, Jayden Daniels at QB5, all projected starters, all acquired without drama, all consistently ahead of where the field was thinking. That kind of draft is harder to execute than it looks, because there's no single moment to point to, just pick after pick that held up. The Kittle situation is quite the pickle, an Achilles tear in the NFL playoffs followed by cautiously optimistic offseason updates leaves his Week 1 availability genuinely uncertain, but the roster has enough projected starter-caliber talent that a slow start from him doesn't crater the floor. Jeremiyah Love at RB13 and Loveland at TE3 give this team a ceiling worth respecting. At 62nd percentile in the tournament and third in the Hogwarts Legacy division, scottfish24 is positioned not as a contender by circumstance but by construction, and that distinction matters when the season actually starts.

jessicadawn did not come to the Scott Fish Bowl to make a statement pick. She came to win, and the draft board reflects exactly that discipline. The receiver group is where it all starts: Puka Nacua (WR1), A.J. Brown (WR8), and George Pickens (WR10) form a projected top-ten triumvirate that most managers would mortgage their middle rounds to assemble, and jessicadawn paired Nacua with Matthew Stafford (QB14) for a stack that compounds every big game either of them has. Yes, Stafford cost a premium, taken 1.3 rounds ahead of his ADP, but the rest of the draft quietly paid that bill back with interest. Bucky Irving (RB21), Zach Charbonnet (RB42), and Tyler Allgeier (RB46) all fell past their ADPs, each one a small correction that added up to something meaningful. David Montgomery (RB23) brings his own intrigue, now pressing Woody Marks for top billing in Houston after a diminished role in Detroit. This roster did not happen by accident. It happened pick by pick.

MeggieMcSchmeg enters 2026 sitting first in the Hogwarts Legacy division, 88th percentile in the field, and looking very much like a team that knew exactly what it was doing on draft day. The foundation is legitimate: Ja'Marr Chase at WR2 and Ashton Jeanty at RB7 give this roster a pair of genuinely elite anchors, and the depth behind them holds up. Kenneth Walker III landing at RB10 when his ADP had him going more than a full round earlier is the kind of quiet win that separates disciplined drafters from the rest, and Colby Parkinson falling more than three rounds past his ADP at pick 18.09 is the sort of late-round patience that makes a roster look inevitable in hindsight. The only real question is Justin Herbert, a talent whose ceiling stays capped as long as the Chargers keep winning games and managing the clock, but at QB8 he is a perfectly usable piece on a roster that earns it. Two steals, four values, and zero major reaches. Clean from top to bottom.
